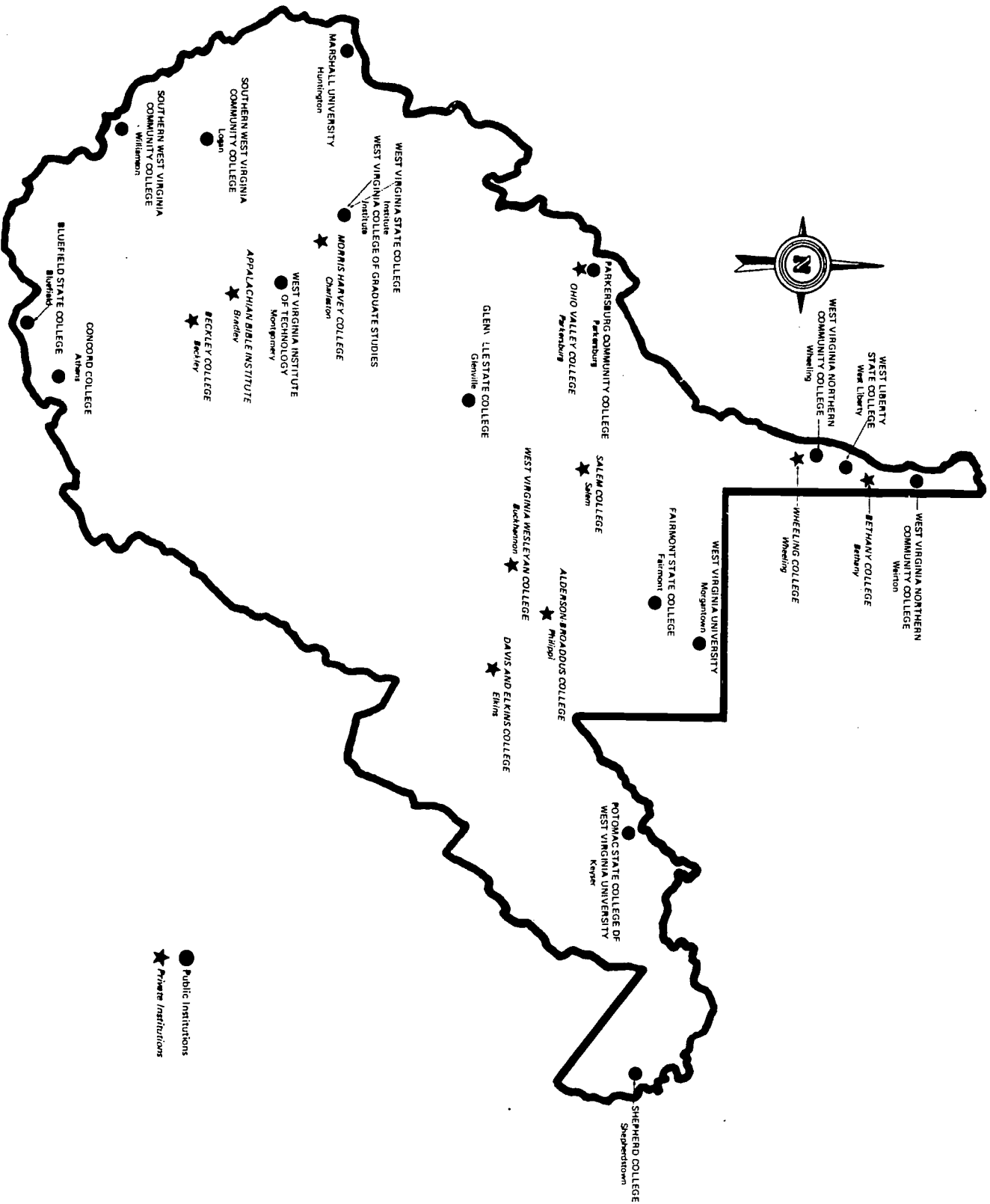

APPENDIX

INTRODUCTION

Background

The West Virginia Board of Regents was established in 1969 as the governing board for the state system of higher education. It was charged with the general determination, control, supervision, and management of all state colleges and universities. Essential to the successful management of any complex and diversified system is the availability of objective statistical data to aid in the formation of prudent management decisions. Since its creation the Board has worked to establish a comprehensive management information system designed to generate data concerning many aspects of West Virginia higher education. This report is an analysis of the degrees conferred during the 1974-75 academic year by institutions of higher education in West Virginia.

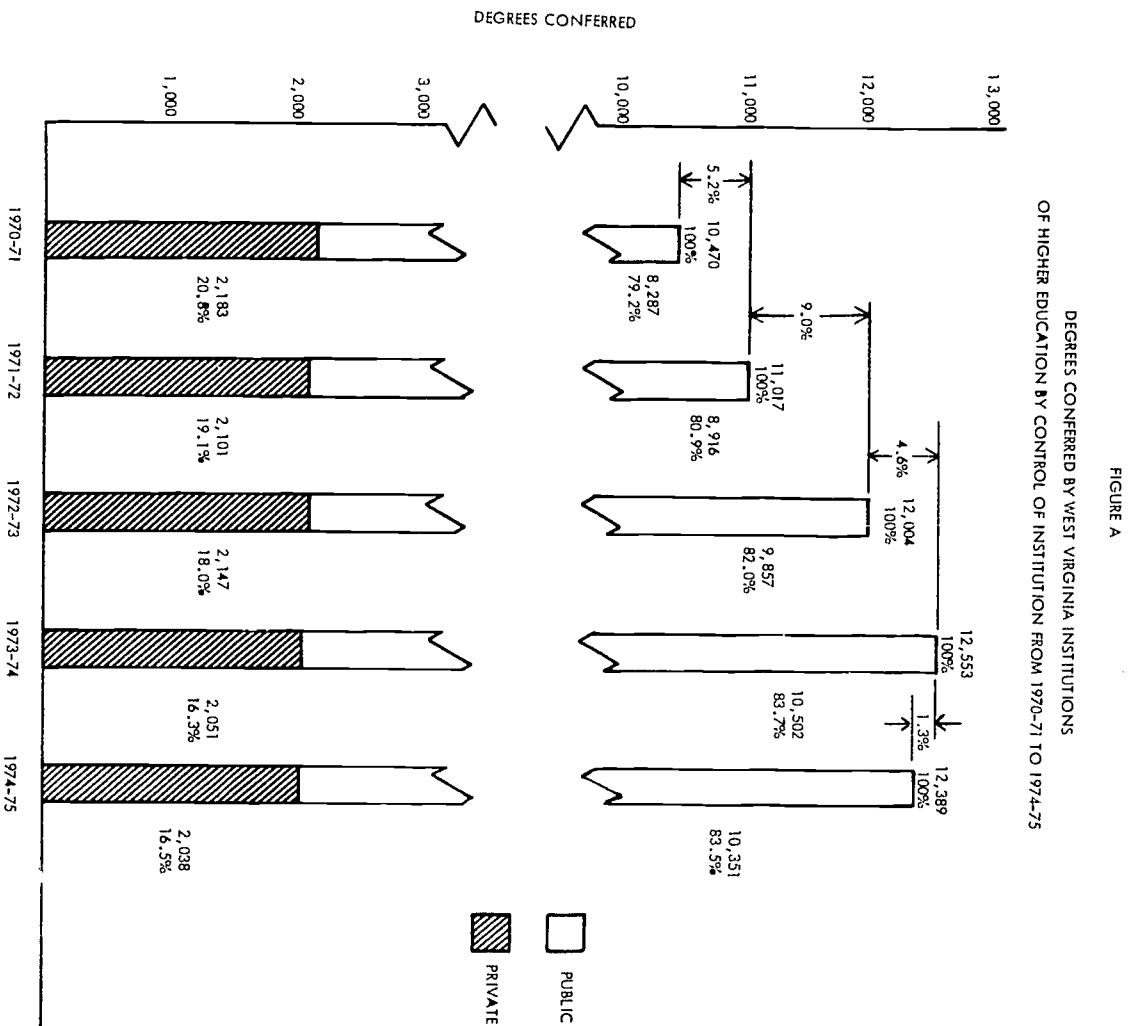
The Board is committed to the formulation of carefully designed new degree programs that are directly related to West Virginia manpower needs and employment opportunities. Likewise, the Board desires to avoid the unnecessary duplication of programs throughout the state, as well as the elimination of programs at the public institutions that attract few students or that involve excessive costs. The tables presented in this publication relating to degree programs represent only one type of analysis produced by the Board's management information system. The data have been reported without reference to any critical or judgmental standards.

Nationally accepted definitions and principles have been used in the collection and classification of data for this report. The West Virginia Board of Regents Form BOR DA-1, Degrees Awarded, 1974-75, was used for the collection of the data. The 28 academic areas of study utilized in this report (29 including the West Virginia Board of Regents' B.A. Degree) have been extracted from the U.S. Office of Education publication, "A Taxonomy of Instructional Programs in Higher Education." This taxonomy represents an effort to organize and record data concerning institutional programs in a consistent and meaningful manner. The data of this report are generally comparable to reports prepared by other states. Included in this report are all West Virginia public and private institutions of higher education.

HIGHLIGHTS — ALL INSTITUTIONS

During the 1974-75 academic year, 12,389 degrees were conferred by institutions of higher education in West Virginia. An absolute decrease of 164 total degrees conferred resulted in a 1.3 per cent decrease over the 12,553 total degrees conferred in 1973-74 (see Figure A).

