ABSTRACT

The data in this document portrays full-time, part-time, and total headcount enrollment for each campus and for the entire University of Maine for the 5-year period 1971 to 1975. Full-time equivalent student enrollment that converts part-time enrollment to full-time equivalents is also shown. The total number of students enrolled in the University of Maine increased 31 percent in this five-year period. Daytime enrollment increased 30 percent and continuing education (evening) students increased 38 percent. Part-time students have increased by 19 percent. Resident enrollment increased 31 percent while nonresident enrollments have increased 33 percent. (Author)

The data in this summary portrays full-time, part-time and total headcount enrollment for each campus and the entire University of Maine for the 5-year period 1971 to 1975. Full-time equivalent student enrollment which converts part-time enrollment to full-time equivalents is also shown.

SUMMARY

The total number of students enrolled in the University of Maine increased 31% in this 5-year period. Day-time enrollments increased 20% and continuing education (evening) students increased 38%. Part-time students have grown by 19%. Resident enrollment increased 6069 or 31% while non-resident enrollments have increased 755 or 33%.

The following tables provide details for each campus and the entire University of Maine.

For Fall 1974 and Fall 1975, two different FTE enrollments are shown. The first, which is comparable to previous years' data is computed as follows:

1. Undergraduate students

1 full-time student	=	1 FTE student
1 part-time student	=	.5 FTE student

2. Graduate students

regular day students	=	1 FTE student
CED students are equated in the same manner as undergraduate students		

The second FTE figure which is in parentheses reflects a new method for equating part-time students to full-time students on the basis of student credit hours generated, as follows:

1. Undergraduate level programs:

<u>Total student credit hours generated</u>	= 1 FTE student

2. Graduate level programs

<u>Total student credit hours generated</u>	= 1 FTE student

Both FTE figures are being shown so that the difference created by a new methodology may be noted.
