

PRELIMINARY WASH

- 1. REMOVED ALL JEWELRY BEFORE STARTING PROCEDURE
- 2. TURNED WATER ON WITH FOOT OR KNEE CONTROL AND ADJUSTED WATER TEMPERATURE TO A COMFORTABLE LEVEL
- 3. ADJUSTED THE RATE OF FLOW SO WATER DID NOT SPLASH

- 14. DID NOT USE HANDS TO REMOVE ANY LATHER
- 15. WHEN ALL LATHER REMOVED FROM BOTH HANDS AND ARMS, TURNED OFF THE WATER WITH KNEE OR FOOT CONTROL
- 16. KEPT HANDS UP, ARMS ABOVE WAIST, AND AWAY FROM BODY

- * USE "GLO-GERM" FOR PRACTICE SCRUBS.