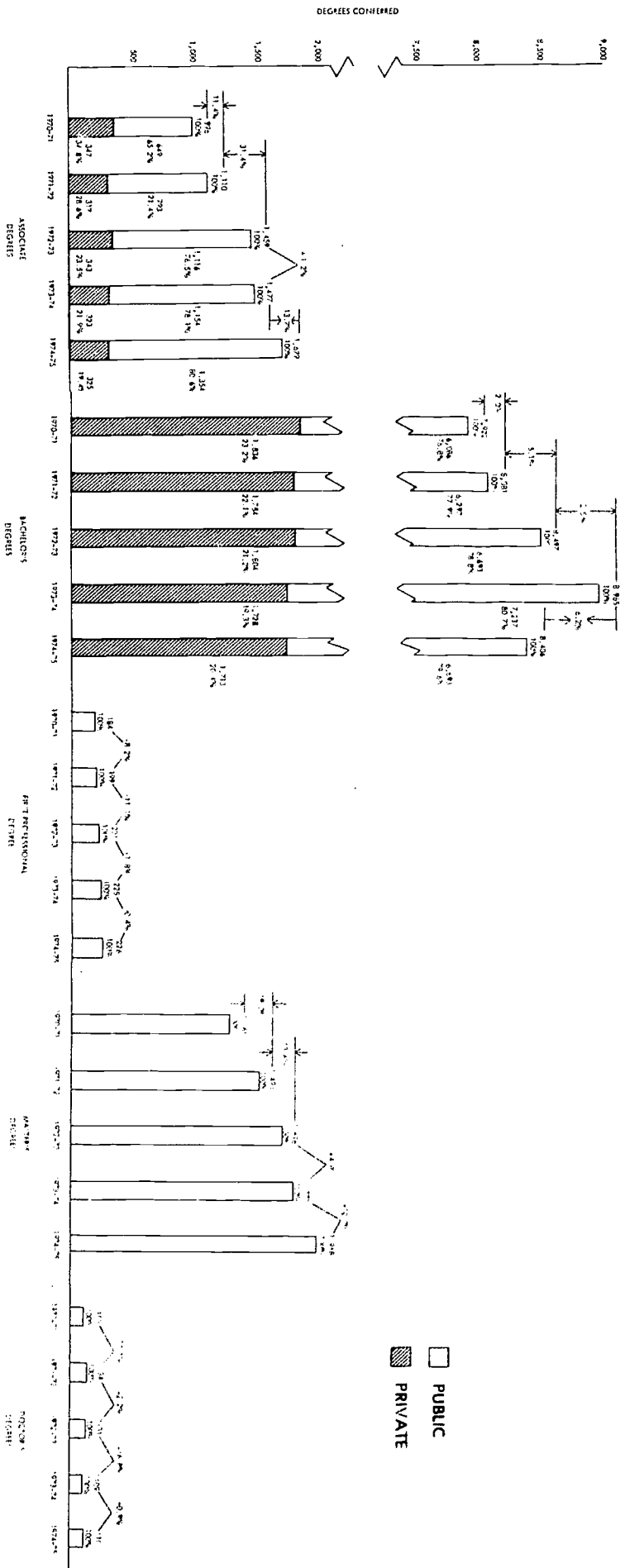
Figure A presents the total degrees conferred for each of the past five academic years. Of the total degrees granted by all West Virginia institutions, public institutions awarded 79.2 per cent in 1970-71, 80.9 per cent in 1971-72, 82.0 per cent in 1972-73, 83.7 per cent in 1973-74, and 83.5 per cent in 1974-75.



HIGHLIGHTS — ALL INSTITUTIONS (Cont.)

The total degrees awarded at each degree level by all West Virginia colleges and universities for each of the past five academic years is presented in Figure B. When analyzing the increase in productivity by level of degree for the 1974-75 academic year over 1973-74, the following increases are revealed: Associate degrees conferred increased 13.7 per cent (1,477 to 1,679); First Professional, 0.4 per cent (225 to 226); Master's, 10.7 per cent (1,777 to 1,968); and Doctor's, 0.9 per cent (109 to 110). Bachelor's decreased 6.2 per cent (8,965 to 8,406). Figure B also shows the proportion of degrees conferred by the public and private institutions for each degree level--private institutions in West Virginia offer only associate and bachelor's degree programs.

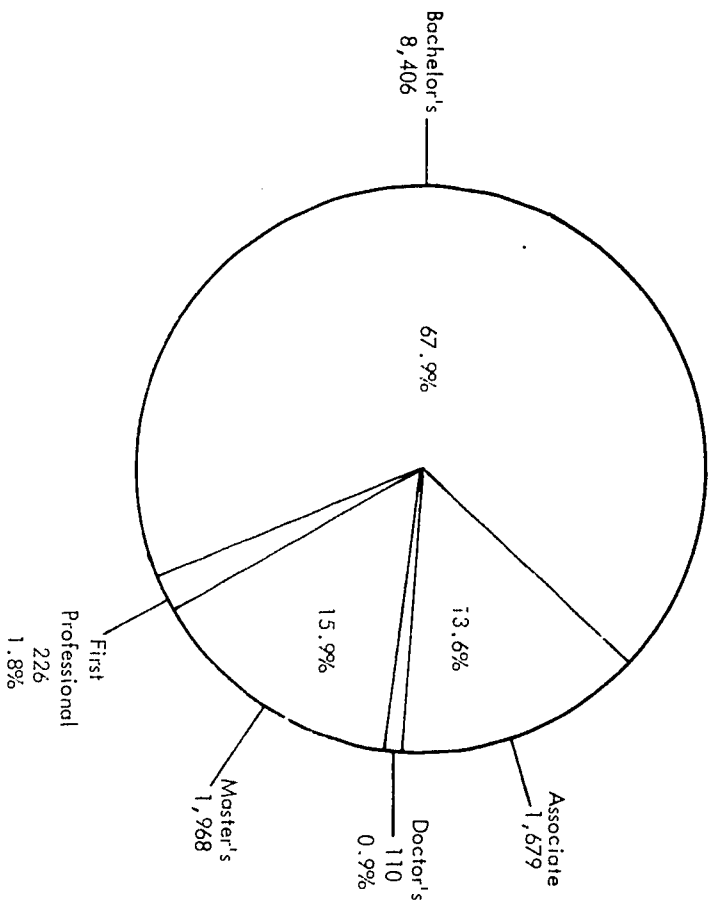

HIGHLIGHTS — ALL INSTITUTIONS (Cont.)

Figure C graphically presents the distribution of degrees by degree level. The total 8,406 bachelor's degrees conferred represented 67.9 per cent of all associate and higher degrees awarded during the 1974-75 academic year. The other degree levels, in descending order, were: Master's (1,968), 15.9 per cent; Associate (1,679), 13.6 per cent; First Professional (226), 1.8 per cent; and Doctor's (110), 0.9 per cent.

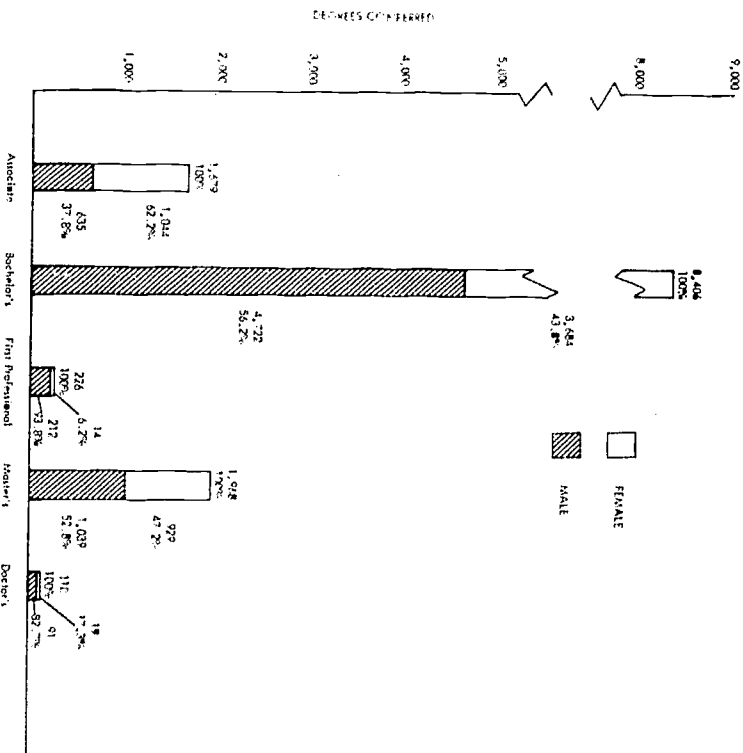

Of the total 12,389 degrees conferred during the 1974-75 academic year, 54.1 per cent (6,699) were awarded to males, while 45.9 per cent (5,690) were awarded to females. Figure D presents the total degrees awarded to males and females for each of the degree levels. Of the total 1,679 associate degrees awarded, females received 62.2 per cent (1,044) and males 37.8 per cent (635). Of the total 8,406 bachelor's degrees awarded, males received 56.2 per cent (4,722) and females 43.8 per cent (3,684). Males received 93.8 per cent (212) of the total 226 first professional degrees conferred, while females received 6.2 per cent (14). For the 1,968 master's degrees conferred, 52.8 per cent (1,039) were awarded to males and 47.2 per cent (929) to females. Of the 110 doctor's degrees earned, 82.7 per cent (91) were awarded to males, while females received 17.3 per cent (19).

