ABSTRACT

The grades earned by all students registered for credit classes in six Hawaii community colleges during Fall 1980 were analyzed to determine student grade point averages (GPA's) by college program and the distribution of grades in courses offered by the colleges. This analysis revealed that: (1) the credits earned ratio was 71%; (2) this ratio was higher for vocational courses (74%) than for general education courses (69%); and (3) the ratios ranged from 66% in natural science courses to 81% in technology courses, and from 66% to 73% by campus. Of the grades assigned, 24% were A's, 25% were B's, 8% were W's, and 11% were N's. Only four of the six colleges assigned F grades, with the proportion of F grades assigned ranging from 2% to 16% by campus. The grade point average for the system as a whole was 2.69, compared to 2.76 in Fall 1979 and 2.84 in Fall 1976. For the second consecutive year, the GPA earned by vocational majors (2.70) was higher than that earned by liberal arts majors (2.66). The GPA for vocational majors ranged from 2.52 in hotel/food service programs to 2.95 in health services programs. Unclassified students continued to earn the highest GPA (2.87), probably due to the lighter credit load carried. The report includes tables illustrating grade point averages and grade distributions by college, curricular area, student major, and student educational objective for Fall 1976 through Fall 1980. DISTRIBUTION OF GRADES AND CURRENT GPRs EARNED
COMMUNITY COLLEGES
FALL 1980

This report briefly summarizes data on student achievement as perceived from two dimensions: (1) by the current grade point averages earned by students (by program); and (2) by the distribution of grades in the course offered by the colleges. Such information may be helpful in examining campus grading practices and in planning and assessing academic programs.

Computer reports 2528 and 2529 were used as the source documents for this report. They are generated at the end of each semester after all the grades have been submitted. These reports are on file in the registrar's office at each campus.

The data include the grades given to and earned by all students registered for credit classes, i.e., regular students, special students (early admits and concurrent registrants), students in credit courses offered by continuing education, as well as students who registered for the first time in the second eight-week session.

Highlights

Tables 1 and 2: Distribution of Grades and Average Grades Assigned

Community college totals and individual campus data show minor difference from the information reported for last fall:

Credits earned ratio

- The credits earned ratio was 71 percent.
- Credits earned ratios were higher for vocational courses (74 percent) than for general education courses (69 percent).
- Credits earned ratios ranged from 66 percent (natural science courses) to 81 percent (technology courses).
- Credits earned ratios by campus ranged from 66 to 73 percent.

Distribution of grades

- Almost half (47 percent) of the grades were A's and B's (24 and 25 percent, respectively).
- "W" and "N" grades comprised 8 and 11 percents, respectively, of the grades this fall.

- Four of the six campuses gave 'F' grades. Six percent of the grades given this fall were 'F' grades. The proportion ranged from 2 to 16 percent, by campus.
- Average grade assigned ranged from 2.3 to 3.2, by campus.
- The average grade given was 2.7.

Table 3: Current GPRs by Major and Educational Objective

- The current mean GPR of 2.69 earned by community college students is slightly lower than the 2.76 reported for Fall 1979 and considerably lower than the 2.84 of Fall 1976.
- For the second fall semester the current average GPR earned by vocational education majors (2.70) was higher than that earned by liberal arts majors (2.66). The average GPRs of the vocational education majors ranged from 2.52 for hotel/food service majors to 2.95 for health services majors.
- Unclassified students earned the highest GPR's as in past semesters, probably due to the lighter credit loads they carry.
- The data by educational objective show that the unclassified students earned the highest GPR's (2.87) followed by those seeking Associate in Science degrees (2.72).
