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ABSTRACT

College and university admissions and enrollment data for New York State for fall 1980 are presented. Fifteen statistical tables pertain to degree-credit and noncredit enrollment; four tables summarize undergraduate and graduate admissions. Tables include the following: trends in degree-credit enrollment in public, independent, and proprietary institutions of higher education by type of institution, 1965-1980; degree-credit enrollment by level of study, type of institution, and student sex, fall 1980; percent distribution of degree-credit enrollment by level of study; first-time student degree-credit enrollment by type of institution; degree-credit and noncredit enrollment by level of program and institution; undergraduate degree-credit enrollment by institutional classification and year of study; organized occupational, degree-credit enrollment by major program area, year of study, attendance status, and student sex; undergraduate-upper division degree-credit enrollment by major subject area, year of study, attendance status, and student sex; first-professional degree-credit enrollment by subject area; enrollment in master's and in doctoral degree programs by major subject area, attendance status, and student sex; trends in degree-credit enrollment by major subject area and level of study, 1978-1980; degree-credit unclassified enrollment by institutional classification and level of study; graduate certificate enrollment by institutional classification; trends in undergraduate admissions by type of institution and admissions status, 1978-1980; and trends in first-professional and graduate admissions by type of institution and admissions status. 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This publication is divided into two parts. Tables 1 through 15 pertain to degree-credit and noncredit enrollment, while tables 16 through 19 summarize undergraduate and graduate admissions.

In the enrollment portion, Table 5 is the summary table of degree-credit and noncredit enrollment. Table 6 reports the same enrollment by institution. Further detail of the summary data by level are found in the following tables:

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DEFINITIONS

DEGREE-CREDIT ENROLLMENT: Students in a program or taking courses which are creditable toward a diploma, certificate, associate, bachelor's, master's, doctoral, or first-professional degree.

UNDERGRADUATE:

LOWER DIVISION - Includes freshmen and sophomores in bachelor's degree programs, students in associate degree programs, and students in terminal occupational programs of one, two, or three years that result in formal recognition below the baccalaureate.

UPPER DIVISION - Includes students who have completed the sophomore year and typically are enrolled in a four-or five-year bachelor's degree program.

UNCLASSIFIED - Not candidates for a degree or other formal award, although taking degree-credit courses designated by the institution as undergraduate level.

ORGANIZED OCCUPATIONAL ENROLLMENT - Students in a program specifically associated with the development of skills required for occupations at the technical or semiprofessional level.

FIRST-TIME STUDENTS - Students who have not previously enrolled in any college. However, students admitted under "Advance Credit or Advance Placement" plans if they had never been previously enrolled in an institution of higher education and students attending college for the first time during the summer session are included.

FIRST-PROFESSIONAL: Students enrolled in a professional school or program which required at least two academic years of college work for entrance and a total of at least six years for a degree. Report only students in the following first-professional degree programs: Dentistry (D.D.S. or D.M.D. degree), Medicine (M.D. degree), Optometry (O.D. degree), Osteopathic Medicine (D.O. degree), Pharmacy (D.Pharm. degree), Podiatry (Pod.D., D.P. or Podiatric Medicine, D.P.M., include Chiropody), Veterinary Medicine (D.V.M. degree), Chiropractic (D.C. degree), Law (LL.B. or J.D. degree), and Theological Professions (B.D., M.Div., Rabbi or other first-professional degree).

GRADUATE:

MASTER'S OR DOCTORAL DEGREE ENROLLMENT - Students who hold a bachelor's or first-professional degree or equivalent, and are in a program for a master's or doctoral degree.

GRADUATE CERTIFICATE ENROLLMENT - Students enrolled in graduate level curricula which lead to a certificate, such as a Certificate of Advanced Studies (CAS, School Administrator and Supervisor, School Counselor, and Library and Information Studies).

UNCLASSIFIED - Students who are not candidates for a graduate degree or certificate but taking degree-credit courses, designated by the institution as graduate level.

FULL-TIME: Those students whose academic load-course work or other required activity is at least 75 percent of the normal full-time load. Undergraduate students must carry at least 12 credit hours to be considered full-time, while graduate students must carry at least 9 credit hours.

PART-TIME: Those students whose academic load-course work or other required activity is less than 75 percent of the normal full-time load.

NONCREDIT ENROLLMENT: Students taking courses which are not creditable towards a degree, diploma, or certificate.