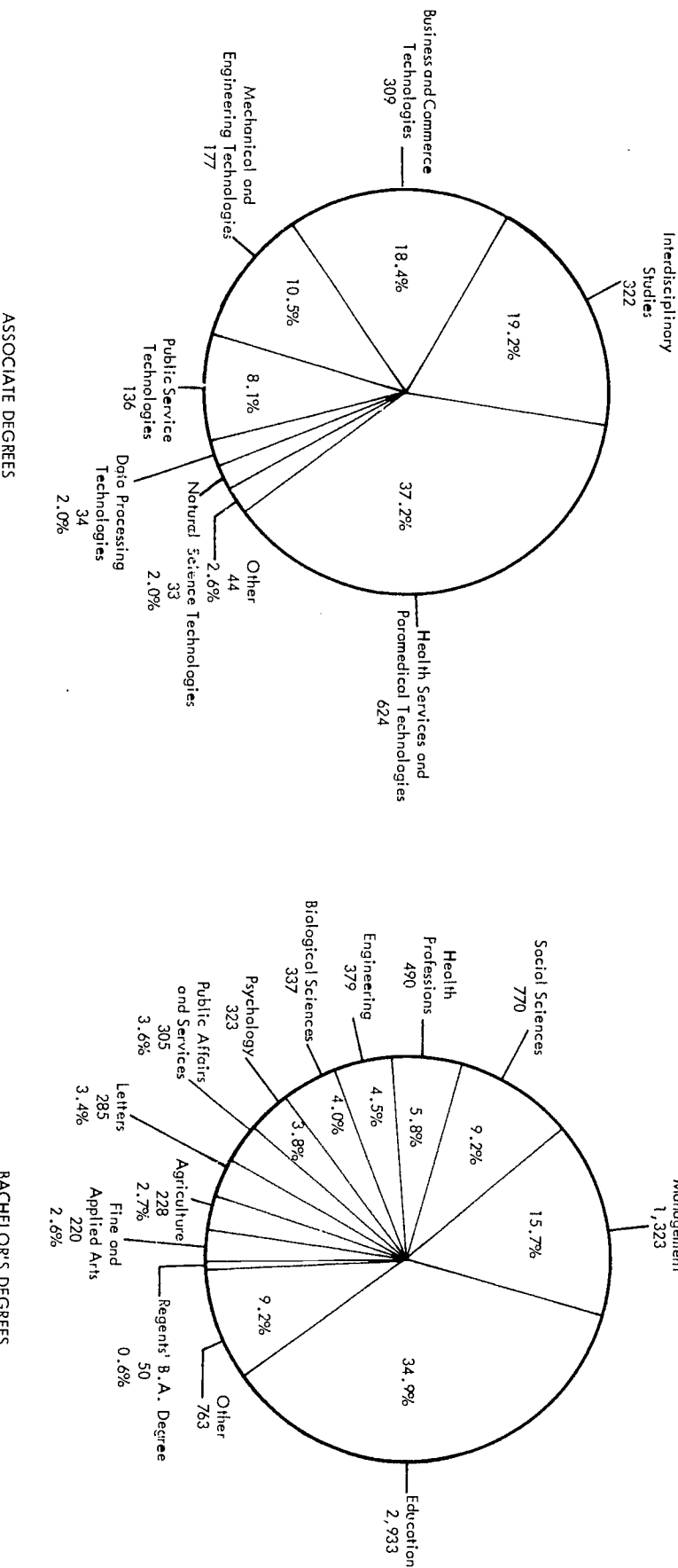


HIGHLIGHTS — ALL INSTITUTIONS (Cont.)

For the 1974-75 academic year, the dominant academic areas of study for all degree levels were: education (33.1 per cent), business and management (11.8 per cent), social sciences (6.7 per cent), health professions (5.7 per cent) and engineering (3.9 per cent). Figure E presents a breakdown of the total degrees awarded for each degree level by academic area. For the associate degree level, over 85 per cent of the degrees were awarded in four academic areas: health services and paramedical technologies (624), 37.2 per cent; interdisciplinary studies (322), 19.2 per cent; business and commerce technologies (309), 18.4 per cent; and mechanical and engineering technologies (177), 10.5 per cent. Three academic areas of study accounted for nearly 60 per cent of the degrees awarded at the bachelor's level. The three were: education (2,933), 34.9 per cent; business and management (1,323), 15.7 per cent; and social sciences (770), 9.2 per cent.

HIGHLIGHTS — ALL INSTITUTIONS (Cont.)

Health professions accounted for 62.4 per cent of the first professional degrees, while law accounted for 37.6 per cent. Of the 141 first professional degrees in health professions, there were 82 degrees in medicine and 59 degrees in dentistry. First professional degrees in West Virginia are only awarded by West Virginia University.

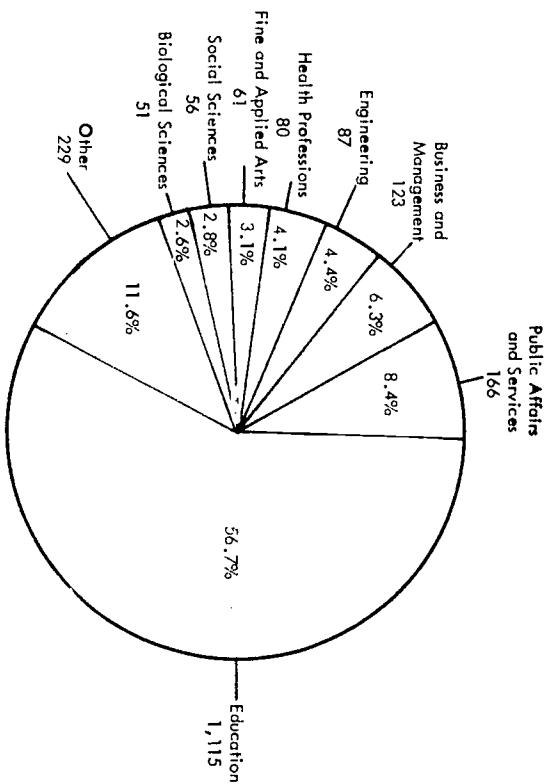
Education accounted for over 50 per cent of the master's degrees conferred, while at the doctor's level it accounted for 40.9 per cent. Four other academic areas at the doctor's level accounted for an additional 49.1 per cent of the total 110 doctor's degrees awarded. They were: biological sciences, 13.6 per cent; engineering, 12.7 per cent; psychology, 11.8 per cent; social sciences, 5.5 per cent; and physical sciences, 5.5 per cent.

