#### ABSTRACT

This Area Health Education Centers (AHEC) directory catalogues the Federal, State, local, and private decentralized professional health education programs initiated in direct response to the recommendations of the 1970 "Carnegie Commission Report of Higher Education and the Nation's Health." The introductory section briefly presents the history of the area health education concept, the identification and classification of AHEC-type programs, AHEC classification prototypes, and definitions of the five elements which comprise these classifications. Following the introduction, maps indicating the geographic distribution of AHEC and AHEC-type programs are presented. The remainder of the directory identifies 140 AHEC and AHEC-type programs throughout the country, which are located in 38 states. Each entry is listed by State, and includes the title of the program, classification, funding, executive director, and program address and telephone number. (SH)

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# FOREWORD

The Area Health Education Center Directory represents the first attempt on the part of the federal government to systematically identify all known AHEC type programs. It includes information on federal, state, local and privately funded programs in decentralized health professions education throughout the country.

The development of the area health education center concept was the result of recommendations made by the Carnegie Commission Report of Higher Education and the Nation's Health (1970) which concluded that "the crisis in the delivery of health care in the United States reflects the combined influences of five interrelated and overlapping factors: (1) unmet needs for health care. (2) rising expectations of the population for universal access to care. (3) critical shortages in, and inefficient utilization of, health manpower, (4) ineffective financing, and (5) rapidly rising costs."

By September 1972 eleven area health education centers had been funded through the National Institutes of Health under the Comprehensive Health Manpower Training Act of 1971 for the purpose of "improving the distribution, supply, quality, utilization and efficiency health personnel and the health services delivery system . . .". In 1974 administrative responsibility for this program was transferred to the Bureau of Health Manpower (BHM), formerly the Bureau of Health Resources Development (BHRD). Since then the Bureau has maintained a leadership role in working with other federal, state and local agencies supporting AHEC-type activities to ensure an understanding of the dynamics of the total AHEC effort across the country.

In response therefore to wide spread interest in AHEC-type programs, this Directory was developed to serve as a guide for government agencies and other interested groups concerned with the existing void of AHEC-type activities in both rural and urban areas.

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# INTRODUCTION

#### PURPOSE

The AHEC Directory catalogues the federal, state, local and private decentralized professional health education programs initiated in direct response to the recommendations of the 1970 Report of the Carnegie Commission on Higher Education, Higher Education and the Nation's Health: Policies for Medical and Dental Education.

# HISTORY OF THE AREA, HEALTH EDUCATION CONCEPT

This report called for the creation of University Based Health Science Centers (HSCs) aimed at expanding the programs for educating physicians and dentists with particular emphasis on the availability of primary care. In conjunction with these centers, satellite facilities or Area Health, Education Centers (AHECs) were also recommended for the purpose of serving the medically underserved areas between the University Medical Center and the AHEC. The community hospital(s) was to serve as the focal point of the AHEC, providing clinical, residency fund continuing education-type programs through contractual arrangements with the "University Medical Center".

Subsequently authorized by the Comprehensive Health Manpower Training Act of 1971, an AHEC or AHEC-type project is presently defined as "an organized effort of health manpower education and training primarily to increase the supply, or improve distribution and trailization of health manpower in shortage areas, usually through a consortum linking educational and clinical institutions, usually multi-disciplinary and serving a defined geographical area." Under the auspices of the Bureau of Health Manpower (BIM), Health Resources Administration, DHEW, eleven AHECs were funded in 1972. Since then, the Veterans Administration (VA), the DHEW Regional Medical Program (RMP), individual States, foundations and secondary educational institutions have funded AHEC-type programs possessing characteristics similar to the BHM AHEC prototype.

# IDENTIFICATION AND CLASSIFICATION AHEC-TYPE PROGRAMS

Because of the increasing interest in the number and type of decentralized professional health education program, C.F. Pagan Associates, Inc., was contracted by the brocky of Health Manpower to identify and classify

each of the AHEC and AHEC type programs throughout the country. AHEC program data was gathered from direct inquiries to federal, state and local agencies, national health organizations, hospital associations, consortium groups, universities, and knowledgeable individuals requesting information required for the Directory. To ensure accuracy, each project director was given the opportunity to revise and comment on the data to be included in the Directory.

Although funding for some programs may have terminated, the information contained within the Directory is valid as of July 1, 1975.

Based on an initial examination of the data, including a literature review, C.E. Pagan Associates, Inc. identified several AHEC-type models: the "Community Based Consortium" model, the "Veterans Administration Hospital" model and the "Statewide Network" (often with a Central Coordinating Unit or Statewide Resource Center). However, a review of actual program data revealed considerable diversity within programs which were, nominally, examples of these models. In order to finalize tentative criteria for differentiating AHEC and AHEC-type programs, a series of consultant workshops was held to gain the input of a broad spectrum of health profession education experts. Based on the data processed the following eight classifications were developed.

# DEFINITIONS OF THE FIVE ELEMENTS WHICH COMPRISE THESE CLASSIFICATIONS ARE

# 1. CARNEGIE MODEL CONSORTIUM

A consortium of health care providers and educational institutions with linkage to a central medical school university health science center which provides central coordination and is responsible for developing cooperative educational programs with and among institutions at the local level.

# 2. COMMUNITY BASED CONSORTIUM

A health manpower education consortium of local health care providers and educational institutions which is responsible for coordinating and developing cooperative educational programs among institutions at the local level. Such a consortium may include universities, colleges or medical schools within the local area but no single institution has central responsibility for program direction.

# CLINICAL EDUCATION ACTIVITIES

Any training or academic instruction which leads to the attainment of a degree, certificate or license in a heattr profession. This includes courses

offered in an academic setting and courses offered outside academic settings which fulfill the requirements for a degree or certificate. Also included are residencies and clinical placements or preceptorships.

# 4. CONTINUING EDUCATION ACTIVITIES-

Any training, course work or instruction offered to health professionals to improve or expand their skills. Such training generally does not lead to the attainment of a degree or certificate.

# 5. EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES

Such activities include a wide range of education related activities which are not training per se, but which are directed toward improving educational programs or resources or the availability and accessibility of same. This includes public or constanter education, counseling, recruitment and retention activities, educational research, planning or evaluation, development of information services, technical assistance to educational programs, administrative and managerial assistance, coordination of educational resources and programs, and other/related activiti

# OBSERVATIONS

CEPA identified 140 AHEC and AHEC-type programs throughout the country. These are located in 38 States. Overall, no large portion of the country is without AHEC-type activities. New England, the Mid-Atlantic, Southern, Mid-Western, Southwestern and Northwestern areas all have significant AHEC activities. Although individual states or counties may not be involved directly in AHEC-type programs; nonetheless, no major section of the country has failed to implement decentralized programs in professional health education.

In reviewing those AHEC and AHEC-type programs funded via federal grants, CEPA identified 11 BHM funded AHEC programs, 8 VA funded AHEC-type programs, and 92 RMP funded AHEC-type programs. The following maps indicate the geographic distribution of these projects. Also included in the map section is a geographic distribution of the Carnegie Commission's suggested 128 AHEC locations.






