ABSTRACT

This report is a summary of the total associate, baccalaureate, first-professional, master's, and doctoral degrees conferred during the 1974-75 fiscal year by the 29 institutions of higher education in Kentucky accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. Degrees conferred in 1974-75 total 20,099. There were 2,881 associate degrees, 11,893 bachelor's, 802 first-professional, 4,345 master's, and 178 doctoral degrees conferred. Degrees are listed for state and private colleges and universities, junior colleges, and community colleges. Also listed are degrees awarded by discipline. (Author/KE)

## S U M M A R Y

This report is a summary of the total associate, baccalaureate (bachelor's), first-professional, master's and doctoral degrees conferred during the 1974-75 fiscal year by the 29 institutions of higher education in Kentucky accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

(Associate degrees are awarded for the completion of programs requiring at least two years, but less than four years, of study beyond the high school level. First-professional degrees are those awarded in law, dentistry, and medicine.)

Degrees conferred in 1974-75 total 20,099. There were 2,881 associate degrees, 11,893 bachelor's, 802 first-professional, 4,345 master's and 178 doctoral degrees conferred.

### Associate Degrees

The 13 University of Kentucky community colleges conferred 1,668 associate degrees in 1974-75. The eight public senior (four-year or more) institutions conferred 902 associate degrees, and 311 were conferred by the 21 private two-year and four-year institutions.

The largest percentage of the associate degrees conferred was in nursing (R.N.), 39.5 percent of the total, followed by 10.2 percent of the total in secretarial and office machine technologies, and 4.8 percent in police and social work technologies.

This is only the third year for which associate degrees data has been reported. Future reports will contain comparisons to previous years' data.

### Bachelor's Degrees

A total of 11,893 bachelor's degrees was awarded by Kentucky institutions during the 1974-75 fiscal year. Of these, 24.7 percent were in education; 16.2 percent were in business and management; and 11.3 percent were in the social sciences. In the 1970-71 fiscal year, the first year degree data was compiled by the Council on Public Higher Education from U.S. Department of Health, Education, and Welfare figures, 12,375 bachelor's degrees were conferred. Of those, 31.1 percent were in education; 16.5 percent were in the social sciences; and 14.5 percent were in business and management.

### Master's Degrees

Kentucky institutions conferred 4,355 master's degrees in 1974-75, up from 2,623 in 1970-71. Of the 1974-75 total, 57.6 percent were in education; 4.4 percent were in library science; and 8.4 percent were in public affairs and services. Comparative percentages from 1970-71 are 58.9 percent in education, 6.2 percent in the social sciences; and 5.0 percent in library science.

### Doctoral Degrees

In 1974-75, 178 doctoral degrees were conferred. Of these, 15.6 percent were in education; 15.0 percent were in the social sciences; and 12.3 percent were in business and management. During the 1970-71 fiscal year, 160 doctoral degrees were conferred in Kentucky. That year, doctoral degrees in biological sciences made up 19.4 percent of the total; physical science made up 18.1 percent; and education made up 13.8 percent.

### First-Professional Degrees

First-professional degrees conferred in 1974-75 totaled 802. In 1970-71, 493 were conferred. The order of ranking - law first,

medicine second, and dentistry third - is the same for 1974-75 as it was for 1970-71. In comparing 1970-71 and 1974-75, the most significant increase in all levels of degrees awarded is in the first-professional category.

Figures in the report were summarized from the HEW Office of Education's survey, Degrees and Other Formal Awards Conferred Between July 1, 1974 and June 30, 1975, and the Kentucky Council on Public Higher Education survey, Degrees Conferred July 1, 1970 to June 30, 1971.