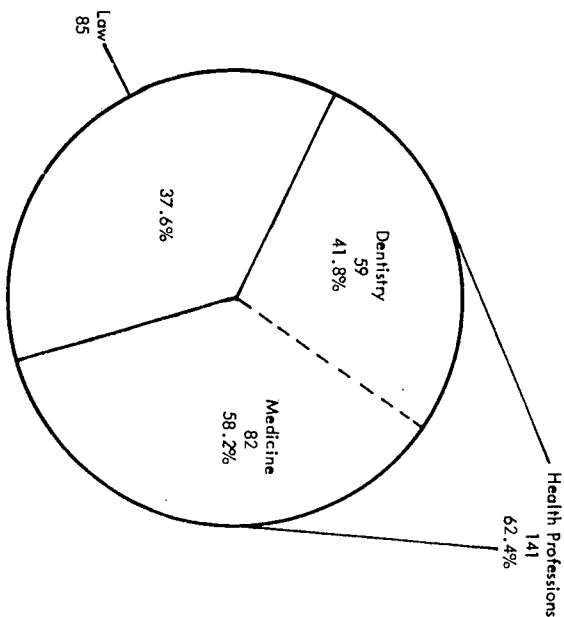
PER CENT DISTRIBUTION AND NUMBER OF DEGREES CONFERRED

BY WEST VIRGINIA INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION

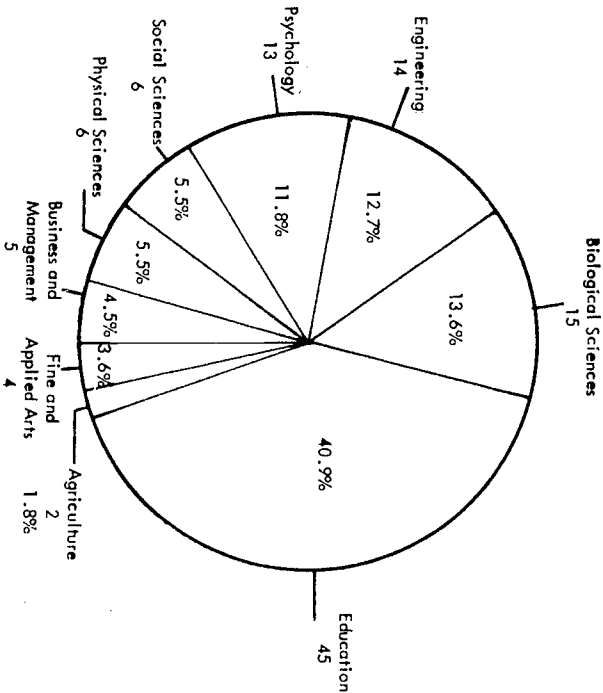
BY LEVEL OF DEGREE AND ACADEMIC AREA OF STUDY, 1974-75

FIRST PROFESSIONAL DEGREES

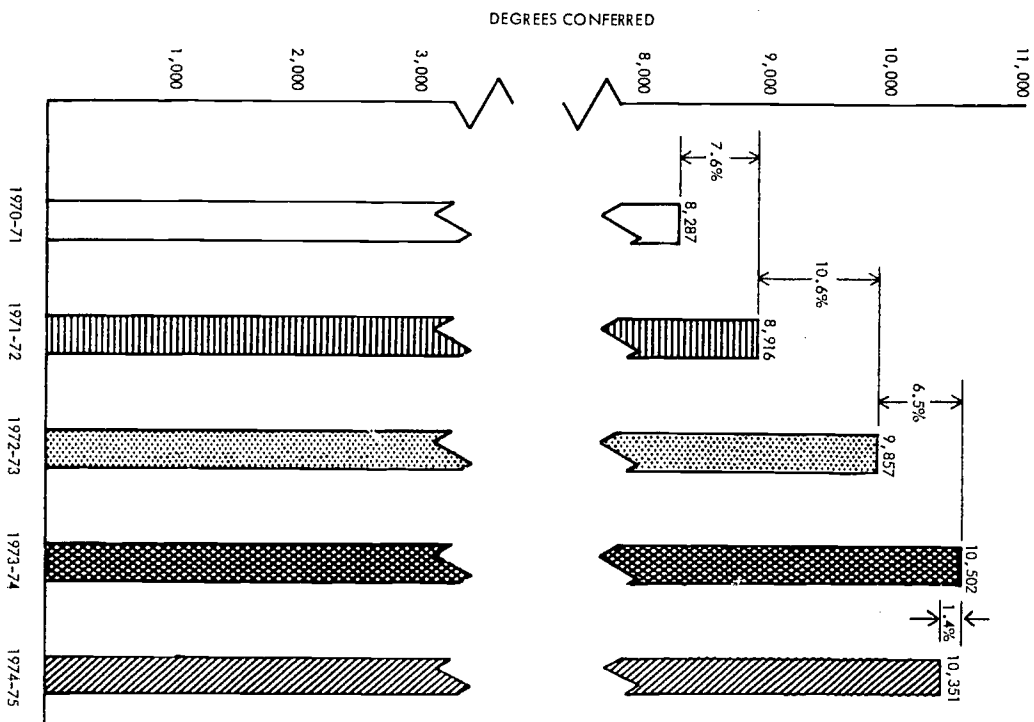


DOCTOR'S DEGREES

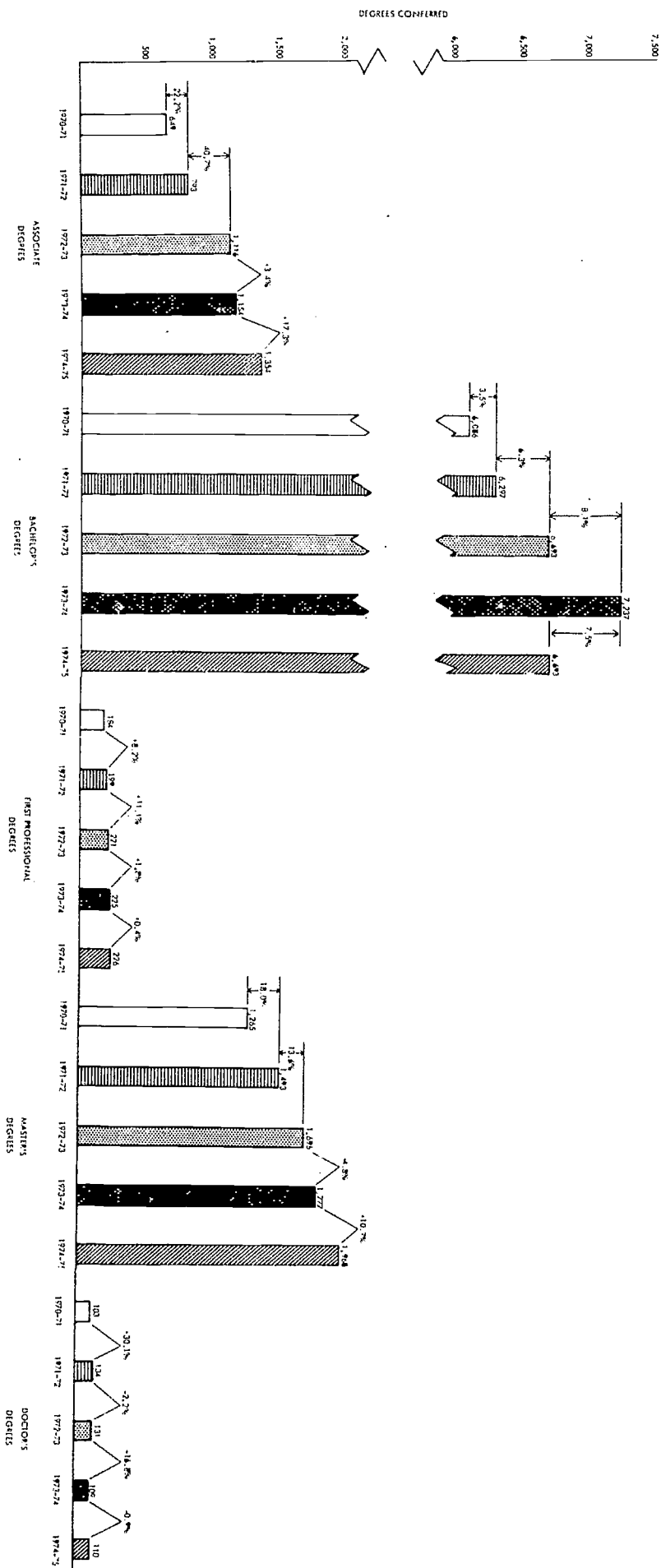


During the 1974-75 academic year, a total of 10,351 degrees was awarded by public colleges and universities in West Virginia. An absolute decrease of 151 total degrees conferred resulted in a 1.4 per cent decrease over the 10,502 total degrees awarded in 1973-74 (see Figure F). Since 1970-71, the public institutions have had an absolute increase of 2,064 total degrees conferred, a 24.9 per cent gain.

HIGHLIGHTS — PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS (Cont.)

The total degrees awarded at each degree level by all West Virginia public institutions of higher education for each of the four academic years is presented in Figure G. When analyzing the increase in production by level of degree for the 1974-75 academic year over 1973-74, the following increases were revealed: Associate degrees conferred increased 17.3 per cent (1,154 to 1,354); First Professional, 0.4 per cent (225 to 226); Master's, 10.7 per cent (1,727 to 1,968); Doctor's, 0.9 per cent (109 to 110); and Bachelor's decreased 7.5 per cent (7,237 to 6,693).

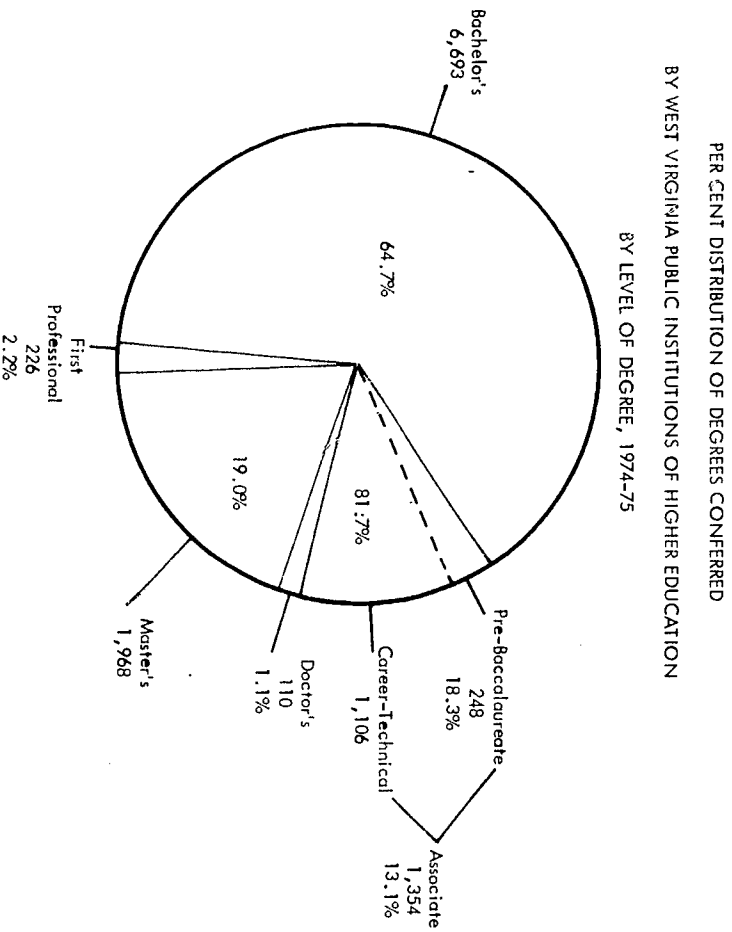


HIGHLIGHTS — PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS (Cont.)

Figure H graphically presents the distribution by degree level of the degrees conferred by the public institutions. The total 6,693 bachelor's degrees conferred represented 64.7 per cent of all degrees awarded during 1974-75 by public institutions. The other degree levels, in descending order, were: Master's (1,968), 19.0 per cent; Associate (1,354), 13.1 per cent; First Professional (226), 2.2 per cent; and Doctor's (110), 1.1 per cent.

