SCORING:

1. Each response is given a ✓ mark in the appropriate column of response.
2. ALL RESPONSES ARE TO BE IN FULL SENTENCES. (The lessons and tests are to measure speaking ability.)
3. One Point is given for each question.
4. COMPLETE SENTENCE RESPONSE\* has a total possible of 10, and the person should be moved to the next level.
5. PARTIAL SENTENCE RESPONSE\* means remedial work is needed for the level being tested.
6. NO RESPONSE (i.e. NONE) means that the basic language skills have not been learned for that level.

\*POSSIBLE SCORING:

COMPLETE: 10-8 Move to the next level. (Note: for the student who can answer COMPLETE 10-8 possible scoring, move to the next level PRE TEST, etc. until the PARTIAL or NONE score is reached. This will be the level for the student to work.

PARTIAL: 7-6 Remedial work is needed.

NONE: 5-0 Basic level work is needed.

DIRECTIONS

DIRECTIONS:

1. The testing area should be quiet and free from any distraction.
2. Each person to be interviewed will be given the test individually.
3. The questions should be asked in a clear voice.
4. A moderate amount of time should be given for recognition and response. (Caution: do not wait too long. If it is obvious the student does not know the answer, move on to the next item.)
5. A cover or shield should be placed between the person asking the questions for the Instructor and the person giving the response. This is to prevent an anticipated question and to keep the distraction from moving hands or paper to a minimum. (Bookends supporting an open manila could be used.)
6. ALL materials should be in order before the person is seated and ready to begin.
