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ABSTRACT

Summary statistics on fall 1981 application and registration patterns of applicants wishing to pursue full-time study in first-year places in Ontario, Canada, universities are presented. Each applicant was allowed to indicate up to three choices of universities and programs. Each choice was considered to be a distinct application, even though the applicant submitted only one application form. Applicants also indicated their order of preference for their choices. Year 5 applicants refer to those applicants who were registered during the 1980-1981 academic year as full-time students in year 5 of the Ontario secondary school, while all other applicants refer to regular applicants. In addition to application and registration ratios for 1973-1981, data are provided on: applicants and registered applicants by university and student category for 1981; applicants and registered applicants by choice preference (first, second, and third) by university; applicants and registered applicants by academic program, and by choice preference for each program; summary of regular applications, applicants, and registered applicants by educational source of applicants; distribution of active applications by geographic origin of applicants as a percentage of total applications by applicant type for each university; distribution of year 5 and regular active applicants and registered applicants by age and sex; distribution of year 5 and regular active applicants and registered applicants by country of citizenship and immigration status; and applicants and registered applicants by program and sex. 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APPLICATION STATISTICS

1981

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This report presents summary statistics on application and registration patterns of applicants wishing to pursue full-time study in first-year places in Ontario universities. This is the ninth in a series of annual reports which commenced with admissions in the fall of 1973.

To facilitate timely release of these statistics, no commentary has been included in the report.

Introduction

This report presents application and registration data for the fall of 1981. The presentation of the data is identical to that used in the last year's report. Users are cautioned to read the limitations section of this report to be aware of any factors which might affect the comparability of data in this report, both to earlier reports in this series and to other reports which present registration statistics.

Definitions

For the purpose of this report, the definitions used by the Ontario Universities' Application Centre have been employed.

Year 5 applicants refer to those applicants who were registered during the 1980-81 academic year as full-time students in Year 5 of an Ontario secondary school. All other applicants were defined to be Regular applicants.

Each applicant was allowed to indicate up to three choices of universities and programmes. Each choice was considered to be a distinct application, even though the applicant submitted only one application form. Applicants also indicated their order of preference for their choices.

Throughout the admission cycle, applicants were permitted to amend their choices by dropping a choice and adding a different choice. Deleted choices are referred to as inactive choices or applications while current choices (up to the maximum of three) are called active choices.

All of the tables in this report exclude inactive choices.

The Application Centre was responsible for processing all applications for first-year full-time applicants who were not previously registered at an Ontario university. When these applicants subsequently registered at an university, they were designated as registered applicants. If a student had been previously registered (i.e. repeater or internal transfer between programmes) at that institution, his application was not processed by the Centre. Data on all students registered in first-year programmes on a full-time basis were provided to the Centre by the universities via the Statistics Canada/MCU USIS/UAR system. Included in these figures were those students who had applied for advanced standing above first year but had subsequently registered in first year. Where universities did not identify the classification of some of their registrants, these registrants were recorded as unidentified registrants.

Statistics presented in this report deal only with applicants processed by the Application Centre who are applying for fall entry into full-time study in first year of post-Year 5 programmes. In addition to the exclusions listed in the previous paragraph, applicants seeking admission to preliminary year programmes or diploma programmes which do not require Year 5 for entry have been excluded. Table 15 presents a reconciliation of the various categories of registrants in first year.

General Limitations

As previously stated, the Application Centre received data on registrations indirectly from the universities as part of their annual submission of USIS/UAR enrolment data to Statistics Canada and MCU. Prior to 1979, the universities submitted data on registrations directly to the Centre. Data on registrations are particularly sensitive to the count date employed. In 1973, 1974 and 1975 the universities counted their registrants in late September for submission to the Application Centre in early October. Statistics submitted to MCU and Statistics Canada employed a December 1 count date. Commencing in 1976, all registration statistics submitted to OUAC, MCU and Statistics Canada were based on a November 1 count date. However, the statistics reported may not agree because of differences in the definitions of full-time employed for the different submissions.

In its operations the Application Centre employs a unique set of programme categories; there may not be a direct correspondence between these categories and the programme categories used by MCU and Statistics Canada. Furthermore, there may be instances where a student is reported in one programme to the Application Centre and reported in a different programme to either MCU or Statistics Canada. In addition, statistics showing enrolment in "First Year" from MCU and Statistics Canada may include programmes (e.g., law, medicine, etc.) which are not included in first year as defined by the Application Centre.

Applicants were permitted up to three choices of universities and programmes on the application form. The one exception to this was in 1973

when regular applicants were required to submit a separate application form for each choice of programme and university, up to the maximum of three choices.

