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ABSTRACT

The report is divided into two sections: credit course enrollment (headcount) and degrees granted. The first provides data for the individual institutions and institutional types of the State University as well as system-wide data. The data in this section are for the fall term of each year and are arrayed by student load and level (graduate/undergraduate). Degrees granted data are provided for the entire system as well as for individual institutions and institutional types; degrees granted over the entire 12-month period are reported. INTRODUCTION

This report is a reissue of our Trends in Enrollment and Degrees Granted, 1948-1974. The current report covers the period from 1948 to 1976.

The report is divided into two major sections: Credit Course Enrollment (Headcount), and Degrees Granted.

The Credit Course Enrollment section provides headcount enrollment data for the individual institutions and institutional types of the State University as well as system-wide data. The enrollment data in this section is for the fall term of each year and is arrayed by student load (full-time/part-time) and student level (undergraduate/graduate).

Degrees granted data is also provided for the State University system as a whole, as well as for individual institutions and institutional types. Unlike the enrollment data, which is point-in-time data, the degrees granted information covers all degrees awarded over a twelve-month period. The twelve-month census period for degrees granted is from the first of July of a given year through June thirtieth of the following year. Data in this section is provided separately for each degree type; viz., Associate, Bachelor's, Master's, Doctoral and First-professional Degrees. It should be remembered that the information presented here is a count of degrees conferred and does not include other formal awards such as undergraduate certificates and diplomas, and graduate certificates.

In interpreting enrollment and degrees granted data over a period of time, one of the major considerations to be taken into account is changes in the numbers of institutions which comprise the State University of New York. For example, in examining the recent enrollment history of the University, it is important to know that as of July 1, 1975, the Community Colleges sponsored by the New York City Board of Higher Education ceased to be under the program of the State University of New York and became solely a part of the City University of New York. Because this change involves a substantial number of students, two special tables (1A and 65A) have been added to this report. Table 1A provides system-wide enrollment data but with the enrollment component from Community Colleges sponsored by the New York City Board of Higher Education systematically removed; Table 65A provides the analogous information for degrees granted. In order to provide comprehensive information regarding the institutional history of the State University of New York in a convenient format, this report contains, in the Appendix, a chronology of dates of establishment for institutions of the State University.

This report should serve as a convenient reference for basic data regarding the enrollment and degrees granted history of the State University. As is always the case, the significance of data depends on the needs and priorities
