ABSTRACT

This report provides vocational teachers with readability information for selected vocational texts. Selected texts are categorized and appear in charts according to 21 vocational programs: accounting, air conditioning and refrigeration, automotive shop (automotive body and fender repair, automotive mechanics), aviation shop, business, carpentry, cosmetology, data processor-computer operator, design-drafting-engineering, electronics, farm management--mechanics and production, fashion design, food science, graphic arts, health care (practical nursing--dental assistant, medical assistant), heating and plumbing, machine shop (machinists, metallurgy, tools), secretarial science--stenographer and related occupations, sheet metal, typing and related occupations, and welding. The mean reading level (in terms of grade level), of each text are given based upon these readability formulas: Flesch, Forecast, Dale-Chall, Fry, and Raygor. Other information provided for each includes title, author, year, publisher, and source of information. (YLB)



FORWARD

Reading assignments are often very hard for vocational students. Vocational reading matter is often highly technical and full of unfamiliar vocabulary.

Vocational teachers need to select reading assignments with care. When text material is very difficult, students may not be able to understand it. This chapter provides resources to help you analyze the reading difficulty level of printed material and use that information for selecting texts and making reading assignments.

Warning: Readability analysis could be
hazardous to your teaching

The readability studies in this report all report reading difficulty in terms of grade-level. That is, text material is described in terms of the grade level of students who ordinarily should be able to read it. A book which has a difficulty of "9.5" is appropriate for the "average" student "midway through ninth grade." In theory, this book should be appropriate for students who score near the 9.5 grade-level on standardized tests of reading. In practice, however, one should not take such readability measures so literally.

The best use of readability measures is for comparing two or more texts, not for judging one book alone, or for making arbitrary reading assignments. There are two reasons for this. First, the various formulas for computing difficulty give very different results. Although the data from these formulas correlate highly, that is, they order a set of books in a very similar sequence of difficulty, the grade-level scores they produce differ a great deal. Second, the most widely used measures of students' abilities--standardized tests--differ in the grade-level scores they will assign to a given student. That is, for a fixed level of

student ability, different tests will give quite different grade-level scores. Thus, both readability scores and test grade-level scores are useful only for comparison purposes; and only if you use the same tests for all comparison purposes.

In summary, the following resources are useful for judging the relative difficulty of two or more different texts, not for making an absolute judgment on one text, or a detailed matching of students' abilities with text difficulty.

Three extensive analyses of the readability of selected vocational texts were reviewed to form the charts on the following pages. These studies were:

By referring to such readability information, teachers who use the texts cited, or who are considering using them, can gain insights to the potential match between students' abilities and instructional requirements. In the event of a mismatch, alternative materials may be sought and lesson ideas developed to reinforce students' basic skills so that they will learn the skills necessary for occupational success.
