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ABSTRACT

This report on social services to families receiving Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) in May 1975 is Part IV of a broad study of AFDC recipient characteristics. The background of the AFDC social service program as mandated by Title XX of the Social Security Act is delineated briefly and a one-page prose summary of the statistics included in the report is provided. The bulk of the report consists of tables of data broken down by HEW region, by state and by U.S. total on such factors as whether a service plan had been developed for the families, what social services had been provided, whether family members had been receiving help for alcohol or drug abuse problems, what kind of child care arrangements were employed for children of various ages, whether screening services had been received, what the families' WIN project status was, and whether families received CETA or WIN payments. The appendices contain a glossary of terms related to the material in this report and a detailed discussion of the sample design and accuracy of the data. (JMB)

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FOREWORD

This report on services to AFDC families in May 1975 is part 4 of a broad study of recipient characteristics. Part 1 provided demographic and program statistics, part 2 provided data on child support enforcement, and part 3 provided data on financial circumstances.

The study was made by the National Center for Social Statistics of the Social and Rehabilitation Service before the reorganization of HEW announced in March 1977. The study was directed by Howard Oberheu of the Family Assistance Studies Staff. The sample was designed by William Hickey and Stanley Nachimson, mathematical statisticians, presently of the Office of Human Development Services and the Health Care Financing Administration, respectively.

The data were derived from a sample survey that included all States and jurisdictions except Guam. The minimum sample required from each State was one-half of 1 percent, but States were given the option of submitting larger samples computed by specified formulas. Twenty-nine States provided samples large enough for reliable State data to be shown in the tabulations. Data are also shown for all 10 HEW regions. Sample data are inflated to represent all families receiving money payments during the study month. Therefore, the data are subject to sampling variability and, as in all surveys, to errors of response.

The Office of Research and Statistics gratefully acknowledges the cooperation of State and local welfare agency personnel. State welfare agencies were responsible for completion of sample surveys for the study month. Information was obtained from case records supplemented by the personal knowledge of welfare agency workers.

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SOCIAL SERVICES IN 1975

At the time of this study (May 1975), all recipients of AFDC were eligible for social services. Although not included in the study, States had the option of providing services to current applicants and to former and potential recipients of AFDC. Social services were provided to preserve, rehabilitate, reunite, or strengthen the family or to assist family members to attain maximum self-support and personal independence. Because of separate organizational units, agency workers who provided social services did not determine eligibility for financial assistance.

A service plan was to be developed for each AFDC case. The plan could indicate that none was needed, or include an authorization for services the family needed and wanted. Families were free to accept or reject a service plan or a specific service. Social services could be furnished directly by the public welfare agency or obtained by the agency from other sources, sometimes with a fee. Some services needed were unavailable in the community where the family lived.

Title XX of the Social Security Act took effect in October 1975. It requires that each State establish a formal process for planning its social service program. A proposed Comprehensive Annual Service Program Plan (CASP) must describe how each will use its State-Federal social services funds for the next program year.

SERVICES PROVIDED (Tables 1-6)

Almost one-half of the AFDC families had a service plan. Services were to be provided to nearly three in four of the families with a service plan.

During the year, 1/ one or more services were provided to 44 percent of the AFDC families. The services most frequently provided were related to health, family planning, home management and functional educational instruction, education and training, and child care, ranging from 23 to 11 percent of the families. About 5 percent of the families received services to improve housing, transportation services, and protective services. Of the 8 percent of families with members having problems with alcohol or addictive drugs, about one in five received related services.

CHILD CARE (Tables 7-12)

There were 123,000 families whose caretaker was recurrently absent that had vendor payments for child care. The total amount paid in May 1975 was \$19 million, making the average payment per family \$155. Amounts of vendor payments were determined by the number of child care hours and local wages for the care of children. Child care not financed through vendor payments was usually paid for by the mother or other caretaker out of the AFDC assistance grant, out of the mother's earnings, or by a payment by the welfare agency to the mother or other caretaker who then purchased the care herself.

In cases where the child care arrangements were known, younger children were more likely to be cared for in their own homes. A substantial proportion of children aged 12-14 were unsupervised outside of school hours.

MEDICAL SERVICES (Table 13)

As part of the Medicaid program provided for under Title XIX, family members under age 21 are to receive early and periodic screening services to ascertain if they have any physical or mental defects. Nearly one in four families had members who received Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment (EPSDT) services during the past year.

EMPLOYMENT SERVICES (Tables 14-20)

Nearly all AFDC families lived in a Work Incentive Program (WIN) project area. Of those families, over one-third had one or more members registered for WIN. Nearly 3 times as many family members registered were required to do so than were registered voluntarily for the program. Mothers and stepmothers were the family members most likely to be registered, regardless of whether registration was required or not.

