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AESTRACT	

The annual reports published by American private foundations give comprehensive information to grant-seeking researchers. The Foundation Center has compiled a directory of the names and addresses of the approximately 397 out of 25,000 foundations which publish annual reports. They have also reproduced some 1,304 reports on microfiche. This collection is available at the Foundation Center libraries, or individual microfiche copies may be ordered from the Center. Information about the Center, the directory of foundations, and a listing of the microfiche collection are contained in the report. (KB)

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### WHEN OF THE FOUNDATION ANNUAL REPORT

Does the Foundation You Are Studying Publish an Annual Report? The annual report of a private foundation is usually the best single source of detailed information about the foundation. Unfortunately, this aluable tool is currently available for only about 375 foundations out of a total universe which numbers approximately 25,000. A foundation is required by law to file forms 990-AR and 990-PF annually with the Internal Revenue Service. It is also required to make the 990-AR available for public inspection at its principal office for 180 days after filing the return with IRS. It is not, however, required to publish a separate annual report for distribution to the public. Many persons are under the false impression that all foundations are required to publish annual reports,

and there is some legitimate confusion between the legally required 990-AR (those letters do stand for annual report) and a separately published annual report.

What Is Usually Included? Foundations which do publish reports include the following information: foundation address and telephone number; trustees and officers; statement of objectives and grant application procedures; biographical sketch of the donor and history of the foundation; review of the year's grants with brief descriptions; statement of grants committed for future payment; financial statement with auditor's certification; balance sheet with statement of changes in fund balances; and an enumeration of investments.





Why This Is Such a Valuable Tool. There are many advantages to an annual report over other sources of information about a foundation. It is usually the most current available information. Due to delays caused by IRS processing and filming demands, the time lag in the availability of the foundation information returns (forms 990-AR and 990-PF) is usually significant. Thus, while 1975 returns do not become available until about March of 1977, the 1975 annual reports for foundations which issue them are usually available by mid-1976, and often substantially earlier.

The annual report collects all of the important information about a foundation in one place. The current listing of officers and trustees contained in the report enables the grant seeker to personalize his proposal by addressing it to the most appropriate person on the foundation's board or staff. The report also provides the most complete details regarding the purposes of the grant awards or activities funded. A reading of the foundation's own presentation of its general philosophy, combined with a careful study of its grant-making pattern, enables thorough researchers to positively identify the best potential sources of foundation funding, saving valuable time by eliminating unlikely prospects. Grant seekers should pay special attention to any geographic limitations on a foundation's grant-making activity. In addition to stated restrictions, it is important to note those implied by the geographic locations of recipient organizations. When the grant seeker has identified the best potential grant sources, the detailed descriptions of previous grants allow him to structure his proposal to fit well within the foundation's program while avoiding duplication of projects to which funds have already been committed.

What You Can Learn From the Financial Data. The complete financial picture presented in the annual report allows the grant seeker to properly position his proposal within the grant-making range of the foundation and to eliminate those foundations whose grant-making patterns clearly fall above or below his own request. A researcher interested in a foundation's financial scope, its investments and assets, will find that most foundation annual reports include fiscal data only for the current year, but usually for the year before, and sometimes for additional years as well, making fiscal analysis and trend identification easier.

**Obtaining an Annual Report.** The 397 foundations listed in this booklet publish reports largely out of an interest in keeping the public informed about their activities. Having made the effort to print the report, they are usually more than glad to distribute copies to the public. Most foundations would prefer to receive such requests in written form.

Application Guidelines—Hard-to-Find Information. The annual report is often the only place where important application guidelines and procedures are outlined. The time of year when grant proposals receive board consideration and the preferred format for such proposals are invaluable, and often crucial, pieces of information for every grant seeker.

Using Copies Available at The Foundation Center. This booklet contains foundation addresses so that interested persons can write to any of the foundations listed to request copies of their report. Microfiche reproductions of all the foundation reports can be purchased from The Foundation Center. Grant seekers who do not need to develop their own collection of foundation reports are invited to consult the paper and microfiche copies free of charge in all Foundation Center national and regional library collections. For a list of our 55 library reference collections, see pages 40 and 41.

For the past five years The Foundation Center has been reproducing foundation annual reports on microfiche cards and has made them available in this form to the interested public. As of April 1976 the Center had reproduced 1,304 annual reports on microfiche in 15 series representing 397 different foundations. This is the largest and almost certainly the most complete collection to be found anywhere. Prices for the whole collection, for individual series, and for single microfiche cards will be found on the price schedule which accompanies this booklet. Most of these 1,304 reports in the collection are annual, but a few are biennial. triennial, or occasional. Reports of foundations outside the United States are not included, nor are reports in mimeographed or processed form which are not available for general circulation. Finally, not included are annual reports published only in local newspapers.



The names of the foundations whose reports are included on the microfiche are printed at the top of each card and may be easily read without magnification. To read the text a microform reader is required. Compact desk-top readers are available at relatively low cost. Many public and other libraries have microform readers which may be used without charge. Each card measures 105 by 148.75 mm. (4 in. by 6 in.), and the reduction ratio is 24:1.

