ABSTRACT

Fall 1982 registration data for Hawaii's community colleges were analyzed to determine the course-taking patterns of different groups of student majors and the client-serving patterns of different academic departments. Major findings reveal that students seeking a certificate were taking 56% of their course work in vocational courses; those seeking an associate in arts degree (AA) were taking 88% of their work in general education; and those seeking an associate in science degree (AS) were taking 54% of their work in vocational courses. The courses taken by certificate and AS students were generally numbered less than 100, while AA students took 75% of their course work in courses numbered 100 or higher. As in previous years, liberal arts majors took the bulk of their course work (88%) in general education courses, and vocational majors took 56% of their course work in vocational education areas. Vocational students continued to generate the bulk of the vocational student semester hours (SSH's), and to generate an increasing proportion of the SSH's in general education courses. Other findings indicated that the proportion of SSH's generated by general education was slightly less than two-thirds of the total, and that 87% of the SSH's taken by early admits and 63% taken by concurrent registrants were in general education courses. Data tables and charts comprise the bulk of the report, providing combined and institutional statistics and illustrating trends. (HB)

The academic crossover study report was developed primarily to answer two questions: (1) what is the course-taking pattern of the different groups of student majors? e.g., what proportion of the liberal arts majors' academic load is in the humanities? in the natural sciences? in vocational courses? (2) what is the "client"-serving pattern of the different subject disciplines? e.g., what proportion of the student semester hours in the humanities is generated by liberal arts majors? business majors? health services majors?

Such information has been found especially helpful for physical facilities planning, for estimating staffing needs and for academic planning, in general.

Sources of Data

Computer reports 2524B, C, D, based upon the student registrations as of October 15, 1982, were used as the primary sources of data. Included in this report are the student semester hours (SSH) generated by early admits and concurrent students as well as by regular credit students.

Highlights

The data show that the course-taking, client-serving patterns have generally remained stable over the past five years.

I. What is the course-taking pattern of students?

A. By educational objective (Table 1):

1. Certificate of Completion students took 56 percent of their work in vocational education courses; Certificate of Achievement students, 67 percent in vocational courses; Associate in Arts (A.A.) students, 88 percent in general education courses; Associate in Science (A.S.) students, 54 percent in vocational courses; and "other" students (special and unclassified), 65 percent in general education.
2. Certificate of Completion, Certificate of Achievement and A.S. students took 81, 80 and 65 percents, respectively, of their work in courses numbered below 100. A.A. and "other" students took 75 and 61 percents, respectively, of their work in courses numbered 100 and over.

B. By majors (Table 2 and Chart 1) (see Appendix A for major groupings):

1. Liberal arts majors continued to take the bulk of their work (88 percent) in general education courses (as in previous semesters).
2. Vocational majors continued to take most of their work (56 percent) in vocational education courses (as compared with 63-57 percent in previous semesters).
3. Unclassified students continued to take about two-thirds of their work in general education.

II. What groups of student majors do the different "departments" serve? (Table 2, Chart 2):

- A. General Education Courses: As in the past years, liberal arts majors were the largest consumers of general education courses (57 percent). However, in recent years, proportionately more of the student semester hours in general education courses have been generated by vocational education and unclassified students.
- B. Vocational Courses: Vocational students continued to generate the bulk of the vocational SSH (78 percent), followed by liberal arts majors (13 percent) and unclassified students (8 percent).

III. Other observations:

- A. As in the past years, the proportion of SSH generated in the general education area was slightly less than two-thirds (64 percent) of the total. The range was from 52 percent at Maui Community College to 81 percent at Windward Community College. Thirty-one percent of all SSH generated was in the humanities.
- B. Slightly over half of the SSH was generated in courses numbered over 100. Seventy-five percent of the SSH of liberal arts students was in courses numbered over 100; 68 percent of the vocational students' credits was in courses numbered below 100.
- C. Close to 59 percent of all SSH generated in courses numbered below 100 was in vocational education courses (58,791 of 100,022 SSH).
- D. Eighty-seven percent of the SSH taken by early admits was in general education courses. The 471 SSH attributed to early admits constituted 0.2 percent of total SSH.
- E. Sixty-three percent of the 80 SSH taken by concurrent registrants was in general education courses.

