



## PROFESSIONAL PREPARATION DIRECTORY FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PHYSICAL EDUCATION

#### INTRODUCTION

The National Association of Sport and Physical Education is proud to present the first Professional Preparation Directory of Elementary School Physical Education made possible by the work of its Elementary School Physical Education Council.

Better physical education programs for elementary and pre-primary children - this professional goal has been the focal point for unprecedented interest during the past decade. With this surge in interest, of course, came a great demand for specialists prepared to teach children. The profession, however, was unprepared to meet the demands. Until the 1970s only a small percentage of elementary schools had physical education teachers as full-time staff or as resource persons. 1,2

Several institutions of ligher education began to make changes and numerous others sought help. A foresighted committee developed <u>Guidelines</u> in 1970 which are still very sound today. This was followed by a position paper on quality elementary school physical education programs stating the need for qualified physical education teachers full-time or at least as resource persons. A conference was held in 1972 at Lake of Ozarks, Missouri involving representatives of both dance and physical education; this resulted in a publication of the proceedings. Meanwhile, AAHPER headquarters continued to receive many requests for assistance in designing professional preparation programs for the elementary level. A series of articles 6,7,8 were prepared following which a list of schools and colleges offering programs were developed as a result of a survey for the 1972 conference and a dissertation by David Staniford. 9

The Elementary School Physical Education Council recognized the need to publish a directory of institutions offering programs — not as a model — but as a service to all colleges and universities wishing to revise their professional preparation programs and as a reference for undergraduate and graduate students seeking specific help in selecting schools for study. Information from a special survey plus other sources served as the basis for a publication modeled after the highly successful and time-tested directory of the National Dance Association. 10 This culminated in the first edition of Professional Preparation Directory of Elementary School Physical Education presented here.

The Directory will be revised and reprinted every two years. The Council is aware that there are omissions by the limitation of the survey and by failure of schools to respond. However, all institutions which meet the criteria have an opportunity to be included in the next edition by forwarding appropriate information to the editors.

#### PREFACE

The undergraduate elementary school physical education programs in this publication are printed as they have been presented by the institutions offering these programs. (A copy of the questionnaire is included in Appendix B.) Only those schools are included which responded to the questionnaire. In no way is this directory intended to indicate the quality of a program or school. The purpose of publishing the directory is:

- . . . to assist prospective major students and counselors in providing answers to such questions as: What is the size of the elementary physical education specialization program at a particular university? What are the courses leading to the specialization? Who are the faculty?
- . . . to permit chairpersons of college and university physical education programs and others interested in elementary physical education programs to become aware of the nature and growth of such programs and also to have a source for determining curriculum offerings and personnel at various institutions.

The questionnaire was mailed in the spring of 1977 with a follow-up mailing in the fall. The initial mailing list was derived from the Stanford Study conducted in 1975. Of 315 schools contacted, 174 responded. This Directory presents 124 institutions as offering some type of program focus for the elementary physical education specialist. Institutions which did not have any specialization in elementary physical education for major students are not included. An alphabetical list of all institutions in this Directory is included in Appendix A.

The <u>Directory</u> includes information just as it was submitted. In some cases there was no response to a particular item, so no information is recorded. As noted in the <u>Directory</u>, some institutions offer special preparation in elementary school physical education as: major, minr, track, specialization, emphasis, option. The item indicating whether the institution is on the quarter hours or semester hours system is identified by "Q.H." or "S.H." at the top of the listing of credit hours for the courses.

The compilers wish to thank David Staniford, John Fowler, Margie R. Hanson and the Elementary School Physical Education Council for the opportunity to compile this <u>Directory</u> and for their assistance. Special appreciation is also extended to Gloria Fortson for her typing of the <u>Directory</u>.
