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## ABSTRACT

THIS IS THE SEVENTEENTH in a series of catalogues of documents of interest to teachers and researchers in foreign languages and linguistics that have been processed into the ERIC (Educational Resources Information Center) system. Lists Number 1 through 12 were published in *Foreign Language Annals*, starting with the December 1968 issue and ending in May 1974. Lists 13, 14, 15, and 16 appeared in the March 1975, November 1975, April 1976, and November 1976 issues of *The Modern Language Journal*, respectively. List 18 will appear in the November 1977 issue.

The documents cited in the present list appeared in the monthly ERIC abstract journal *Resources in Education (RIE)* from January through June 1976. The list is compiled from all of the *RIE* citations published during that period, not only those contributed by the Clearinghouse on Languages and Linguistics. The categories in this list have been reorganized; the list's structure no longer remains strictly parallel to that of the *ACTFL Annual Bibliography*. The major headings now correspond for the most part to the scope areas of the Clear-

inghouse. Several subcategories have been established which provide parallel listings under the major headings Foreign Language Education, Bilingual Bicultural Education, and English as a Second Language. Examples of such subcategories are Materials, Methods, Program Description and Evaluation, Research and Testing, and Teacher Training. There were no FLES documents in this list. In the future, FLES will be a subcategory of Foreign Language Education.

This list continues the entry format adopted in List 14: author's name, title of the work, source, date (if available), length, and ED number. Full résumés for each title may be located in *Resources in Education* by ED numbers, indicated on the spine of each issue.
