ABSTRACT

This publication provides data on day-program full-time faculty teaching loads in the Los Angeles community colleges for the fall semesters 1972 through 1975, compared to total statewide averages, and statewide small college and large college averages, by instructional discipline. Faculty load is computed by dividing weekly student contact hours per discipline by full-time equivalent faculty assigned to that discipline. Average faculty load within the Los Angeles Community College District for fall 1975 was 526, compared to a statewide average of 534. District load figures for the individual instructional disciplines for fall 1975 compared to fall 1974 reveal decreases in fifteen areas and increases in eight. Both districtwide and statewide, largest loads occurred in the social science disciplines, while smallest loads occurred in the health professions, foreign languages, letters, and library science. From fall 1972 through fall 1975, average District load was lower than the statewide average in all years but 1974. Since 1972 the average District day load has increased 5.4% while day weekly student contact hours have increased 23%. Load data for the nine individual colleges in the District are included in this report. Additionally, graphic and tabular displays comparing District load with average statewide and average small and large college load by instructional disciplines are presented. (Author/JDS)

ABSTRACT

This publication provides data on day faculty loads in the Los Angeles Community Colleges for the Fall semesters 1972 through 1975. LACCD data were obtained directly from the institutions involved. Comparative statewide information was taken from the annual California Community College Presidents' Study of Teaching Loads, compiled and published by the Foothill/De Anza Community College District in conjunction with Semans, Mueller & Associates.

Average faculty load within the Los Angeles Community College District for Fall 1975 was 526, a 1.1% decrease from the Fall 1974 figure of 532. The Fall 1975 statewide average was 534, a 2.5% increase from the previous year. Statewide, large community college loads increased 2.4% during this period to 544, while small colleges declined slightly (0.4%) to 487.

District load figures for the individual CIDs for Fall 1975 relative to Fall 1974 reveal decreases in 15 areas and increases in eight. Disciplines showing decreases included Law (27.4%), Architecture and Environmental Design (13.5%), Library Science (13.4%), and Apprenticeship (13.2%). Substantial increases occurred in Interdisciplinary Studies (31.5%), Communications (17.7%), Mathematics (10.5%), and Social Science (9.5%).

Comparison of District and statewide loads for individual CIDs show that LACCD averages were lower than State averages in 11 disciplines, most notably in Law, Computer and Information Science, and Biological Sciences. The District was also higher than the State in eleven disciplines; the most significant differences were in Communications and in Library Science.

From Fall 1972 through Fall 1975 average LACCD load was lower than the statewide average in all years but 1974. Since Fall 1972 the average District day load has increased 5.4% while day WSCH have increased 23.0%. Those areas experiencing the greatest load increases in the District are Public Affairs and Services, Interdisciplinary Studies, and Communications. The largest declines have occurred in Law and in Apprenticeship.

Load data for individual colleges in the Los Angeles Community College District are located in the latter section of this report.

It is hoped that the District and statewide data contained in this publication will assist administrators in planning future staffing assignments and in anticipating future budgetary needs in the various academic areas.

GLOSSARY

Census Week is the fourth week of classes, at which time counts of weekly student contact hours and enrollment are taken for state reporting purposes.

Classification of Instructional Disciplines (CID) is a system of four-digit codes used throughout the state for the classification of instructional offerings. The 23 major CID classifications are reported in this publication.

Disciplines are organized sequences of courses covering related subject matter.

Faculty Load or simply Load is found by dividing the weekly student contact hours in a discipline by the number of full-time equivalent faculty assigned to that discipline.

Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Faculty in this report is a college-provided estimate of the number of full-time day faculty teaching each discipline. When an instructor taught more than one discipline, his or her time was apportioned accordingly.

Large Colleges are defined in the Presidents' Study as having 60,000 or more day WSCH.

Small Colleges are defined as having fewer than 60,000 day WSCH.

Weekly Student Contact Hours (WSCH) are computed by multiplying the number of students enrolled in a class at census time by the number of hours per week for which the class meets.

DISTRICT PROFILE

For several years the Foothill Community College District in conjunction with Semans, Mueller & Associates has compiled data on day faculty load patterns in California Community Colleges. These data have been published in the annual Presidents' Study since Fall 1968. LACCD colleges were involved for the first time in Fall 1972.

The current report presents LACCD day faculty load data for Fall 1972 through Fall 1975. These data were furnished by the colleges in the course of their participation in the Presidents' Study. (To avoid the computational errors that sometimes occur in published Presidents' Study figures, all statewide loads were recomputed from WSCH and FTE source data.) Comparative statewide data as published in the Presidents' Study are also included. Data are presented according to Classification of Instructional Discipline (CID) code, a statewide system of categorizing instructional offerings. An improvement in the current publication is the inclusion of load data below the major CID level.

Faculty load as published in the current report is computed by dividing day weekly student contact hours (WSCH) in each discipline by the number of day full-time equivalent (FTE) faculty assigned to that discipline. Total load for a college is determined by dividing the total day WSCH in all disciplines by the total number of day FTE faculty in those disciplines. District and statewide averages are similarly computed from total day WSCH and day FTE figures.

