ABSTRACT

This bibliography was compiled in an attempt to provide resources for vocational educators to use in understanding, interpreting, and incorporating methods for the total elimination of sex discrimination, sex bias, and stereotyping in their daily classroom activities. The bibliography is organized into eight topic areas: (1) Developing Sex-Fair Vocational Education, (2) Eliminating Sexism in Language and Instructional Materials, (3) How Sex Bias Affects Men, (4) Men and Women in Nontraditional Careers, (5) Reference Materials, (6) Sex Equality Organizations, (7) Sex Fair Counseling in Guidance and Career Education, and (8) Ways of Eliminating Sexism in Schools. Within each topic area, the entries are alphabetized by title under the following categories: audio-visuals, books, dissertations, periodicals, reports, and miscellaneous. The final section of the bibliography contains a list of publishers. (LRA)

## PREFACE

Vocational educators have assumed the responsibility for training or retraining individuals for gainful employment as semi-skilled or skilled workers. The training schools or classes are under public supervision and control of a state board or local educational agency. The schools and classes must comply with the laws that apply to the governing agencies. Title IX and Title II, also called the 1976 Education Amendments, prohibiting sex discrimination and requiring the elimination of sex stereotyping and bias are two laws that vocational training schools must obey. This bibliography was compiled in an attempt to provide resources for vocational educators to use in understanding, interpreting, and incorporating methods for the total elimination of sex discrimination, sex bias and stereotyping in their daily classroom activities.

Some publications within the bibliography explore manifestations and implications of sex-role stereotyping and sex discrimination in education. Other publications provide information for general awareness and the background of sexism regarding women and men. Resources which may be useful to vocational teachers in developing sex fair instructional programs are included. Some publications are designed for counselors; these concern the development of sex fair counseling skills or issues of sex bias in testing and counseling materials. Publications for investigation of life and career possibilities for teachers, counselors and students are also included for use in counseling or career education programs. For administrators, teachers, and counselors, publications by various governmental agencies may help develop an awareness of the effects of the federal government on local school districts in the area of equal educational opportunity. Resource lists, bibliographies, and names of sex equality organizations are provided for educators who wish to pursue particular subjects in further detail. Publications on recognizing sex bias in language and instructional materials are included.

This bibliography is organized by topic areas which are listed in the Table of Contents. Within each topic area, the entries are alphabetized by title under the following categories:

1. Audio-visuals
2. Books
3. Dissertations
4. Periodicals
5. Reports
6. Miscellaneous

A review of all the materials listed in this bibliography for sex fairness within the content was impossible with our limited staff and resources. However, the books listed under Sex Fair Vocational Education have been recommended as sex fair by their publishers or have been personally reviewed and determined to be predominately sex fair.

Some imperfections may be noted within this bibliography. Due to editing inconsistencies, some entries may be used more than once. Even though the bibliography contains information about the sex equality of men and women, it is highly oriented toward women. As the reader may know, very little information has been written about sex bias and men.

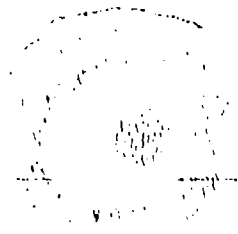
