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ABSTRACT

Tests for the very young child must be nonverbal, and must be fairly brief, inexpensive, and reasonably simple to score and administer. This annotated bibliography represents a selected sample of 109 tests for children aged two through six. The selection covers most of the areas assessed in early childhood programs, including intelligence, language, speech, self-concept, body coordination, perception, vision, sociability and other cognitive, affective and psychomotor skills and abilities. Tests listed do not require subjective judgment in scoring or specialized training for administration. Information is contained in two tables. Table I lists the tests alphabetically by title and points out which of the following areas or skills are covered in the instrument: intelligence/achievement; language/speech; social/affective; sensory/motor; and screening/readiness/diagnostic. Table II is an alphabetical list which provides the title, type, price, publisher, age or grade range recommended by the test's author, forms of test, administration time, subtests and comments obtained from catalogs and bibliographies intended to help the reader better understand the test itself. A list of publishers and their addresses is included as is the list of references used in compiling the bibliography. (RL)

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## Introduction

The inception of Head Start in 1965 gave unprecedented status to early childhood education and firmly implanted the practice of instructional programming for young children into the educational continuum. As more early childhood programs were established, however, teachers became frustrated by the relative absence of instruments for measuring the performance of prekindergarten children. Obviously, if quality learning programs were to be established and maintained, appropriate instruments needed to be developed and disseminated.

A growing trend toward development of valid and reliable measures for use with young children can be noted in editions of Buros' Mental Measurements Yearbook. Buros, a noted author of measurement reviews, has been publishing Mental Measurements Yearbooks since 1938. In both the fifth and sixth yearbooks, published in 1959 and 1965, only one test is listed under PRESCHOOL; in 1972, the number under PRESCHOOL increased to nine; and in Buros' eighth yearbook, 1978, subheadings of Preschool, Readiness & Early Childhood are used. Where can early childhood teachers go, then, to seek help in finding the most practical and effective instrument for evaluating student performance?

Schools for children in grades one through 12 usually use professional personnel to administer tests, or at least to give guidance in the selection and administration of tests. Since the staff of early learning programs usually does not include such a specialist, it then becomes the teacher's or director's responsibility to obtain needed evaluation and assessment instruments.

Many test collections, annotated bibliographies, measurement books, and test handbooks are available to teachers of young children. However, these guides are voluminous and invariably list tests in far too many areas and for all ages of children. Tests for the very young child must be nonverbal, since most children cannot read, and they must be fairly brief, inexpensive, and reasonably simple to score and administer. This information is not readily available in one resource book.

It appears that an annotated bibliography of early childhood measurement instruments which includes appropriate practical information is needed.

#### Description

The following bibliography represents a selected sample of tests for children aged two through six. The selection covers most of the areas assessed in early childhood programs, including intelligence, language, speech, self-concept, body coordination, perception, vision, sociability and other cognitive, affective and psychomotor skills and abilities. Tests listed do not require subjective judgment in scoring or specialized training for administration.

Rating scales, frames of reference for observations, structured interviews, informant-interviews and projective technique tests have not been included. Costly and lengthy tests have also been omitted.



Table I on pages 5 - 12 lists the tests alphabetically, points out the areas or skills covered in the instrument, and directs the reader to the page where more detailed information concerning the test appears.

Table II on pages 13-30 is an alphabetical, annotated list which provides the title, type, price, publisher, forms of test, administration time, subtests and comments.

More specifically, Table I contains:

**TEST TITLE** - The titles listed are as they appear in test catalogs or bibliographies. The word "the" is missing and so is the author's name if it is not commonly used in the title, e.g. Frostig Developmental Test of Visual Perception is known as the Developmental Test of Visual-Motor Integration (VMI). Page number directs the reader to the test's location in this bibliography.

**INTEL/IQ/ACHIEVEMENT** - Tests that measure intellectual function or attained skills.

**LANGUAGE/SPEECH** - Tests or subtest scores that measure oral language communication, vocabulary and speech.

**SOCIAL/AFFECTIVE** - Tests that measure self-concept, personality, sociability, motivation, emotions and attitudes.

**SENSORY/MOTOR** - Tests that measure body coordination, auditory and visual skills, perceptual and psychomotor skills.

**SCREENING/READINESS/DIAGNOSTIC** - Tests that measure capacity to deal with certain tasks or diagnostic and screening tests that are primarily designed for use in placement.

Table II includes the following:

**TEST TITLE** - Same as Table I.

**Type** - This entry concerns the purpose of the test. Most often the title indicates the behavior or abilities the test measures but it is not an all-inclusive label.

**PRICE** - The price is the one listed in the latest Buros Mental Measurements Yearbook, or, if available, the publisher's catalog. Unless indicated, the price includes manual and key. No test over \$80. is included in this bibliography. Prices are subject to change.

**PUBLISHER** - A numeral refers to the alphabetical List of Publishers beginning on page

**AGE OR GRADE** - This is the age or grade range recommended by the test's author. This age/grade range should not be accepted as an absolute limit, since many tests could be used for children who are not functioning at their chronological age.

**FORM** - Unless there is more than one form, the numeral 1 is entered. Common variations of tests, such as English/Spanish, boy/girl, black/white, are also noted.

**ADMINISTRATION TIME** - Tests, especially at the preschool level, are often "untimed." This is entered when the author has furnished this information. The approximate test administration is indicated, where possible. No test requiring over 60 minutes for a single sitting is listed.

**SUBTEST SCORES** - Many tests have subdivisions and these are listed. If there are more than six subtest scores of tested skills, etc. is written.

**COMMENTS/REMARKS** - This notation is usually to help the reader better understand the test itself. Comments were obtained from catalogs and bibliographies and are not a review by this writer. If the test can be administered to a small group, a notation is made.

### Conclusion

The problem of selecting an appropriate measurement instrument is always present. It is hoped that this bibliography will help solve that problem.
