ABSTRACT This manual describes the contents, purpose, and use of the Australian Education Index Database (AEII), which is produced by the Library and Information Services Unit of the Australian Council for Educational Research to provide access to Australian generated information both in published and unpublished forms. An overview of AEII is followed by an outline of the AEII record format and two sample records. Detailed guidelines for searching the AEII database using STAIRS software are provided, with specific attention paid to searchable fields within the records. Subject indexing of records in the database using the Thesaurus of ERIC Descriptors is then reviewed, and the function of stopwords, i.e., words not stored for searching purposes, and the availability of documents recorded in the database are also briefly discussed. Appended are a list of periodicals scanned regularly for inclusion in the database and a list of AEII stopwords. (JL)

A OVERVIEW OF THE AEII DATA BASE

1 SUPPLIER

The Australian Education Data Base which is produced by the Library and Information Services Unit of the Australian Council for Educational Research provides computer access to Australian generated information both in published and unpublished forms.

In 1978, a small experimental file was developed from the records of the Australian Education Index using the facilities for AUSINET at ACI Computer Services, Clayton, Victoria. The format of entry and style of subject indexing were based on the systems used for the ERIC (Educational Resources Information Center) data bases in the United States. From 1979, the data base was updated quarterly with all records from the hard copy Index. In 1980, it was decided that the data base would be extended whenever possible to include other files in order to provide a comprehensive coverage of educational information, for example, in 1980 the small file of the bibliography 'Initiatives in technical and further education vol. 1, no. 1, 1980' by the National TAFE Clearinghouse was incorporated. In addition, input from New Zealand is being considered.

The diversity of files in the data base perhaps develops problems of content clarity but with careful guidance to the users, it is hoped that the additional records will provide a realistic coverage of documents in education for Australia.

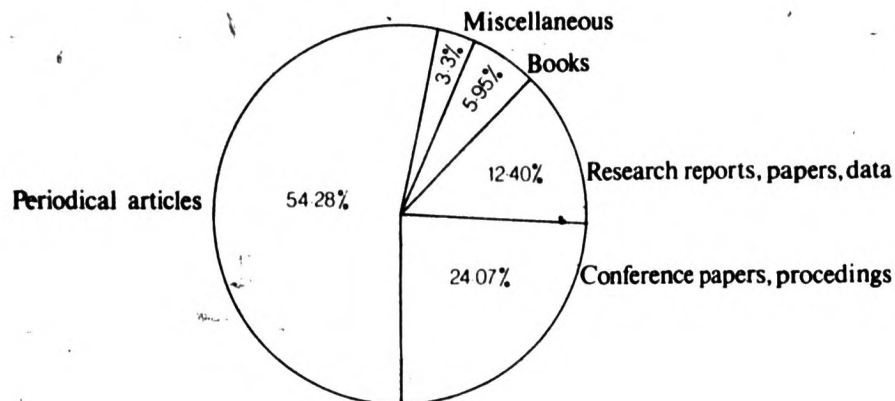
AEII 1978 to date of Australian Education Index and other files.

3 LITERATURE SOURCES

ACER scans regularly 198 periodicals as well as numerous books, research reports and conference proceedings each year. Various kinds of documents are chosen for inclusion: original research, reviews, surveys, discussions, theories, conference reports, case studies, classroom materials, tests and parliamentary debates.

During 1981, the majority of documents fell into the broad categories of periodical articles, monographs, research reports and conference papers. The percentages of coverage for the year are shown in the following figure:

4 SUBJECT COVERAGE

AEI attempts to cover Australia's literature in education and related disciplines. Education is interpreted in the widest sense and information concerned with all areas and all levels of education, teaching and training is included. Broad subject categories covered by the service are: Educational history; Educational research; Educational philosophy, policy and development; Educational planning and administration; Educational facilities; Teaching profession; Teacher education; Educational personnel; Educational management; Study; Curriculum planning; Educational systems and institutions; Special education; Library and Information Science; Related disciplines include such areas as Psychology, Sociology, Politics, Economics, Research methodology and Linguistics.

5 PERIOD OF COVERAGE

The data base contains records for all items indexed in the hard copy AEI since 1979. A small file of 750 records from AEI 1978 which was compiled for experimental purposes is also included. Since these dates refer to the issues of AEI, documents published in earlier years may be included. Each volume of AEI may contain records for documents with imprint dates of the previous two years and which come to hand during that year. So the data base may contain items with imprint dates 1977 to date.

It is intended that the facilities for compiling the hard copy AEI may be used to produce future specialist indexes and bibliographies. These files will with all probability contain items with earlier imprint dates. These files can be incorporated into the data base to enhance the coverage of the file. In these cases, documentation will be provided to advise users.