In addition to children under age 16, prevalent exemptions from WIN were mothers caring for young children (43.6 percent), older children attending school (15.2 percent), and the disabled or elderly (8.2 percent). One in five of those exempted because of incapacity received vocational rehabilitation services.

Individuals in 30,000 AFDC families received WIN or Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA) incentive payments amounting to \$2.6 million. The average monthly payment per family was \$123.

APPENDIX A--GLOSSARY OF SELECTED TERMS

Aid to families with dependent children (AFDC). As used in this report, AFDC means money payments with respect to a dependent child or children and includes money payments to meet the needs of the parent(s) or needy relative with whom the child is living and the needs of any other individual living in the same home who is considered essential to the well-being of the child if the resources and the needs of such individual are taken into account in determining the amount of the money payment.

Dependent child. For AFDC, this term means a needy child who has been deprived of parental support or care by reason of the death, continued absence from the home or physical or mental incapacity of a parent, or, at the option of the States, who is deprived of such support or care because the father is unemployed as defined by Federal regulations. The needy child must be living with his father, mother, grandfather, grandmother, brother, sister, stepfather, stepmother, stepbrother, stepsister, uncle, aunt, first cousin, nephew, or niece (including such relatives of the half-blood; preceding generations as denoted by prefixes of grand, great, or great-great; and persons who have legally adopted the child or his parents) in a place of residence maintained by one or more of such relatives as his or their own home. The child must be under age 18; or, at the option of the States, 18 years of age but under 21 and a student regularly attending a school, college, university, or a course of vocational or technical training designed to prepare the child for gainful employment.

Child recipient. Each dependent child who meets the above criteria is a child recipient. In some States this term includes an unborn child when pregnancy has been medically determined.

Adult recipient. An adult recipient is a needy relative with whom a dependent child lives and whose needs are taken into account in determining the amount of the AFDC money payment. If the parent of at least one of the children is incapacitated, or the father of one of the children is unemployed, the spouse of such parent may also be an adult recipient if the State so elects.

AFDC assistance group. The AFDC assistance group consists of the dependent children (child recipients) as defined above, the adult recipients as defined above, and any other individual living in the same home who is considered essential to the well-being of the child and whose resources and needs are taken into account in determining the amount of the AFDC money payment.

AFDC family. As used in this report, the AFDC family is synonymous with the AFDC assistance group. Other persons related to members of the assistance group may live in the same household. Thus, the AFDC family

will sometimes differ from the "family" as it is usually defined. The most commonly used definition of a family is that of the U.S. Bureau of the Census: two or more persons related by blood, marriage, or adoption who reside together.

WIN. Work Incentive Program for AFDC recipients, which is administered jointly by the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare and by the Department of Labor. As a condition of eligibility for AFDC, every individual must register for WIN unless the person is exempted under specified conditions. Exempt persons may volunteer for WIN registration.

Child care arrangement. Reported arrangements for children whose mother or other caretaker is away from home on a recurrent basis. Examples of applicable absences are those for employment, including part-time, participation in a work or training program, school attendance, or attendance at a mental health clinic. Not included are arrangements for incidental absences such as a shopping trip to the grocery store. The caretaker is the person with primary responsibility for full-time care of the child. In most families the caretaker is the mother, but in some families the caretaker may be the grandmother, aunt, another relative, or a nonrelative with such responsibility. "Child's mother or caretaker looks after child while working or being trained," refers to situations in which the child accompanies the caretaker during the caretaker's recurrent absence from the home. For example, a child may be taken by the caretaker to a work site, a training site, a school, or a mental health clinic where the child will be looked after by the caretaker.

Child care services. Comprehensive and coordinated sets of activities providing direct care and protection of infants and preschool and school age children during a portion of a 24-hour day inside or outside of the child's own home.

Educational and training services (AFDC-non-WIN). The provision of services to individuals to secure employment and self-sufficiency. Such services may include educational and vocational training, medical assessment, transportation, lunches, and uniforms. (Such services can only be provided to AFDC recipients who live in an area where WIN has not been initiated or where the WIN program is inadequate in scope or size to meet the needs of these recipients and there is an agreement with the Department of Labor.)

Employment-related medical and remedial services (WIN). Medical care and services that are found necessary to enable the individual to participate in WIN training or employment and which are not available under the State's Medicaid plan or from other federally funded programs.

Selected vocational rehabilitation services (WIN). Restorative services to correct or modify substantially a physical or mental condition which is a handicap to employment. They include but are not limited to surgery, psychiatric treatment, prosthetic devices, speech or hearing therapy, eyeglasses and visual services, and dental care.

