ABSTRACT This booklet presents 1976-77 statistics on tuition fees, faculty salaries, and administrative salaries for American and Canadian private schools that belong to the National Association of Independent Schools, based on data from questionnaires completed by 675 schools. The tuition fees section presents data on tuition ranges and medians for boys', girls', and coeducational schools, respectively, in seven different regions of the United States and in Canada. The faculty salaries section reports the salary ranges and medians for beginning teachers in different types of schools and for experienced teachers in different geographic regions and different types of schools. The administrative salaries section reports salary ranges and medians for 12 different administrative positions in boys', girls', and coeducational schools, respectively. (JG)

NAIS MEMBER SCHOOL TUITION FEES, FACULTY SALARIES, AND ADMINISTRATIVE SALARIES, 1976-77

With this publication, we continue our previous course of reporting NAIS annual statistics in two parts: statistics on tuition fees, faculty salaries, and administrative salaries in the fall, and operations and membership statistics in the winter. This report is compiled from data supplied by the department of NAIS member schools who responded to the membership information and tuition and salary information questionnaires distributed in May.

We are indebted to all the principals and individuals who provided the data for the summaries that follow. They have answered questions of which special analysis of any

part of these data, please let us know. As always, each school's figures will be kept entirely confidential.

I. TUITION FEES

This section presents the ranges and medians of 1976-77 tuition fees of 675 NAIS member schools in the United States and Canada. The tables present figures for boys', girls', and coeducational schools in seven regions of the United States plus Canada. Where there were too few returns to justify a separate listing for each region, we grouped two or more regions together.

Schools were asked to indicate the percentage increase in the fee for their highest grade since 1975-76. Opposite the highest

grade in each table, the number of schools reporting an increase, and the averages of percentage increases reported, are shown. The average of percentage increases this year is almost the same as last year, or 8.6 per cent. Of the 675 schools reporting, 636, or 94 per cent, recorded an increase over 1975-76. The corresponding figure for 1974-75 was 93 per cent.

II. FACULTY SALARIES

The pattern of previous years has been followed, except that Canadian schools are shown separately because a sufficient number of schools reported, and their salaries are appreciably higher than those in the United States.

Reading Table 1. Table 1 reports the cash salaries being paid this year to new teachers holding a B.A. degree and having no previous teaching experience. The highest beginning salary reported by any school this year is \$13,229

Reading Table 2. Table 2 shows variations in median salaries for different regions of the country. The geographic breakdown is the same as that used for tuition fees, above. Coeducational day schools were selected for this illustration because they form the largest subgroup in the membership.

Reading Table 3. Using girls' day schools

as an illustration, the range of highest salaries (first column) is \$8,500 to \$19,800; in other words, at the bottom of the scale is one school having a highest salary of \$8,500, and at the top a school having a highest salary of \$19,800. The top 10 per cent of all salaries reported in this category range from \$17,500 to \$19,800. The same explanation applies to median and lowest salaries. The median figure of \$12,810 needs no explanation. The mid 50 per cent figures show the range from the lowest salary in the third quartile to the highest salary in the second quartile. Finally, each category in the table shows the percentage of increase in medians over those of five years ago, 1971-72.

Analyzing Table 3. The figures in Table 3 show an average increase in median salaries of 3.6 per cent for all types of schools over 1975-76. It is interesting to note that this is less than last year's average increase, 4.8 per cent.

This section consists of three tables: girls', boys', and coeducational schools. For each category, breakdowns are provided according to size and type (day and boarding) of school. The figures presented are cash salaries only. As a reference for those who may be interested in general information on perquisites and

schools as an illustration, the range of school heads' salaries (second column), school size 201-350, is \$16,800 to \$40,000; in other words, at the bottom of the scale is one head having a salary of \$16,800, and at the top a head having a salary of \$40,000. The top 10 per cent of all salaries reported in this

category range from \$33,000 to \$40,000. The median salary is \$22,150. A comparison with median figures of a year ago shows an average increase of 6.1 per cent for all schools. Median salaries in girls' schools increased 6.1 per cent; in boys' schools, 5.4 per cent; and in coeducational schools, 6.5 per cent.
