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ABSTRACT

This quarterly bulletin provides brief annotations for tests recently acquired by the Educational Testing Service Collection. Book Report Testing Manual: Senior High School; c1968; Grades 10-12; Perfection Form Company.

A series of fifty-one tests on seventeen types of literature. For each literary type there is a test for grades 10, 11, and 12. Subtests are Poetry in General, Dramatic Poetry, Narrative Poetry, Lyric Poetry, Short Story, Fiction, Historical Fiction, Science Fiction, One-Act Play, Full-Length Play, General Non-Fiction, Informal Essay, Formal Essay, Biography, Autobiography, Travel, and Mythology.

College English Placement Test by Oscar M. Haugh and James I. Brown, c1969, College Freshmen, Houghton Mifflin Company.

Useful as an objective guide for the placement of freshmen in English composition courses. Test measures understanding of the basic structure of English and the ability to use the language effectively. An optional essay section is included.

Content Evaluation Series. Language Arts Tests. Form 1 by Ela Graser, Leonard Freyman, Ruth Reeves, and Kellogg W. Hunt, c1969; Grades 7-9; Houghton Mifflin Company.

Subtests are Language Ability, Composition and Literature. The "Language Ability Test" measures knowledge of principles of sentence construction. Effective manipulation of the language is assessed by the "Composition Test." The "Literature Test" measures the ability to identify the major types of literature and differentiate among them, and the depth and breadth of the student's feeling for literature.

Content Evaluation Series: Mathematics: Form 1 by Gilbert Ulmer, c1969; Grades 7-9; Houghton Mifflin Company.

Test is designed to measure the student's competence in dealing with the quantitative situations of daily living and his readiness for high school mathematics. Emphasis is placed on the application of facts and principles.

Content Evaluation Series: Science Tests: Form 1 by Ernestine O'Connell, c1969; Grades 7-9; Houghton Mifflin Company.

Test is designed to measure the student's ability to handle the "everyday" vocabulary of science and to measure the student's understanding of basic concepts. Subtests are Biological Science, Physical Science, and Earth Science.

Gates-MacGinitie Reading Tests: Survey F by Arthur I. Gates and Walter H. MacGinitie; c1969; Grades 10-12; Teachers College Press.

Subscores are Speed and Accuracy, Vocabulary, and Comprehension. Test can be administered to adults having a high school education. Survey F is the hand-scored edition.

Library Sources and Skills Test, Test II; c1967; Grades 9-12; Perfection Form Company.

Areas covered are the *Readers Guide to Periodicals*, terms used in discussing books and manuscripts, the Dewey Decimal Classification System, research organization, reference materials, *Webster's Third International Dictionary*, encyclopedia, periodicals and the card catalog.

Library Sources and Uses of Information, Test III; c1967; Grades 9-12; Perfection Form Company.

Includes sections on alphabetizing, the Dewey Decimal Classification System, periodicals, the card catalog, reference books, the *Reader's Guide*, identifying resources and using sources of information.

Library Survey Test; Test I; c1967; Grades 9-12; Perfection Form Company.

Designed to assess general knowledge of and the ability to use the library. Areas covered are periodicals, oral and written reports, the Dewey Decimal System, the dictionary, and reference books.

A Look at Literature; c1968-1969; Grades 4-6; Cooperative Tests and Services; Educational Testing Service.

Designed to measure interpretive response to imaginative prose and poetry. Test was developed under the joint sponsorship of the Research Foundation of the National Council of Teachers of English and Educational Testing Service.

Newberry Medal Award Tests (1922-1968); Perfection Form Company.

A series of tests which have been developed for the forty-seven titles selected for the Newberry Medal Award. (The John Newberry Award is presented annually by the Children's Services Division of the American Library Association for the year's most distinguished contribution to children's literature.)

A teacher's rating scale for the evaluation of the social competency of young children.

Comprehensive Manual for Use with the Luther Hospital Sentence Completions, Nursing Sentence Completions, Nurse Attitudes Inventory, Forms I and II, and Empathy Inventory by John R. Thurston, Helen L. Brunclik, and John F. Feldhusen, c1970; Nursing Research Associates.

Illinois Ratings of Character in Physical Education by B. Everard Blanchard, c1969, Grades 9-12, Western Psychological Services.

Provides a method of measuring the presence of nine character traits (leadership, positive physical qualities, positive mental qualities, self-control, cooperation, social action standards, ethical social qualities, efficiency, and sociability) and their related trait reactions in students participating in physical education activities. Can be used in measuring progress and effectiveness of physical education programs in building character.

