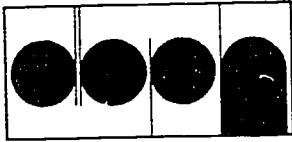

INTRODUCTION

This reference circular presents basic information on radio services for the blind and physically handicapped throughout the country and includes a directory of public (noncommercial) radio stations offering reading or informational program services for the blind and physically handicapped. The directory was compiled by Ms. Cheryl Strange, radio special projects manager, Corporation for Public Broadcasting, from responses to a survey of public radio stations conducted by the Corporation for Public Broadcasting in March 1976.

Two types of radio program services are available to the blind and physically handicapped:

1. Regularly scheduled programs transmitted on the main channel of an AM or FM station (commonly referred to as main or open channel service); and
2. Closed circuit programs (known also as Subsidiary Communications Authorization or SCA programming) transmitted on an FM station's subchannel simultaneously with regular programming on the station's main channel. SCA broadcasts can only be received on a special radio set tuned to the station's subchannel. Note: Most SCA services have eligibility requirements for obtaining a radio receiver. For additional information on SCA services in your local area, contact the local public radio station or agency listed in the directory.

The directory lists SCA and main channel program services alphabetically by state and city. Each listing includes the title and nature of the program service, the address and call letters of the station providing the service (and dial location for main channel services), and program scheduling.

The scheduling of local program services for the blind and physically handicapped may be subject to change. Contact the local public radio stations listed in this directory for further information on their services.