Three types of statewide averages are shown in the current report: the average for all community colleges in the state, the average for "small" community colleges (under 60,000 day WSCH), and the average for "large" community colleges (60,000 or more day WSCH). City, East, Harbor, Pierce, Trade, and Valley are in the large category in our District while Mission, Southwest, and West are in the small category.

Several points must be noted in regard to the current publication. First, statewide variations in computing and reporting load data preclude all but general comparisons between District data and statewide averages. Second, any conclusions about the meaning of a load figure for a particular discipline must recognize the instructional goals and the instructional setting that are involved in that discipline. Third, undue emphasis should not be placed on the large fluctuations often evident in disciplines with relatively small amounts of WSCH and FTE.

Tables 1 through 4 depict day faculty loads for individual LACCD institutions, for the District as a whole, and for community colleges statewide for the Fall semesters 1972 - 1975. Each of the various academic disciplines is listed along the left margin according to its CID number. District and statewide averages in each discipline for Fall 1973 through Fall 1975 are presented graphically in Figures 1 - 3.*

Average faculty load within the Los Angeles Community College District for Fall 1975 was 526, a 1.1% decrease from the Fall 1974 figure of 532. The Fall 1975 statewide average was 534, a 2.5% increase from the previous year. Large community college loads increased 2.4% during the period to 544, while small colleges declined slightly (0.4%) to 487.

District load figures for the individual CIDs for Fall 1975 relative to Fall 1974 reveal decreases in 15 areas and increases in eight. Disciplines showing decreases included Law (27.4%), Architecture and Environmental Design (13.5%), Library Science (13.4%), and Apprenticeship (13.2%). Substantial increases occurred in Interdisciplinary Studies (31.5%), Communications (17.7%), Mathematics (10.5%), and Social Science (9.5%).

* Incomplete reporting in Fall 1972 prevented meaningful graphical presentation of these data.

Comparison of District and statewide loads for individual CIDs show that LACCD averages were lower than State averages in 11 disciplines - most notably in Law, Computer and Information Science, and Biological Sciences. The District was also higher than the State in 11 disciplines; the most significant differences were in Communications and in Library Science.

Figure 4 shows the changes in faculty load for both the District and the State from Fall 1972 through Fall 1975. Average LACCD load was lower than the statewide average in all years but 1974. Since Fall 1972 the average District load has increased 5.4% and the average statewide load 4.9%. Those areas experiencing the greatest growth in the District are Public Affairs and Services, Interdisciplinary Studies, and Communications. The largest declines have occurred in Law and in Apprenticeship.

Figures 5 - 26 present comparisons between the LACCD and the State in each of the 23 major CID areas for the Fall terms 1972 - 1975. Table 5 contains detailed load data for each CID below the major CID level for the same semesters.

Load data for individual colleges in the Los Angeles Community College District will be found in the following section of this report.

State and LACCD Faculty Loads



Figure 3 1975 State and LACCD Faculty Loads





LACCD Average Load vs. State Average Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load


Faculty Load



2100 Public Affairs & Service



Faculty Load







COLLEGE PROFILES

Day faculty load data for the individual Los Angeles Community Colleges are presented in Tables 6 through 14. The tables include load data for Fall 1972 through Fall 1975.

EAST LOS ANGELES COLLEGE

Faculty load data for East are presented in Table 6. East's load figure in Fall 1975 was 479, which ranked sixth in the District. East's load decreased 5.9% between Fall 1974 and Fall 1975.

East experienced increases in load within six disciplines and decreases in ten. Those areas showing the greatest increases were Interdisciplinary Studies (135.7%), Communications (43.5%), and Education (16.3%). Decreases were evident in Foreign Language (-37.1%), Biological Science (-18.8%), and Physical Science (-14.4%).

In Fall 1975 East's highest load was in Interdisciplinary Studies (825), while its lowest load was in Health Professions (306). East's load in Interdisciplinary Studies was the highest in the District for that subject, while its load in Engineering was the smallest in the District.

LOS ANGELES CITY COLLEGE

City's faculty load data are located in Table 7. With a load figure of 528 in Fall 1975, City ranked fifth among the District colleges and slightly higher than the District average. Contrary to the District average, City's average load rose slightly (0.4 %) between Fall 1974 and Fall 1975.

Notable increases occurred in Computer & Information Science (22.5%), Communications (20.2%), and Engineering (17.5%). Nine disciplines experienced declines, including Interdisciplinary Studies (-51.5%), Public Affairs & Services (-31.8%), and Architecture & Environmental Design (-28.3%).

City's highest load in 1975 was in Psychology (762), while its lowest was in Health Professions (259). City had the largest load figures in the District for Computer & Information Science and Fine & Applied Arts.

LOS ANGELES HARBOR COLLEGE

Harbor's faculty load data for the last four years can be found in Table 8. In Fall 1975 Harbor ranked fourth in the District with a load of 534, a 3.8% decline from Fall 1974. Its 1975 load was 1.8% lower than the state large community college average of 544.