6 UPDATE FREQUENCY

The file is updated quarterly during the month preceding the distribution of the quarterly issue of the hard copy AEI, i.e. in February, May, August and November.

Currently each update contains approximately 800 items.

1 FORMATTED FIELDS

These specially indexed elements are stored separately from the free text portion. They do not form part of the Dictionary or Invented files. They are accessible through the SELECT command in the STAIRS program, and allow for the results of a query to be refined.

ACER-NO (Accession Number)

The unique accession number is assigned by ACER to each record upon input into the system. Search numerically.

CLSHE

Clearinghouse or identification of institution responsible for indexing and input e.g. ACER (Australian Council for Educational Research; TAFE (National TAFE Clearinghouse, C/- Dept of Further Education, South Australia). Limit of six characters. Search alphabetically.

ISSUE

Date of issue of Australian Education Index or other publication in which the record appears, e.g. AEI Mar 81, that is Australian Education Index March 1981. Limit of 12 characters. Search alphabetically.

Note: Data must be enclosed in single quotation marks, e.g. Issue = 'AEI Mar 81'.

YEAR

Year of publication of document. Not abbreviated, e.g. 1981. Limit of four digits. Search numerically.

2 PERSONAL NAMES

Authors' or editors' names appear exactly as published in source document. Names in the author and identifier paragraphs appear in inverted order: surname and initials only. No given names are included: No punctuation is given.

Personal names may be recorded in other paragraphs of an AEII record and broader retrieval will be achieved when searching all paragraphs of a record if the search is constructed using the surname alone rather than using the surname WITH or ADJ the initials.

3 CORPORATE AUTHOR (CC Author)

A corporate body, committee, educational institution or government department is cited as the author when appropriate.

Names appear, as far as possible, exactly as published.

Examples:

AUSTRALIAN COUNCIL FOR EDUCATIONAL RESEARCH
WESTERN AUSTRALIAN POST SECONDARY EDUCATION COMMISSION
UNIVERSITY OF MELBOURNE
UNIVERSITY OF NEW SOUTH WALES. STUDENT COUNSELLING AND
RESEARCH UNIT
SWINBURNE COLLEGE OF TECHNOLOGY

Government departments and statutory bodies are entered under country or state, followed by name of department. Abbreviations DEPT for DEPARTMENT and DIV for DIVISION are used.

Examples: AUSTRALIA. DEPT OF EDUCATION
AUSTRALIA. SCHOOLS COMMISSION
NEW SOUTH WALES. DEPT OF EDUCATION. SECONDARY SCHOOLS BOARD
QUEENSLAND. DEPT OF EDUCATION. TECHNICAL AND FURTHER
EDUCATION

As with personal names, names of corporate bodies may be recorded in other paragraphs such as the Abstract paragraph of an AEII record in various forms, for example AUSTRALIAN DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION: COMMONWEALTH DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION or AUSTRALIA. DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. Also abbreviated versions of a corporate body name may be used.

Examples:

ACER may appear as ACER or A.C.E.R. or AUSTRALIAN COUNCIL FOR
EDUCATIONAL RESEARCH
CDC may appear as CDC or CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT CENTRE or
AUSTRALIA. CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT CENTRE.

It is recommended to use 'WITH' in preference to 'ADJ' in some instances for more effective searching when various formats of a name may be used.

For example, UNIVERSITY OF MELBOURNE; MELBOURNE UNIVERSITY.

When searching corporate names, note that some words have been designated as 'Stop' words within the data base. See Section E and Appendix II.

4 INSTITUTION (PUBLISHER)

The institution, corporate body or commercial publisher is responsible for the publishing of monographs or research reports. See Corporate authors for format of name.

Abbreviations of commercial and government publishers are used, e.g.

Aust Internat Press
Aust Govt Pub Service
NSW Govt Pr
Univ Qld Press

If CC Author is also the Institution, name is not repeated in Institution paragraph.

5 SOURCE/DATE

For records included from 1978 to 1981, periodical citation sources are quoted in abbreviated format using the ISO, 'International List of Periodical Title Words Abbreviation (ISO 833), for example, AUST J EDUC. List of major periodicals with abbreviations appear in Appendix 1. From 1982, titles of periodicals are quoted in full, for example, AUSTRALIAN JOURNAL OF EDUCATION.