Preprimary Profile by Herbert J. Schiff and Myles I. Friedman, c1966, Preschool Youngsters, Science Research Associates, Inc.

Designed to provide teachers with information about the child's abilities, previous experiences, and interests. The parent is asked to answer questions about his child.

Psychological Data Card, c1969; Psychologists and Educators Press.

Used for recording personal data, test results, individual and group psychotherapy information on clients.

Pupil Behavior Inventory by Robert D. Vinter, Rosemary C. Sarri, Darrell J. Vorwaller, and Walter E. Schafer, c1966; Grades 7-12; Campus Publishers.

Provides five scores. Classroom Conduct, Academic Motivation and Performance, Socio-Emotional State, Teacher Dependence, and Personal Behavior.

Miscellaneous, Sensory-Motor, Unidentified:

Dennis Visual Perception Scale by Royce Dennis and Margaret Dennis, c1969, Grades 1-6, Western Psychological Services.

A paper-and-pencil test for screening children for perceptual handicaps which can affect learning.

Holmgren Color Test; not dated; Graham-Fjeld Surgical Company.

Tests the ability to discriminate between colors and shades of colors.

Inter-Person Perception Test by F.K. Heussenstamm, and R. Hoepfner, c1969; Monitor.

Designed to assess individual and group status on interpersonal perception or social cognition. Test can be used to assess changes accompanying sensitivity training, counseling, and psychotherapy. Also can be used in selecting personnel who must deal with people or in sociological and psychological research. Items have been constructed for different racial or ethnic groups.

Kindergarten Test Chart; Not dated; Kindergarten and Early First Grade; Graham-Field Surgical Company.

A vision screening test for youngsters who cannot read or who have reading difficulties. Pictures and symbols are used rather than letters.

WPS Two-Copy Personnel Interview Resume Report; c1966; Western Psychological Services.

Provides a structured record of the interview with employee.

Personality, Interests, Attitudes and Opinions:

The Brook Reaction Test of Interests and Temperament: Experimental Edition by A.W. Heim, K.P. Watts, and V. Simmonds; c1969; Ages 13 and over; National Foundation for Educational Research in England and Wales, England.

Test consists of eighty ambiguous stimulus words having two or more meanings. Subject is asked to make an immediate verbal association. Responses are classified into twenty-two interest areas: Aesthetic; Business, Clothing and Appearance, Dances, Social Functions; Entertainment, Food and Drink, Agricultural; Humanitarian; Intellectual; Practical ("Do-It-Yourself"), Literary; Legal; Military; Outdoor Activities; People, Political; Religious; Biological Sciences; Physical Sciences; Secretarial; Sport; and Travel. In addition, the test provides five indices of temperament.

Myokineticische Psychodiagnostik by E. Mira Y. López; c1965; Ages 10 - Adults; Verlag Hans Huber, Switzerland.

A projective personality test. The person is asked to draw lines of various types. The test is based on the premise that an analysis of expressive movements provides information which can be used in the diagnosis of personality traits.

Miscellaneous, Sensory-Motor, Unidentified:

Ishihara's Design Charts for Colour-Blindness: Unlettered Persons by Shinobu Ishihara; c1970; Ages 4 and over; Isshinkai Foundation, Japan.

Test designed for use with children four to six and others who cannot read. Simple geometric shapes are used rather than numbers or letters. Test is published in English. U.S. and Canadian distributor is Graham-Field Surgical Company, Inc.

Organizational Styles Inventory; c1966; Adults; Managerial Effectiveness, Ltd., Canada.

Can be used in determining how an employee views the stylistic features of those in the company's hierarchy, which is a reflection of the company's philosophy. The inventory is based on the 3-D Theory of Managerial Effectiveness. (There are two main elements in a managerial situation: the task to be done and the relationships with others involved.)

Systematic Interview Guide: Number 1: Birth to Five Years, by D. H. Stott; c1967, University of London Press, Ltd., Great Britain.

A form for systematically obtaining and recording information from the mother about the child's early development.

Systematic Interview Guide. Number II. Prenatal by D. H. Støtt, c1967, Adults, University of London Press, Ltd., Great Britain.

Provides a method of systematically obtaining and recording information obtained from the patient about the medical aspects of her pregnancy and her attitudes toward pregnancy.

Test de Comprehension de la Vente by Martin M. Bruce, c1966; Adults, Editions Editest, Belgium.

French adaptation of the *Sales Comprehension Test*.
