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## ABSTRACT

This publication contains a listing of educational research and development projects currently in progress in Australia, which is the first of a planned twice-yearly listing of projects in progress. Projects are listed by territories and are indexed by author and by subject. Information supplied for each project includes a reference number, project title, contact person, contact address, project status, proposed completion date, estimated cost, and a short description of the project. The projects cover all fields of education. A sample of subjects include the following: language needs of migrants in Darwin; development of external studies materials; computer-based screening and diagnostic testing system; a review of the carpentry and joinery course; assessing community needs for further education; training for teachers in the instructional systems model of curriculum development; associate diploma in coal mining; a case study of a Peninsula Community College foundation course; guidelines for curriculum writers; and an occupational analysis of the printing trade. Remarks: In recent years a number of trade areas have been undergoing radical changes due to the introduction of new technology, consequently manufacturers and service organisations have found the need for their apprentices and servicemen to receive appropriate training. It was because TAFE had no appropriate courses to offer in this area that the submission was made.

The submission (electrical/electronic trades) proposed a two-year program in which research and planning to the initial stage of producing a detailed operative proposal for implementation is completed in the first year followed by a limited trial, evaluation and teacher development program in the second year.

In broad terms the program of work for 1981 comprised three stages. The first stage involved collecting facts, figures and opinions, the second stage involved analysing the skills required by competent servicemen and the third stage involved preparing performance objectives, learning units, syllabi, lists of teaching aids, teaching times, etc., to enable limited trials and evaluation to commence in 1982. The work is now sufficiently advanced for limited trials and evaluation to commence.