The microfiche format makes it possible to maintain in good order and at low cost a file of hundreds of foundation annual reports in a desk drawer. Although it may be desirable to request some reports in the originally printed edition from the foundations, the microfiche set offers the option of avoiding the considerable cost of acquiring, shelving, and keeping in order bulky collections of full-size reports.

The 616 cards thus far in the collection are numbered from FC001 to 616. As new annual reports are received, they too will be put on microfiche and will be numbered from 617 onwards.

In conjunction with the ongoing production of microfiche copies of annual reports, The Foundation Center has prepared the following two cumulative listings. One is alphabetical by foundation name. The second is a listing by microfiche number showing the contents of each card. With these two listings the full text of any given report can be quickly located on the appropriate microfiche card. This is a revision of the listings originally published in 1975. New cumulations will be prepared and published from time to time.

-from The Foundation Directory, Edition 5 Data Bank, including detailed information on the top 2,500 foundations with assets of \$1 million or more. This file is maintained as a permanent computer record and is continuously updated by the Center's staff. \$85 per hour, minimum charge of \$45 (average search estimated at \$45-\$75) -from The Foundation Center National Data Bank, including brief fiscal profiles of all 25,000 foundations taken from Internal Revenue Service information returns. \$85 per hour; minimum charge of \$45.

5) Library Research Service—factual research relating to foundations performed for Associates by our professional staff. \$20 per hour.

The above services are available only to Associates. However, anyone who visits the Center's New York and Washington, D.C. libraries or cooperating regional collections may consult all of the published sources and film records without charge. Visitors to the New York and Washington, D.C. libraries may purchase photocopies or duplicated film records to take with them. Some regional collections also offer photocopy service to users who appear in person. Reference staff are available to assist visitors. Further information on services offered the general public through the libraries and regional collections of The Foundation Center is available upon request.

Private foundations are not eligible to become Associates. They may, however, use the Center's services on an established fee basis or without charge if they are substantial contributors to the Center.

Annual Report—a printed report distributed by a foundation which usually includes a list of officers and staff, a statement of program interests, a complete list of grants awarded during the period covered, a financial statement, and, in some cases, preferred application procedures.

**Aperture Card**—a conventional tabulator card which contains a "window" in which film is mounted. The aperture card may be key-punched to permit mechanical retrieval.

**Computerized Data Bank**—information stored in a computer which is capable of being selectively accessed and manipulated.

**Duplicated Aperture Card**—the end result of card-to-card duplication, a process that will reproduce the film record contained in an aperture card.

Form 990-AR (Annual Report)—required to be filed together with Form 990-PF by every organization which is a private foundation. It provides information on "managers" (officers and trustees or directors), assets, and grants paid and/or committed for future payment. It must be made available for inspection by any citizen during regular business hours at the principal office of the foundation for 180 days after publication of notice of its availability in a local newspaper of general circulation.

Form 990-PF (Private Foundation)—required to be filed by all organizations that are exempt from income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and have the status of "private foundation." It provides fiscal details on receipts and expenditures, compensation of officers, trustees or directors, and highest paid employees, capital gains or losses on investments, and other financial details relating to the foundation's operations.

**Foundation**—*The Foundation Directory, Edition 5* defines a foundation as a "nongovernmental, nonprofit organization, with funds and program managed by its own trustees or directors, and established to maintain or aid social, educational, charitable, religious, or other activities serving the common welfare, primarily through the making of grants. Both charitable trusts and corporations are included."

**Grant Record**—a full description of a foundation grant which has been awarded or authorized. Each grant record includes foundation name and state location, the amount authorized, and recipient name and city and state location. Usually, there is additional information provided outlining the specific purposes for which the grant was made.

**IRS Private Foundation Returns**—Forms 990-PF and 990-AR defined above.

**Keywords**—the most informative words in a title or document (in this case, a grant record) which describe the content of that document; the significant words.

**Microfiche**—sheet of film, usually  $4'' \times 6''$ , containing multiple micro-images in a grid pattern.

**Microfilm**—a film often in the form of a strip 16 millimeters or 35 millimeters wide containing an image greatly reduced in size from the original.



National Collection—a collection of foundation information including aperture cards containing information returns for foundations in all 50 states and multiple copies of Foundation Center publications as well as an extensive collection of reference books and periodicals relating to philanthropy.

**Photo Copy/Hard Copy**—a reproduced paper copy made from microfilm or from a paper original.

**Readers**—equipment capable of enlarging micro-images to a size that can be read with the naked eye. The images are projected on a groundglass screen.

**Reader-Printer**—equipment that in addition to enlarging micro-images to readable size can also make paper copies of selected images.

Regional Collection --- a collection of foun-dation information housed in a public, academic, or foundation library which has agreed to cooperate with The Foundation Center. The relationship between The Foundation Center and its regional collections is voluntary. Regional collections contain the following information: at least one copy of each of the printed and microform publications of The Foundation Center, foundation annual reports on film, aperture cards containing information returns for the foundations in the state in which the regional collection is located (and sometimes in neighboring states) and copies of the booklets. brochures, and order forms of The Foundation Center. Regional Collections are open to all without charge. Ordinarily no appointment is necessary. A list of Foundation Center regional collections follows.
