ABSTRACT

This bibliography lists all the books and materials developed and published by the San Francisco Unified School District for students in bilingual education programs. Most of the materials are intended for elementary grades, although a few are appropriate for use in secondary grades. The bibliography is arranged according to the following subject areas: (1) Chinese language arts, (2) music, (3) science, and (4) social studies. Each listing includes title, author, grade level, languages used, number of pages, and a short description of the material. The materials feature aspects of both Chinese and American culture. 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Preface

This bibliography is a listing of all the books and materials developed and published by the ESEA Title VII Chinese Bilingual Pilot Program since the program began in 1969.

The purpose of this booklet is to share information with bilingual educators and others interested in curriculum materials for Chinese bilingual students.

The bibliography is divided according to subject areas: Chinese language arts, music, science and social studies. Each listing includes the following information: title, author, grade level, languages used, number of pages and a short description of the material.

The project-developed materials feature aspects of both cultures. They were developed for students in the Chinese Bilingual Title VII Program in the San Francisco Unified School District. Most of the project-developed materials are for elementary grades since that level was our focus when the program first began. Presently, we are concentrating our curricular efforts in the secondary level.

All materials have been field tested in the classrooms prior to publication. However, they are still experimental and subject to revision.

It is hoped that this bibliography will inform others of the curricular aspect of our project and that it will encourage others to develop Chinese bilingual curriculum materials in areas and levels where there is still a great need.

Special thanks are to be given to Alfonso Santos, Jr. and Ramon Salinda of the Filipino Title VII Bilingual Program for designing the cover of this booklet.