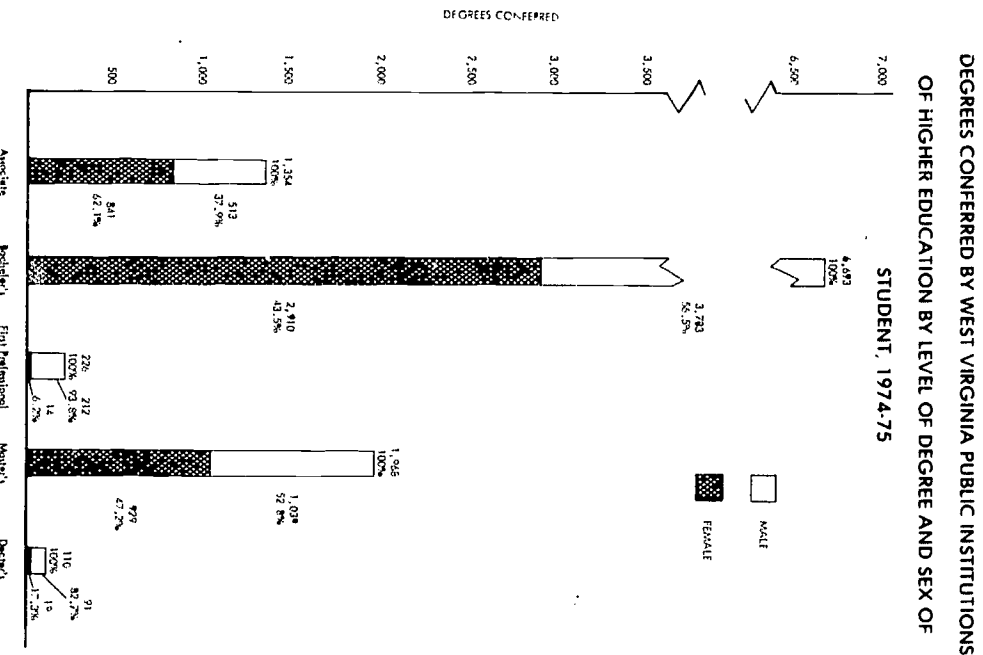
Of the total 10,351 degrees conferred during the 1974-75 academic year by the West Virginia public institutions, 54.5 per cent (5,638) were awarded to males while 45.5 per cent (4,713) were awarded to females. Figure I presents the total degrees awarded

to males and females for each of the degree levels. Of the total 1,354 associate degrees awarded, females received 62.1 per cent (841) and males 37.9 per cent (513). Of the total 6,693 bachelor's degrees awarded, males received 56.5 per cent (3,783) and females 43.5 per cent (2,910). Males received 93.8 per cent (212) of the total 226 first professional degrees conferred while females received 6.2 per cent (14). For the 1,968 master's degrees conferred, 52.8 per cent (1,039) were awarded to males and 47.2 per cent (929) to females. Of the 110 doctor's degrees earned, 82.7 per cent (91) were awarded to males, while females received 17.3 per cent (19).

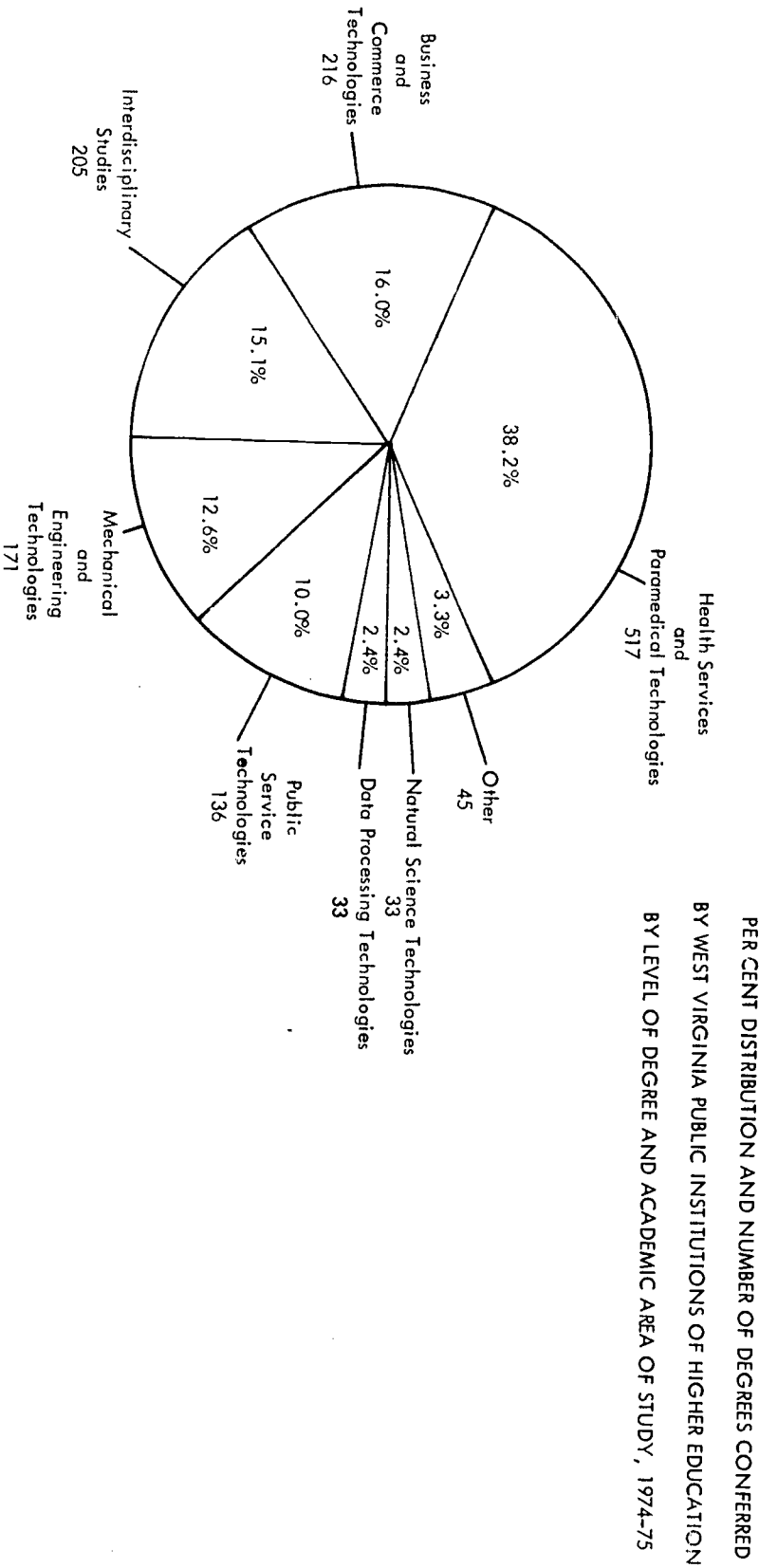

HIGHLIGHTS — PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS (Cont.)

Soon after its formation, the Board of Regents determined that the most critical higher educational need in West Virginia was an expanded program of career-technical and pre-baccalaureate (college transfer) offerings of two years or less duration. The Board has approved the establishment of new programs designed specifically to meet these needs. Although most of these degree programs have only been in operation for a short period of time, Figure G shows that the associate degree level recorded a 17.3 per cent increase over the past academic year. Of the total 1,354 associate degrees conferred by the public institutions, 1,106 or 81.7 per cent were career-technical associate degrees and 248 or 18.3 per cent were pre-baccalaureate associate degrees. Figure J presents a breakdown by academic area of both the career-technical and pre-baccalaureate associate degrees.