Harbor experienced increases in load in nine disciplines in Fall 1975, including Communications (15.4%), Social Science (12.3%), and Public Affairs & Services (10.9%). Decreases were evident in Foreign Languages (-27.9%), Computer & Information Science (-27.8%), Biological Science (-22.9%), and six other disciplines.

Harbor's Fall 1975 load of 938 in Public Affairs & Services was the highest at that college and the highest in the District for any discipline. Harbor's lowest load was in Health Professions (243). Among the individual CIDs, Harbor led all District colleges in Education, Mathematics, and Public Affairs & Services.

LOS ANGELES MISSION COLLEGE

Fall 1975 Faculty load data for Mission College are depicted in Table 9. Mission first began operation in Spring 1975, and Fall 1975 was the first semester in which faculty load were available for this report.

Mission had the lowest faculty load (267) of all the colleges in the District in Fall 1975. Not surprisingly, Mission had the lowest loads in the District in a number of disciplines. Mission's largest load was in Education (674), while its smallest (and the smallest of any LACCD subject load in Fall 1975) was in Physical Science (60).

LOS ANGELES PIERCE COLLEGE

Four-year faculty load data for Pierce College are presented in Table 10.

Pierce's load for Fall 1975 was 583, the highest within the District and 7.6% higher than its load the previous year.

Among the individual CIDs at Pierce, increases (10) significantly outnumbered decreases (7) in 1975. The greatest increases occurred in Interdisciplinary Studies (104.4%), Mathematics (24.8%), and Physical Science (19.0%). The most notable declines occurred in Computer & Information Science (-8.1%), Psychology (-5.6%), and Architecture & Environmental Design (-5.2%).

In Fall 1975 Pierce's largest load was in Biological Science (790) and its smallest was in Health Professions (274). The college had the largest loads in the District in Architecture & Environmental Design, Biological Science, Letters, and Physical Science. Pierce is the only college in the LACCD to offer courses in Agriculture & Natural Resources.

LOS ANGELES SOUTHWEST COLLEGE

Southwest's load data are presented in Table 11. Southwest ranked eighth in the District in Fall 1975 with a college load of 422, a 6.6% increase from Fall 1974. In 1975 Southwest experienced more increases (12) than decreases (6) within individual disciplines. Especially large increases occurred in Architecture & Environmental Design (161.0%), Public Affairs & Services (141.2%), and Computer & Information Science (56.1%). The largest declines were in Communications (-27.6%), Engineering (-24.8%), and Library Science (-21.1%).

Despite its decrease, Library Science still had the largest load (870) of any CID at Southwest in Fall 1975. The lowest load figure was in Communications (110). Southwest had the largest load of all District colleges in Library Science, and the lowest loads in Communications, Education, and Health Professions.

LOS ANGELES TRADE-TECHNICAL COLLEGE

Faculty load data for Trade are shown in Table 12. Trade's average load of 536 ranked third among the District colleges in 1975, yet still represented a decrease of 8.8% from 1974. Trade had the largest average faculty load of all LACCD colleges from 1972 through 1974. Eight disciplines at Trade showed increases between 1974 and 1975 while 12 experienced declines. The greatest increases occurred in Library Science (153.5%), Communications (32.7%), and Psychology (18.5%). The most significant decreases were in Education (-34.9%), Foreign Language (-33.4%), and Law (-31.0%).

Trade's largest load was in Home Economics (688) and its smallest in Health Professions (377). Trade's load in Home Economics was the largest of any District college. Its load in Health Professions, though the smallest load at Trade, was still the largest in the District for that discipline.

LOS ANGELES VALLEY COLLEGE

Valley's faculty load data for 1972-75 are shown in Table 13. Valley had the second largest load (558) among the Los Angeles Community Colleges in Fall 1975, 8.1% higher than the Fall 1974 load figure.

Load increases (13) outnumbered decreases (7) among individual subjects in Fall 1975. The largest growth was in the areas of Psychology (45.4%), Health Professions (39.9%), and Communications (28.5%). Most notable among the declines were Law (-56.9%), Interdisciplinary Studies (-27.2%), and Architecture & Environmental Design (-25.4%).

The largest load at Valley in Fall 1975 was in Psychology (871), while the smallest was in Law (233). Valley had the largest loads of any District colleges in Business & Management, Communications, Engineering, Psychology, and Social Science. Valley had the lowest load in the District in Law.

WEST LOS ANGELES COLLEGE

West's faculty load data are contained in Table 14. West's Fall 1975 load of 472 was third smallest in the District, and a 14.0% decrease from Fall 1974.

That decrease was the largest experienced by any college within the LACCD in 1975.

Among the individual disciplines at West, declines (12) far outnumbered increases (4). Law had the largest load at West in Fall 1975 (850), while Architecture & Environmental Design (171) had the smallest load. West's loads in Foreign Language and Law were the largest in the District, while its loads in Architecture & Environmental Design and Library Science were the lowest. Increases occurred in Engineering (40.6%), Biological Science (22.8%), and Foreign Language (11.0%), and Education (7.4%). The sharpest declines occurred in Architecture & Environmental Design (-36.7%), Business & Management (-35.5%), and Communications (-33.2%).