Family planning services. Social, educational, and medical services to enable appropriate individuals (including minors who can be considered to be sexually active) voluntarily to limit their family size or to space their children and to prevent or reduce the incidence of births out of wedlock. This includes medical contraceptive services, social services, and educational services.

Foster care services for children. Placement of a child in a licensed foster care facility suitable to his or her needs; supervision of the placement of the child to assure proper care while in placement; review of the placement at least annually to assure its continuing appropriateness; counseling with the parents to facilitate the child's return to his or her own home where possible or otherwise plan for placement of the child in the home of other relatives, adoptive homes, or continued foster care as appropriate; and work with foster parents or foster care facility staff to assure quality child care.

Health-related services. Services provided for the purpose of assisting persons to attain and retain as favorable a condition of health as possible by helping them to identify and understand their health needs and to secure and utilize necessary medical treatment as well as preventive and health maintenance services, including services in medical emergencies. In addition, this includes those responsibilities carried out under the EPSDT program.

Homemaker services. Services provided by a trained and supervised homemaker to families and children to improve family living through assisting parents to overcome homemaking, housing, money management, and child rearing problems.

Home management and functional educational instruction. Formal or informal instruction and training in management of household budgets, maintenance and care of the home, preparation of food, nutrition, consumer education, child rearing and health maintenance.

Services to secure better housing or improve housing conditions. Services directed toward working with eligible persons and their landlords and others in upgrading substandard rental housing in which they live; to obtain repairs to their own home if substandard or unsuitable; to find other housing suitable and adequate to their needs at prices they can afford. Also includes staff activity involved in cooperating with community planning activities to help increase the supply and availability of safe, suitable housing for recipients who have housing problems.

Protective services for neglected or abused children. Services to protect eligible children who are found to be in danger of or subject to neglect, abuse, or exploitation and bring such cases to the attention of appropriate courts or law enforcement agencies and to cooperate with courts and officials to assist planning for the child to serve his or her best interest.

Services to runaways. Services provided to a child defined as any minor (as defined by the State law) who is reported, in accordance with the State's definition or description of a runaway, to have left his or her place of abode without consent of parents, guardian, or other person acting in the capacity of a parent.

Services to unmarried parents. Counseling of unmarried parents and, when indicated, along with their parents; help with making living arrangements, obtaining financial assistance, securing medical care and legal services, and planning for themselves and their children.

Transportation services (as part of a service plan). Travel and related costs for individuals and families to community facilities and resources.

Legal services. Services of a lawyer to persons who desire help with legal problems within the scope of such services specified in the State plan.

Other social services. Emergency services and other services not listed above but specified in the approved State Plan.

APPENDIX B--SAMPLE DESIGN AND ACCURACY OF DATA

DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS

The sample for the 1975 AFDC Study was designed to be representative of the May 1975 caseload. In addition, the sample was stratified to allow for a longitudinal analysis of the AFDC caseload and to check the accuracy of reporting. For the longitudinal strata, the sample included cases that were used in the 1973 AFDC Study sample that also received AFDC in May 1975. For the accuracy check, the sample included cases from the May 1975 AFDC quality control sample. Additional cases were used for the 1975 AFDC Study that were neither in the 1973 sample nor the quality control sample.

To obtain the longitudinal strata sample, an attempt was made to equalize a State's 1973 and 1975 sampling rate. If the 1973 sampling rate was higher than the 1975 rate, the 1973 cases were subsampled down to the 1975 rate. If the 1973 sampling rate was lower, the 1973 cases were supplemented by cases drawn in 1975 which received AFDC in 1973. Different weights for each stratum were assigned to compensate for differences in the sampling rates.

The first step in the weighting process was to estimate the stratum population in each State. The proportion of cases in each stratum was estimated by the sample proportion of cases drawn entirely in the 1975 caseload that were in each stratum. The total AFDC caseload was then multiplied by these proportions, resulting in an estimate of population totals in each stratum. Stratum weights were then calculated by dividing the population estimates in a stratum by the number of sample cases in a stratum.

STATE SAMPLE SIZE

States had the option of using either a minimal sample size based on the AFDC caseload in Section VIII; $1\frac{1}{2}$ in Region A; $2\frac{1}{2}$ in Region B; and $3\frac{1}{2}$ elsewhere; or an increased sample size sufficiently large to estimate a characteristic occurring at the one-half of one percent level in the State AFDC population with a standard error of one percent. The sample size was calculated using the formula:

Sample size = $1.645 \sqrt{.0011657 / (p \times N)}$, where N is the number of cases

SAMPLING VARIABILITY

The figures in the attached tables are based on a sample of AFDC families and are, therefore, subject to sampling variability. They may differ from the results that would have been obtained by a complete census. However, because the research design involved a known probability of selection for a given family, the sampling variability can be estimated. The following tables indicate the estimated sampling variability (or standard error) of various percentages and absolute numbers contained in the tables in this release.