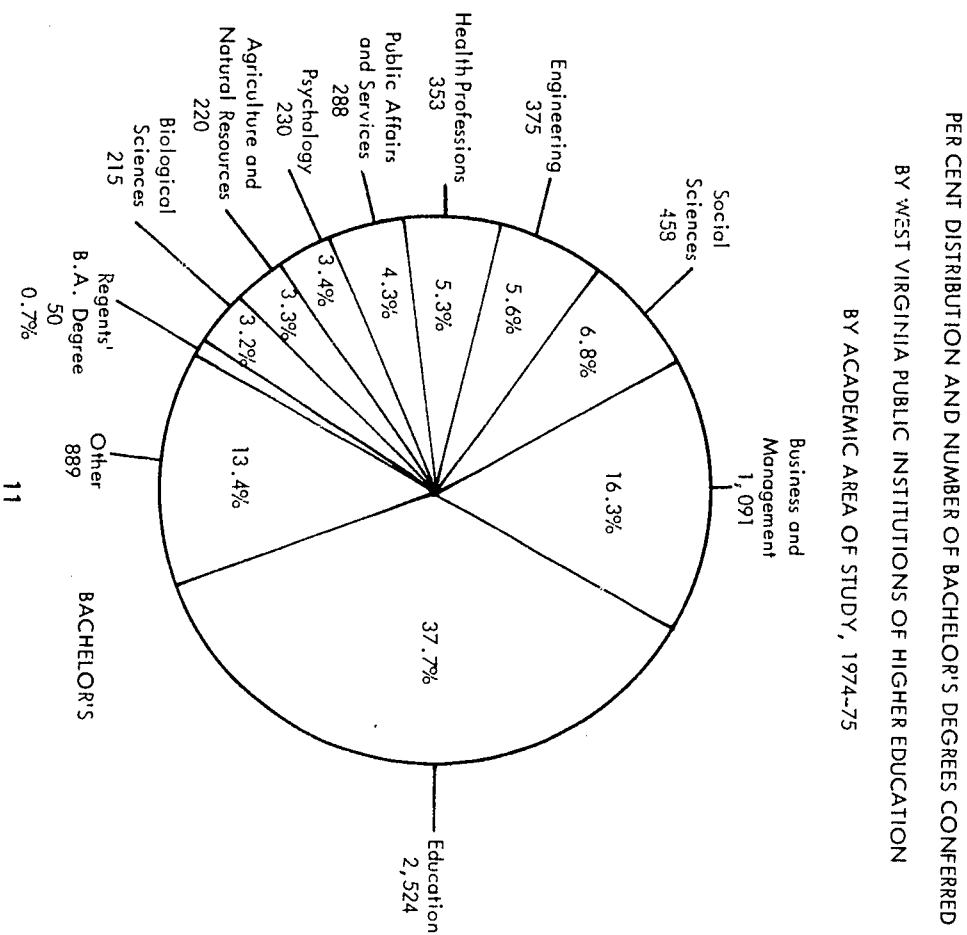


HIGHLIGHTS — PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS (Cont.)

Figure K presents a distribution by academic area of the total 6,693 bachelor's degrees awarded by the public institutions. Education and business and management accounted for over 54 per cent of the total bachelor's degrees awarded by the public colleges and universities. For a breakdown of the first professional, master's and doctor's degree levels for each academic area, see Figure E on Page 6.

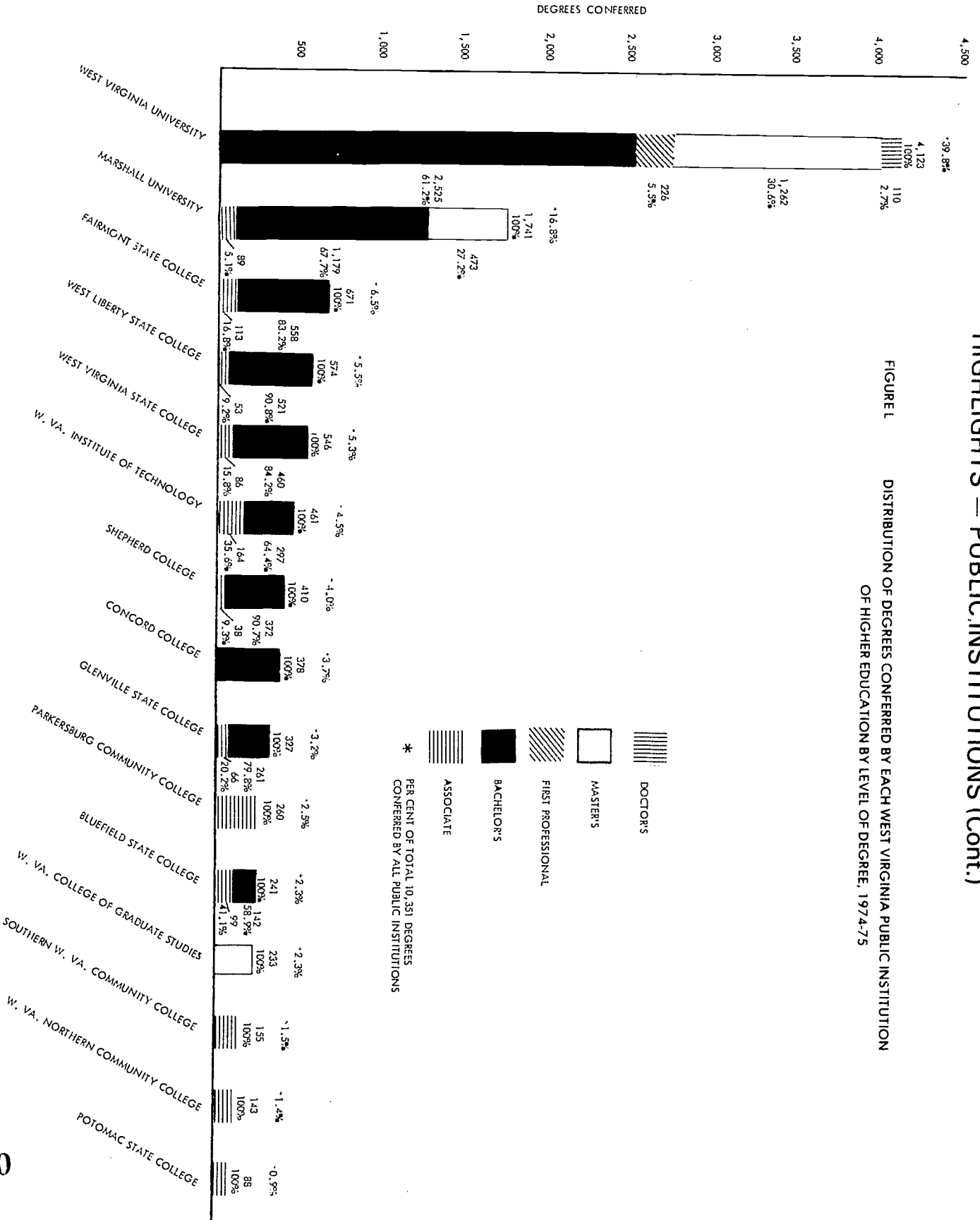
Figure L on the following page graphically presents by degree level the total degrees awarded by each of the 15 West Virginia public institutions of higher education. The community colleges and graduate college are new institutions established within the past four years by the Board of Regents. It is expected that these institutions will have a significant increase in the number of degrees conferred for the next several years, since they have experienced a dramatic enrollment growth.

HIGHLIGHTS — PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS

During the 1974-75 academic year, a total of 2,038 degrees was awarded by private colleges in West Virginia. An absolute decrease of 13 total degrees conferred resulted in a 0.6 per cent decrease from the 2,051 total degrees awarded in 1973-74 (see Figure M).

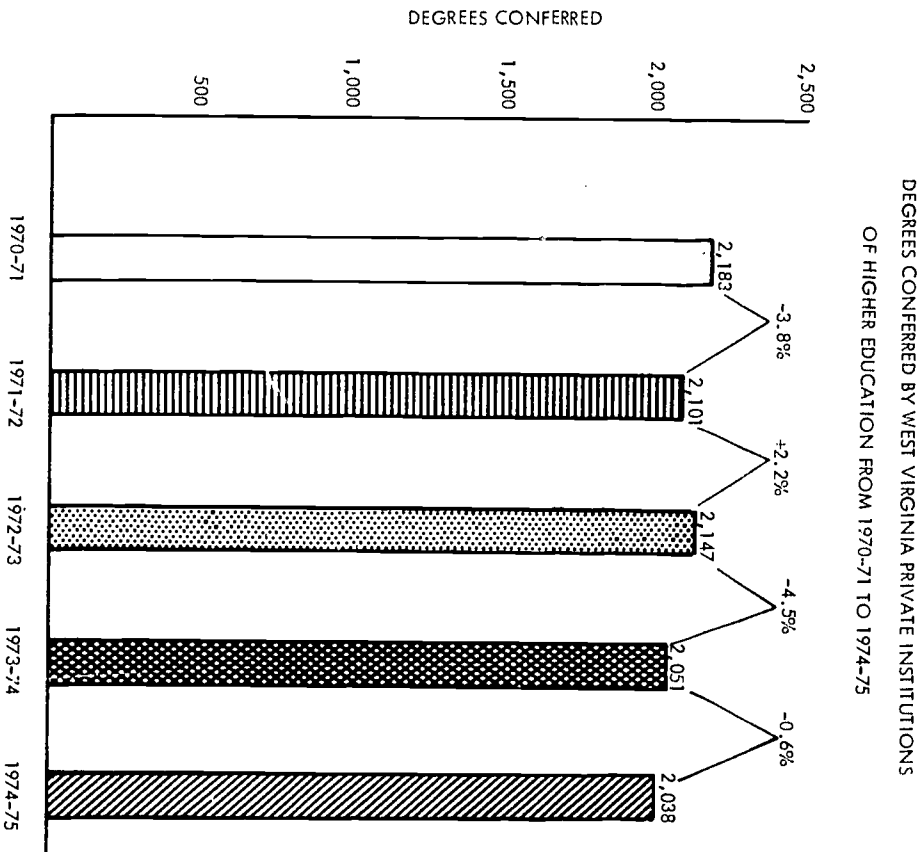
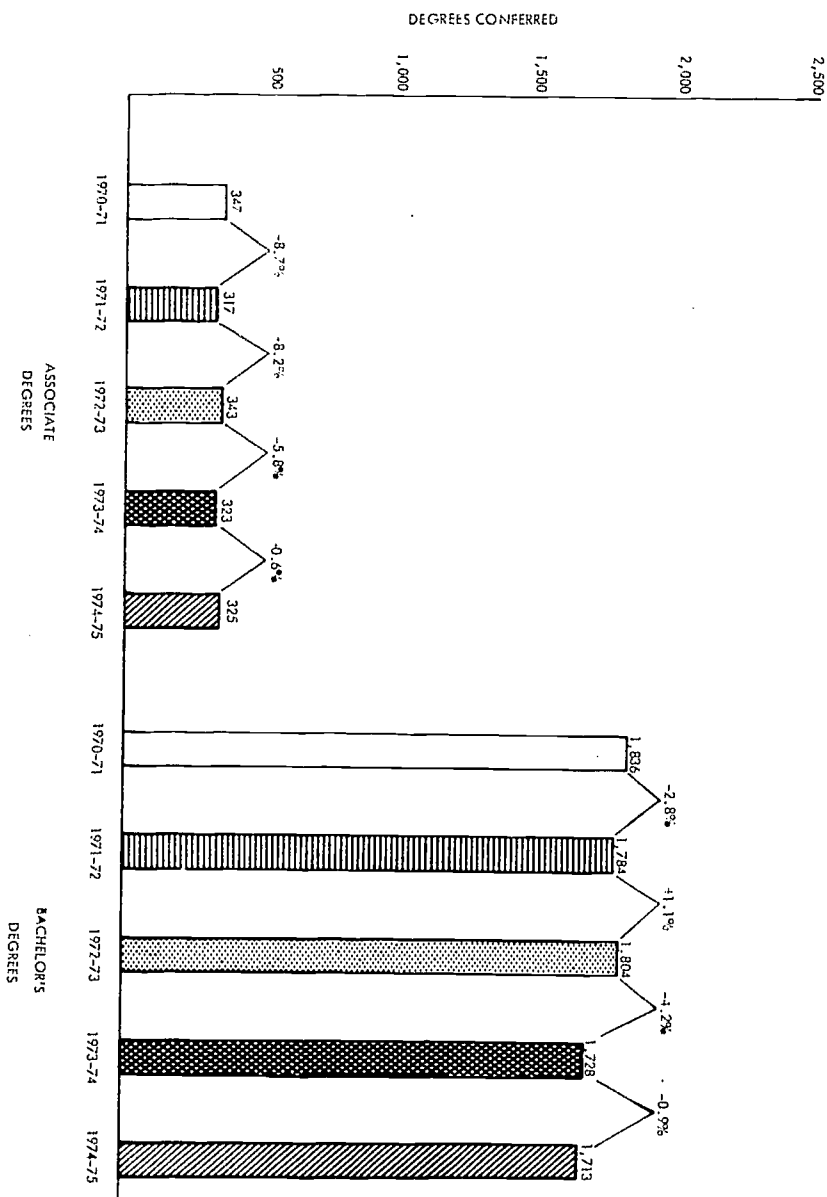

