ABSTRACT

This summary of financial aids provided to Los Angeles City College students from 1973-1978 considers the four major vehicles for federal aid: (1) Basic Educational Opportunity Grants (BEOG); (2)\National Direct Student Loans (NDSL); (3) Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants (SEOG); and (4) College Work Study (CWS). Data tables outline amounts of aid, numbers of recipients, average amount of aid per recipient, and sex/ethnic characteristics of recipients. During the five years studied nearly 20,000 financial / aids totaling over \$10,000,000 had been provided for LACC students. Amounts of aid from NDSL and CWS increased slightly over the period, whereas assistance under BEOG grew from about 400 students receiving \$100,000 in 1973-74 to over 5,000 students receiving nearly \$3,000,000 in 1977-78. Data indicate that female recipients outnumbered male recipients in about the same ratio as their representation in the college population. Blacks (40% of the student population) received slightly over half of the aids, while white, Hispanic, and Asian students followed in that order, each showing percentages somewhat below their percentage in the college population. PURPOSE OF THE STUDY

This study was prepared at the request of the Assistant Dean of Administrative Services. Its purpose is to provide a summary of financial aids provided to LACC students over the past five years.

PROCEDURE OF THE STUDY

Records available in the LACC Financial Aids Office were examined and provided the basic data for the study. The study was limited to the four major vehicles for federal aid, viz, (1) Basic Educational Opportunity Grant (BEOG), (2) National Direct Student Loan (NDSL), (3) Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (SEOG), and (4) College Work Study (CWS), Major sources of detailed information were reports prepared for USOE (OE Form 1152-1, replaced by 646) which required detailed information on NDSL, BEOG, and CWS. Similar detailed information was not available for BEOG.

Appreciation is expressed to Financial Aids Coordinator Ed Mitchell for his considerable assistance in providing data.







Apparently in 1973-74, "Unduplicated Total" was taken to mean those students who received one aid only, while in later years it meant all students who received one or more aids. That is, from 1974 on, unduplicated total means number of people, duplicated total means number of aids.

OBSERVATIONS AND CONCLUSIONS

Following are some observations on the findings of the study:

- (1) During the past five years nearly 20,000 financial aids totaling over \$10,000,000 have been provided for LACC students.
- (2) Amounts of aid from NDSL, and CWS have increased slightly over the five year period, but assistance under the BEOG program has grown from about 400 students receiving \$100,000 in 1973-4 to over 5,000 students receiving nearly 3,000,000 in 1977-78.
- (3) Available data indicate that female aids outnumber male aids in about the same ratio as female/male ratio in the college population. With regard to ethnic distribution, Blacks receive slightly over half of the aids (compared with about-40% Blacks in the college population), while White, Hispanic, and Asian follow in that order in each group showing percents somewhat below college population percents.