About 2 out of 3 of all possible probability samples selected, with the same specifications, will yield estimates within one standard error of the figures that would have been obtained in a complete count of AFDC families. About 95 percent of all such probability samples will give estimates within 2 standard errors and about 99 percent of all possible probability samples will give estimates within 3 standard errors of the "true" figure.

APPROXIMATE STANDARD ERROR FOR POPULATIONS OTHER THAN U.S. TOTAL FAMILIES

The approximate standard error for recipient children is the same as for U.S. total families. For any State and regional population, multiply the approximate standard error for the U.S. population by the factor for the State or region as shown in the following table:

For example, an estimate of 25 percent for families has a standard error of .33 percent. For Region I recipient children, an estimate of 25 percent has an approximate standard error of 1.3 percent (.33 x 4), from tables A-2 and A-3.

APPROXIMATE STANDARD ERROR FOR SUBUNIVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

Several tables concern subuniverse tabulations of portions of the total universe (for example, families receiving child care is a subuniverse of all families). To obtain the approximate standard error of subuniverse percentage values, multiply the subuniverse percentage value of the universe by the subuniverse characteristic percentage value. Then use the tables to determine the standard error of the product, treating the product as a percentage value of a universe characteristic. Using families that receive child care in Massachusetts as an example, 13.1 percent of the AFDC families received child care (subuniverse percentage value of the universe) and 8.4 percent of AFDC families had such services provided in their own home (subuniverse characteristic percentage value). Following the instructions, 13.1 percent x 8.4 percent = 1.1 percent. The standard error of a State family percentage of 1.1 percent is .08 percent (from table A-2) x 5 (from table A-4) = .4 percent; thus the standard error of 8.4 percent is (8.4 / 1.1) x .4 = 3.05 percent.

APPROXIMATE STANDARD ERROR OF ESTIMATED NUMBERS

To obtain the standard error of the estimated number of a population with a specific characteristic, the standard error of the percentage for the characteristic should be multiplied by the total number in the population.

For example, in a State with a population of 25,000 cases, a percentage figure of 10% represents 2,500 cases. The 10% has a standard error of 1.25%, the 2,500 has a standard error of 312.5 (25,000 x 1.25%).

SIGNIFICANT DIFFERENCES ($\alpha = .05$) BETWEEN U.S. AND REGION OR STATES OR BETWEEN REGIONS AND STATES FOR CASELOAD PERCENTAGE ESTIMATES

The standard errors and intervals in the technical appendix tables are based on sample sizes of one-half of one percent (17,098 families) of the U.S. total of AFDC families in May 1975 and approximately 860 AFDC families per region or State, the minimum required for publication of the data. Since the actual sample for the U.S. and some regions and States is larger, these standard errors and intervals are generally over-estimated.

Figures in the tables refer only to percentage estimates for total caseloads. The estimated percentage in column 1 of each table is for a given characteristic in a caseload (U.S. totals in table A-4, State or region totals in table A-5). Columns 2 and 3 show the nearest upper and lower percentage values at which differences between the characteristic in this population and in another population become statistically significant (i.e., we are 95 percent confident that the true difference is greater than zero).

For example, a State's percentage for a characteristic is 28 percent. The U.S. estimate for this characteristic is 30 percent. Looking at table A-4, we see that the figures which are significantly different from 30 are 33.3 percent and 26.9 percent. Since 28 percent is between these figures, we can conclude that it is not significantly different from 30 percent.

To compare other States or regions to a specified State, we use table A-5, and the row for 28 percent. Percentages significantly different from 28 percent are less than or equal to 23.8 percent and equal to or greater than 32.4 percent. A State or regional percentage for the characteristic between 23.8 percent and 32.4 percent is not significantly different from the 28 for the specified State.

These tables were derived as follows:

The standard error of the difference between two independent estimates, P_1 of P_2 , is equal to: $(P_1(1-P_1)/n_1) + (P_2(1-P_2)/n_2)$ --(where n_1 and n_2 are the sizes of the samples from which the estimates were made). The difference between two estimates, P_1-P_2 , becomes significant when the difference is greater than 2 standard errors or less than -2 standard errors (when the absolute value of the difference is greater than 2 standard errors).

In the tables, the values of P_1 are found in the estimated percentage column. The values in the adjacent columns are the nearest values to P_1 which are significantly different from it; i.e., the closest values to P_1 where P_1-P_2 is greater than 2 standard errors.
