ABSTRACT Data regarding full-time instructional faculty in Nebraska colleges and universities for 1975-76 and 1978-79 are presented in summary form. Information was taken from Higher Education General Information Survey reports. The following data are included: percentage of full-time instructional faculty, by rank, of the total number of full-time faculty, by institution and institutional sector; total number of faculty and percent of those tenured, by academic rank and institutional sectors; total number and average salaries by public institution; total number and average salaries for independent colleges and universities; and average salaries by sex and academic rank. PREFACE

The information contained in this report was reported by the Nebraska institutions of postsecondary education on the Higher Education General Information Survey (HEGIS). The HEGIS full-time instructional faculty report is part of a series of reports institutions annually file with the National Center for Education Statistics of the U.S. Department of Health, Education, and Welfare. The Nebraska Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education coordinates the distribution of the HEGIS reporting forms to the institutions, the collection and return of completed reports for the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES).

The data were taken from the following HEGIS reports:

Academic Year 1978-79: "Salaries, Tenure, and Fringe Benefits of Full-Time Instructional Faculty, 1978-79 (NCES Form 2300-3).

Academic Year 1977-78: "Salaries, Tenure, and Fringe Benefits of Full-Time Instructional Faculty, 1977-78 (NCES Form 2300-3).

Academic Year 1976-77: "Employees in Institutions of Higher Education, 1976-77 (OE Form 2300-3).

Academic Year 1975-76: "Salaries, Tenure, and Fringe Benefits of Full-Time Instructional Faculty, 1976-76 (OE Form 2300-3).

The raw data reported herein were sent to each Nebraska institution of postsecondary education on March 13, 1979, for verification. The data shown in this report reflects changes made by the institutions as a result of this verification process.

It should be noted that while each collegiate postsecondary institution annually completes the Higher Education Information Survey, in 1978, the Nebraska College of Business, a Private Vocational School, participated in the Survey on an experimental basis. This experiment was conducted to determine the problems encountered, appropriateness, and general capability of private vocational schools which offer associate level degree programs to provide the same information. This single year reporting by the Nebraska College of Business does not imply that other private vocational schools were requested to provide the information or that this reporting in any way represents the totality of the 67 private vocational schools in Nebraska.

The Commission wishes to acknowledge with appreciation the cooperation and time the institutions devoted to reviewing and verifying the data contained in this report.

I. Introduction

The following tables provide in summary form data regarding full-time instructional faculty. It should be noted that these data do not include all the faculty an institution may have that are providing instructional services as, for example, the data do not include information on part-time faculty. It is, therefore, inappropriate to draw conclusions from these data related to the number of Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) faculty.

Special note must be paid to the average salaries reported herein. These are nine (9) month average salaries and this is the normal manner used for reporting average salaries of full-time instructional faculty. The formula used to derive these average salaries is the standard formula applied nation-wide. The formula is as follows: $9/11 \times 12\text{-month faculty Salary Outlay} + 9\text{-month faculty Salary Outlay} = \text{Total and Converted 9-month Salary Outlay}$. This Total and Converted 9-month Salary Outlay is then divided by the total number of faculty (in total or by the respective academic ranks) to determine the average salary. The salary data reported herein do not include the fringe benefits the faculty receive from their respective institutions.

While all institutions reporting these data follow the same instructions, there are differences in reporting that do cause some differences in the data that need to be mentioned. An example of this was provided in a comment from Wayne State College when these data were verified by the Director for Institutional Research at Wayne State College.

The average salaries for Full-Time Instructional Staff for 1975-76 through 1978-79 are correct, according to the formula used to convert 12-month salaries to 9-month salaries, however, a distortion of the values results with the inclusion of salaries for Division Heads at the Full Professor and Associate Professor levels. From 1975-76 through 1978-79, the Division Heads were 0.5 FTE in instruction. Wayne State College interpreted the HEGIS guidelines such that Division Heads fiscal-year salaries were included in the reports. (Compared to the average salaries for full-instructional staff on 9-month contracts, the institutional average has been distorted by about \$600, the Full Professor average by \$200, and the Associate Professor by \$800).

In order to eliminate the distortion of average salaries due to the inclusion of a rate-of-pay for an administrative function, Wayne State College will not include the Division Head salaries in the Fall 1979 data.

As the above statement indicates, these data do need to be reviewed carefully and generally. While these data are being presented for informational purposes for their comparative value, it would be a mistake to interpret these data too literally without investigating some of the factors behind the apparent differences among and between institutions and institutional sectors.

Some of the differences are due to the exclusions from the report the institutions completed. These exclusions provide for differences in these data from what may be anticipated or thought to be intuitively. The exclusions are:

1. Instructional faculty who are employed to teach less than two semesters, three quarters, two trimesters, or two 4-month trimesters, or two 4-month sessions.
2. Instructional faculty for pre-clinical and clinical medicine. (Instructional faculty in all other health fields, such as dentistry, veterinary medicine, nursing, dental hygiene, etc. are included).
3. Instructional faculty who are employed on a part-time basis.
4. Administrative officers with titles such as Dean of Instruction, Academic Dean, Dean of Faculty, Dean of Students, Librarian, Registrar, Coach, etc., even though they may devote part of their time to classroom instruction.
5. Undergraduate or graduate students who assist in the instruction of courses, but have titles such as teaching assistant, teaching associate, teaching fellow, etc.
