MISSION STATEMENT

THE MISSION OF THE MEYER CHILDREN'S REHABILITATION INSTITUTE IS TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR CHILDREN WHO DURING THE CRITICAL YEARS OF THEIR DEVELOPMENT ARE FACED WITH LONG TERM HANDICAPS OF THE MIND OR BODY. THIS MISSION, BY ITS VERY NATURE, REQUIRES THAT THE INSTITUTE WORK CLOSELY WITH ALL PEOPLE AND AGENCIES SERVING CHILDREN, RECOGNIZING THAT OUR FINEST EFFORTS, BE THEY IN TEACHING, SERVICE, OR RESEARCH, WOULD BE OF SMALL BENEFIT UNLESS MULTIPLIED MANY TIMES THROUGH THE LABORS OF OUR STUDENTS AND COLLEAGUES AND ALL WHO ARE CONCERNED FOR THE WELFARE OF CHILDREN.

INSTITUTE GOALS

MCRI'S FIRST PRIORITY GOALS IS TO PROVIDE AN EXEMPLARY INTERDISCIPLINARY EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAM FOR THE PROFESSIONAL, TECHNICAL, AND DIRECT CARE PERSONNEL NEEDED IN PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN WITH HANDICAPS. IN ESSENCE, OTHER GOALS MUST BE SECONDARY TO THIS EDUCATIONAL GOAL.

THE SECOND PRIORITY GOAL OF THE INSTITUTE IS TO DEVELOP, PROVIDE, AND DEMONSTRATE THE EXEMPLARY ARRAY OF SERVICES NEEDED TO MEET THE INTERDISCIPLINARY EDUCATION AND TRAINING OBJECTIVES. THIS INCLUDES THE DEVELOPMENT AND EVALUATION OF NEW, INNOVATIVE WAYS TO PROVIDE NEEDED SERVICES. SERVICE NEEDS MUST BE RESPONSIVE AND BE DETERMINED BY THE EDUCATIONAL NEEDS.