HIGHLIGHTS — PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS (Cont.)

The total degrees awarded at each degree level by West Virginia private institutions of higher education for each of the past five academic years is presented in Figure N. When analyzing the productivity by level of degree for the 1974-75 academic year over 1973-74, the following was revealed: Associate degrees conferred increased 0.6 per cent (323 to 325), and Bachelor's degrees conferred 0.9 per cent (1,728 to 1,713).

HIGHLIGHTS — PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS (Cont.)

Figure O graphically presents the distribution by degree level of the degrees conferred by the private institutions. The total 1,713 bachelor's degrees conferred represented 84.1 per cent of all degrees awarded during 1974-75 by private institutions. The 325 associate degrees accounted for 15.9 per cent of the total.

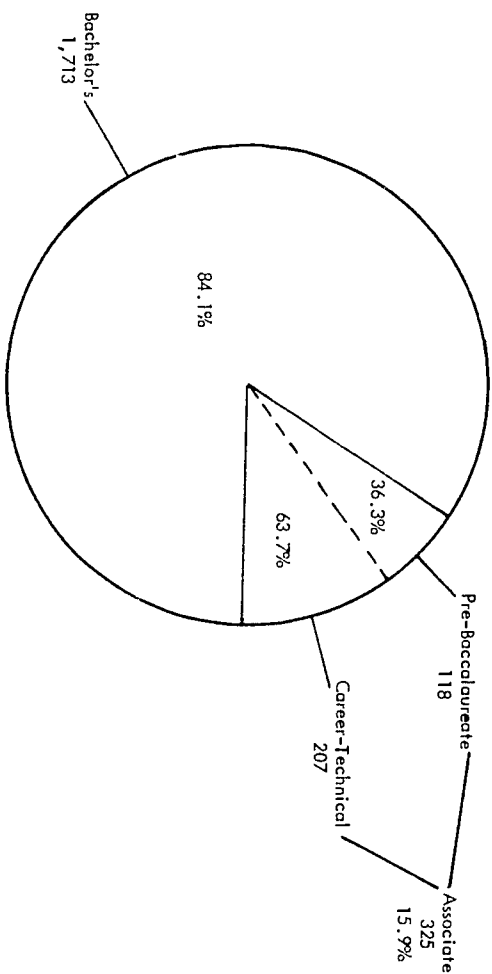
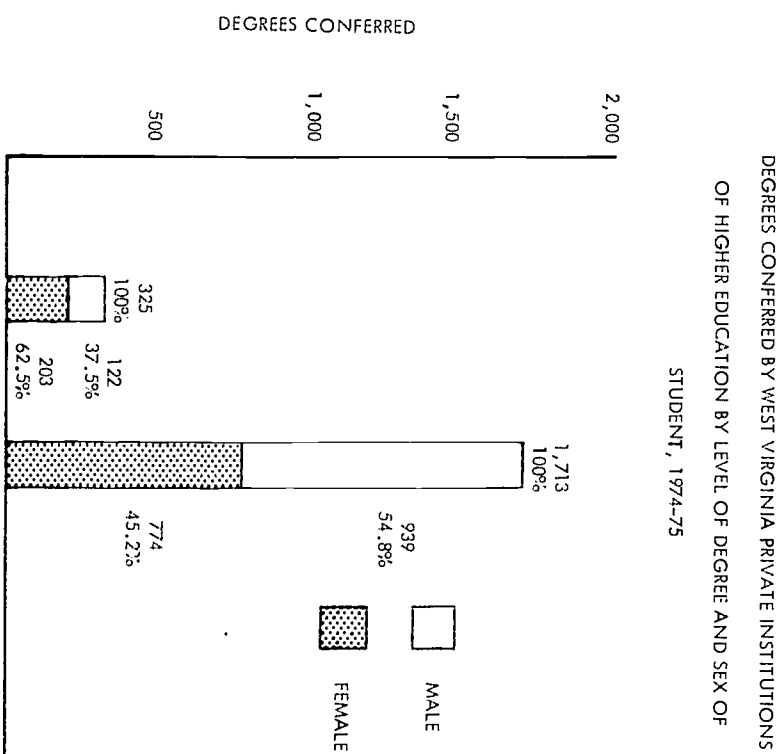

Of the total 2,038 degrees conferred during the 1974-75 academic year by the West Virginia private institutions, 52.1 per cent (1,061) were awarded to males while 47.9 per cent (977) were awarded to females. Of the total 325 associate degrees awarded, females received 62.5 per cent (203) and males 37.5 per cent (122). Of the total 1,713 bachelor's degrees awarded, males received 54.8 per cent (939) and females 45.2 per cent (774).

Of the total 325 associate degrees conferred by the private institutions, 207 or 63.7 per cent were career-technical associate degrees and 118 or 36.3 per cent were pre-baccalaureate associate degrees. Figure Q presents a breakdown by academic area of the total associate degrees conferred.