Journal issues, number and paging is given in the following form:

Title v. - n. - p. -

where

v. is the volume

n. is the number

p. is the page numbers

Example:

Aust J Educ v.24 n.3 p.225-245

A separate field 'Date' contains the publication date of the document. This information usually is abbreviated with no punctuation when month is included, as follows:

Month: JAN FEB MAR APR MAY JUNE JULY AUG SEPT OCT NOV DEC

Year: 79;80;81

Examples: OCT 80; FEB 81

6 CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS; COLLECTIONS

Beginning in January 1982, full bibliographical details of the source of papers included in conference proceedings and collections will be searchable through the SOURCE (SO) paragraph. Prior to 1982, this information was available in the NOTES (NO) paragraph.

7 PUBLICATION TYPE

From January 1981, the scheme for identifying the form or organization of the document currently in use by the ERIC system is adopted. This publication type is followed by a three-digit code. To allow flexibility in classification, up to three code assignments can be assigned for a single document or article. Category names and codes are:

8 BOOK REVIEWS

Book reviews may be retrieved by searching for author in the IDENTIFIER (ID) paragraph with 'BOOK REVIEWS' in DESCRIPTOR (DE) (1978-1980) or MAJOR DESCRIPTOR (MA) (1981-) paragraphs. Full citations of reviewed documents is given in the title paragraph or in the abstract paragraph if review has distinctive title. Name of reviewer is included in the AUTHOR paragraph.

D SUBJECT INDEXING

In the data base, there are four paragraphs for recording subject information

DESCRIPTOR

MAJOR DESCRIPTOR

MINOR DESCRIPTOR

IDENTIFIERS

The field DESCRIPTOR used for documents indexed prior to October 1980 (Record 4600) is replaced by two fields MAJOR DESCRIPTOR and MINOR DESCRIPTOR.

Terms recorded in the MAJOR DESCRIPTOR and IDENTIFIERS paragraphs are selected to describe the subject of the item being indexed, and appear with entries and as headings in the Subject Index in the printed issues of AEI. The MINOR DESCRIPTOR paragraph contains terms selected either to refine the description given by the MAJOR DESCRIPTORS and IDENTIFIERS or to provide access to secondary aspects of the items, and do not appear in the printed issues of AEI.

1 DESCRIPTORS

Terms entered in the MAJOR DESCRIPTOR and MINOR DESCRIPTOR paragraphs (DESCRIPTOR paragraph before Record 4600) are selected from, and controlled by The Thesaurus of ERIC descriptors. For Documents nos. 1-5300 (1978-1980), terms were selected from 7th edition 1977. Commencing with Document no. 5301 (1981) terms are selected from the Revised edition 1980. Some changes have been made so that terms are consistent with Australian usage. These changes include:

- 'Primary education' instead of 'Elementary education' and the use of 'Primary' instead of 'Elementary' in phrases, e.g. Primary school mathematics.
- Extension of 'University' in a similar way as 'College'
- Introduction of the terms 'Australian Aborigines' and 'Australian Aboriginal ...'. Terms have been formed in a similar way to 'Blacks' and 'Black ...'.
- 'Year 1', 'Year 2', etc. instead of 'Grade 1', 'Grade 2', etc.

In addition, the accepted Australian spelling of some words is preferred to American usage, e.g. 'behaviour' in preference to 'behavior'; 'enrolment' to 'enrollment'; 'counselling' to 'counseling'.

On the average, eight (8) descriptors are assigned to a document, although the number varies with the indexing requirements of each document. Three to five major descriptors can be used to represent the major concepts of the documents, and also serve to provide a limited number of access points in the printed AEI indexes.

Users are advised to refer to the Thesaurus to establish the appropriate terms before commencing a subject search.

Identifying terms for subjects not adequately covered by The ERIC Thesaurus and also for projects and studies are used occasionally, e.g. School based curriculum; Australian Science Education Project. These terms are not controlled in any way but an attempt is made to maintain some consistency in format. Personal names and names of corporate bodies are also included in this paragraph if relevant to the document but do not appear in the AUTHOR, CC AUTHOR or INSTITUTION paragraph.

E STOPWORDS

Some words within the data base are 'stopped', i.e. not stored for searching purposes. Stopwords have been chosen to reduce the size of the Inverted and Dictionary files. There are normally words which occur with great frequency but are unnecessary for searching. A list of 'Stopwords' appears in Appendix 3.

In searching it should be remembered that a 'Stopword' does still occupy a position. For example, LOCUS OF CONTROL does not become searchable as LOCUS ADJ CONTROL because 'OF' is a 'Stopword'. The phrase would have to be searched as LOCUS with CONTROL.

F DOCUMENT BACKUP

Availability and price for acquiring documents are shown for many documents. However most documents excluding these are available in the ACER library and requests should be processed through the interlibrary loan system.