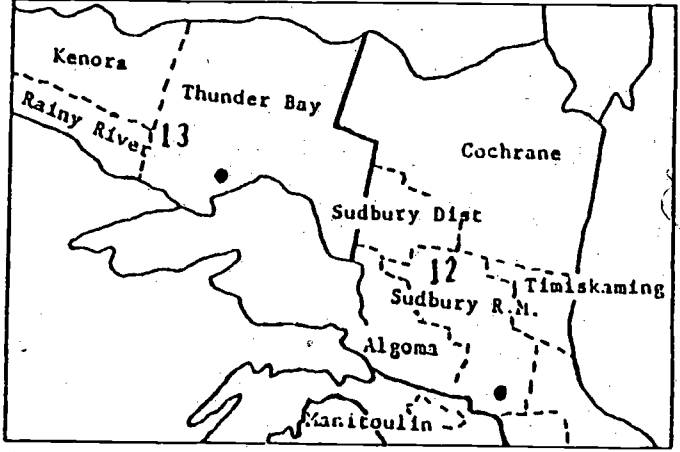
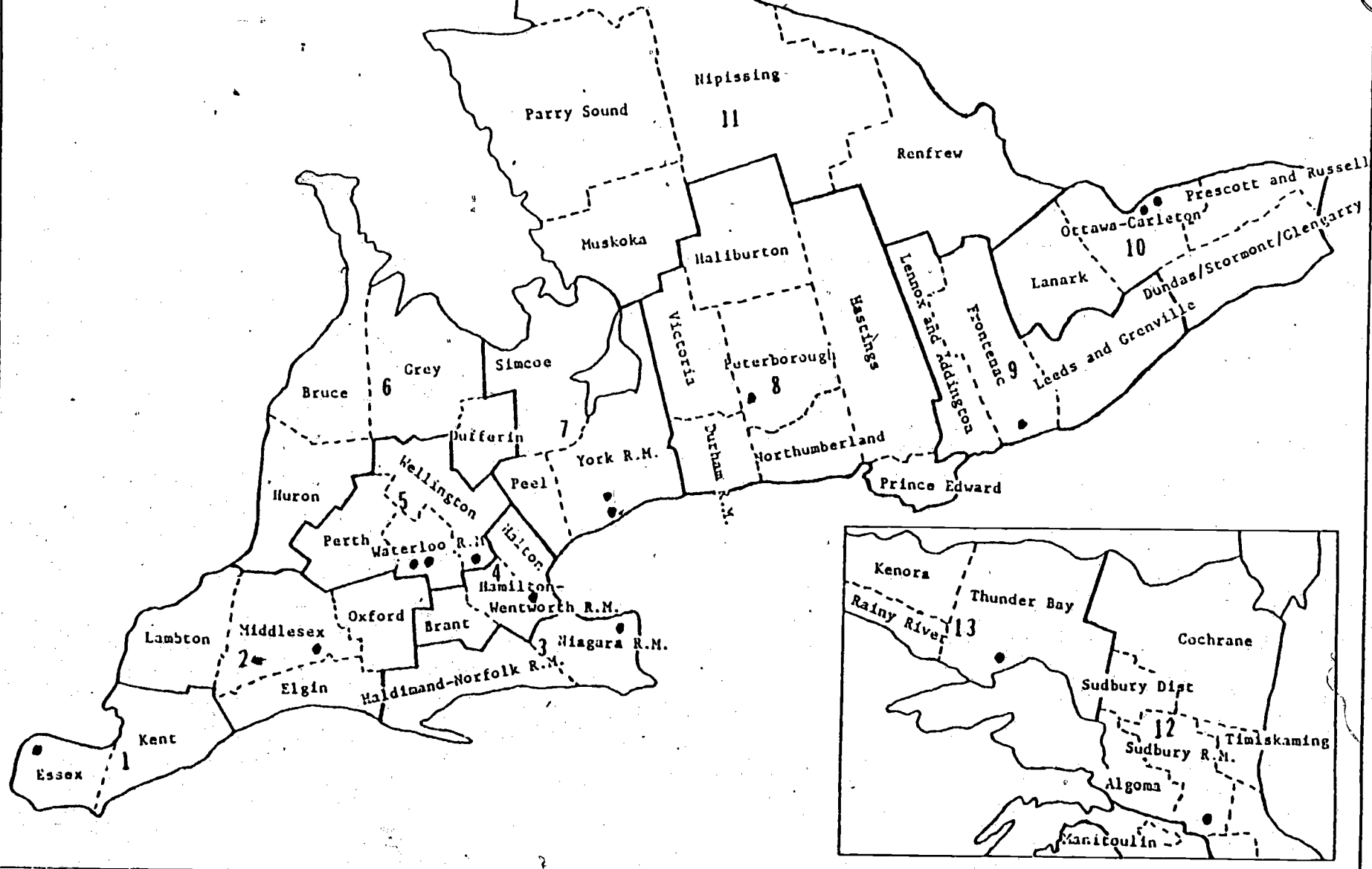