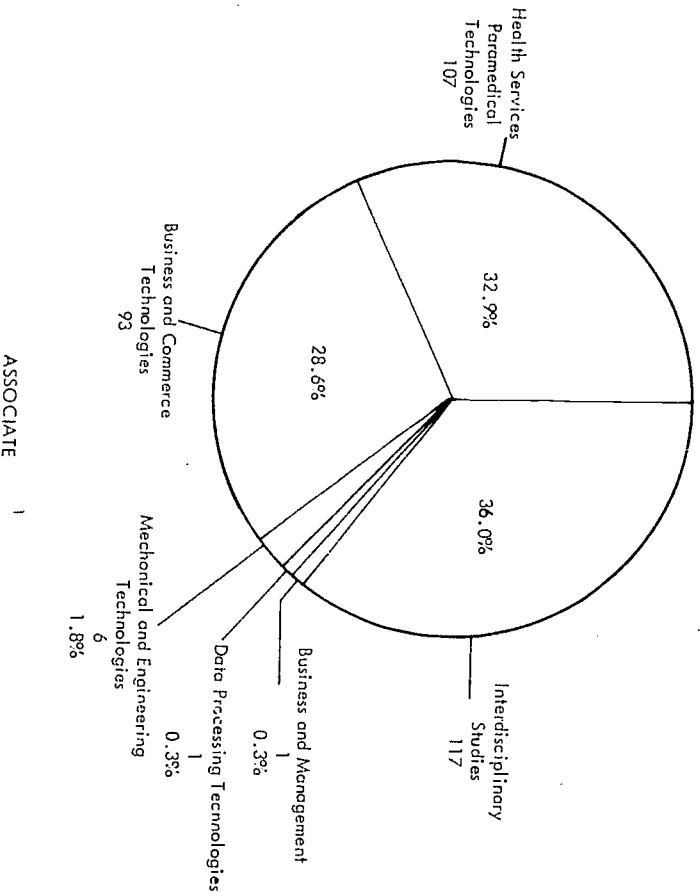
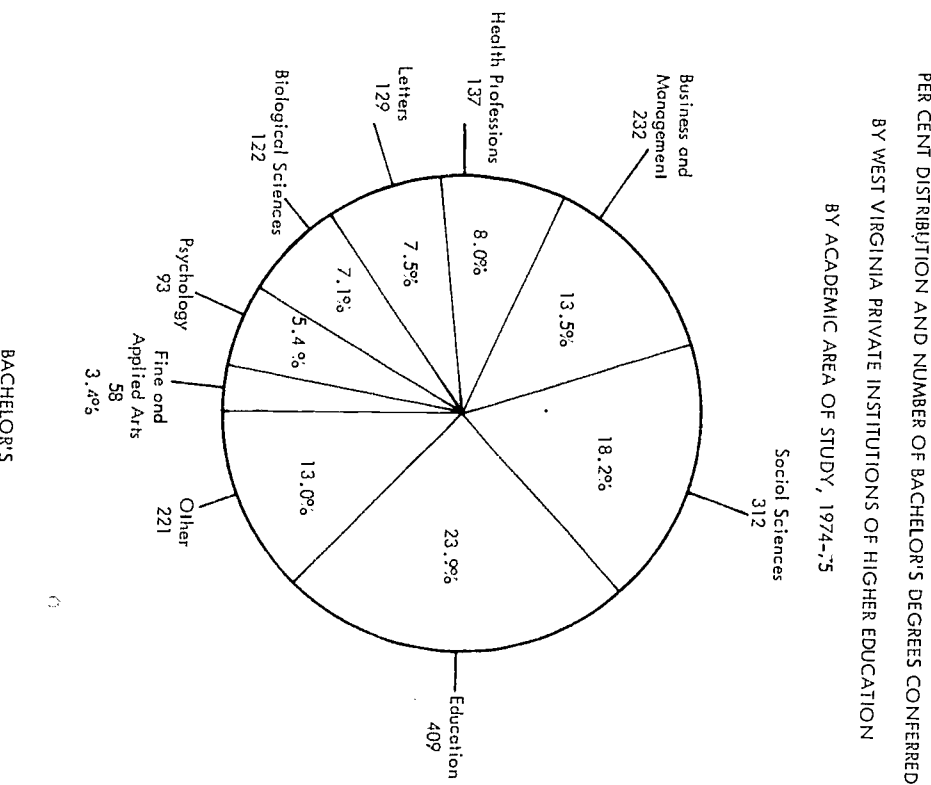


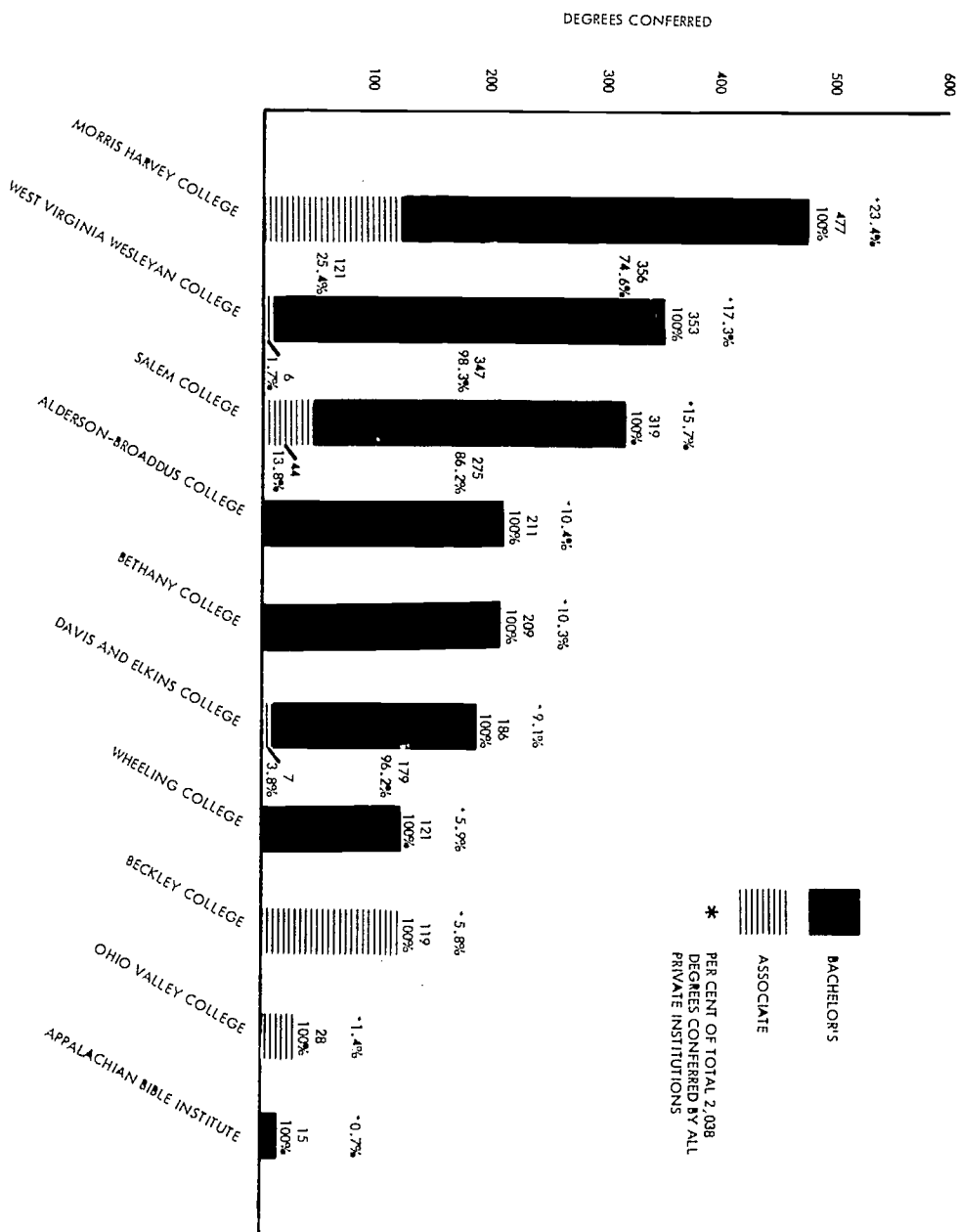

EXPLANATION OF TABLES

The report is divided into three basic sections: All Institutions, Public Institutions, and Private Institutions. The first section presents statewide analyses, while Sections II and III present analyses of the public and private institutions respectively.

Section I is composed of three tables. Table 1 summarizes all degrees conferred by institutions of higher education in West Virginia by level of degree, control of institution, and by sex of the student. Table 2 presents an analysis of all the degrees conferred by level of degree, sex of student, and control and level of the institution. Total degrees conferred are summarized in Table 3 by level of degree, control of institution, and by academic area of study.

Sections II and III are composed of similar tables. Tables 4 (Section II) and 7 (Section III) respectively present a summary of the total degrees conferred by each public and private West Virginia institution of higher education. The data are reported by level of degree and sex of student.

Tables 5 (Section II) and 8 (Section III) are analyses of the number of different degree programs offered and the total degrees conferred by each West Virginia public and private institution by academic area of study and level of degree. The total degrees conferred in each degree program offered by each West Virginia public and private institution by academic area of study, sex of student, and by level of degree are reported in Table 6 (Section II) and 9 (Section III) respectively.

In Tables 5, 6, 8, and 9 the associate degree level is not subdivided into career-technical and pre-baccalaureate degree level classifications. The career-technical programs and degrees are reported under the last six academic areas of study, all of which end in the word technologies; while the pre-baccalaureate degrees and programs are reported under the first 22 academic areas of study ranging from Agriculture and Natural Resources to Interdisciplinary Studies.

When zero or few degrees are reported for an individual degree program the reader should not prematurely conclude that the program is an unproductive one. All of the degree programs offered by each institution are listed. Some are new programs that have not been operative for a sufficient length of time for any degrees to have been produced, while some programs are presently being phased out and, therefore, are naturally producing few degrees. The Appendix presents the definitions of degree levels used in this report.

APPENDIX — DEFINITIONS

Associate Degree

A degree awarded upon completion of at least two but less than four years of work beyond high school.

Career-Technical -- The associate degree programs in the technological and occupational areas that are chiefly designed to prepare for immediate employment.

Pre-Baccalaureate -- The associate degree programs that are designed to provide a two-year general education and/or to be chiefly or wholly creditable toward a bachelor's degree.

Bachelor's Degree

A degree granted upon completion of an educational program requiring at least four but not more than five years of academic work in the liberal arts, sciences, and professional fields.

Doctor's Degree

The highest academic degree in a given discipline or profession, based generally on (a) three or more years of graduate work, (b) satisfaction of a foreign language requirement, and (c) completion of a special study resulting in a dissertation approved by a committee of the faculty.

First Professional Degree

A degree which signifies the completion of the academic requirements for a selected profession, which is based on an educational program which requires at least two academic years of previous college work for entrance and which requires a total of at least six academic years of college work for completion. First professional degrees included in this report are the Doctor of Dental Surgery (D.D.S.), the Doctor of Medicine (M.D.), and Juris Doctor (J.D.).

Master's Degree

A degree customarily granted upon successful completion of one (sometimes two) academic years of work in the liberal arts and sciences beyond the bachelor's degree. The master's degree in professional fields is an advanced degree beyond the first professional but below the Ph. D. degree, such as Master of Orthodontics.