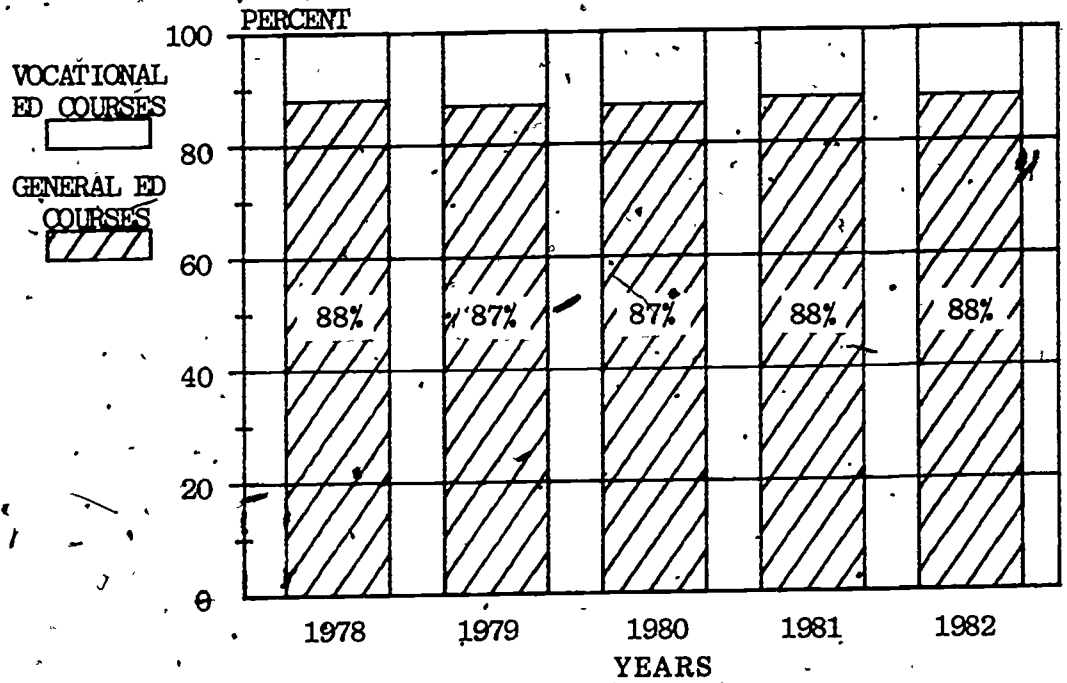

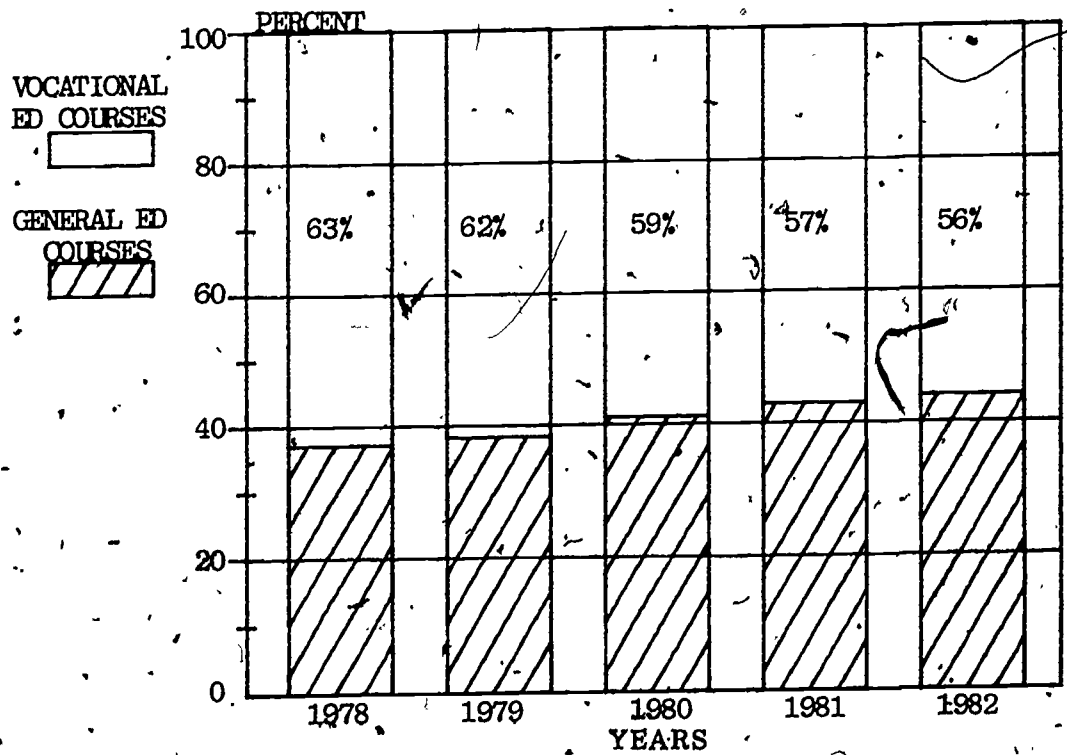
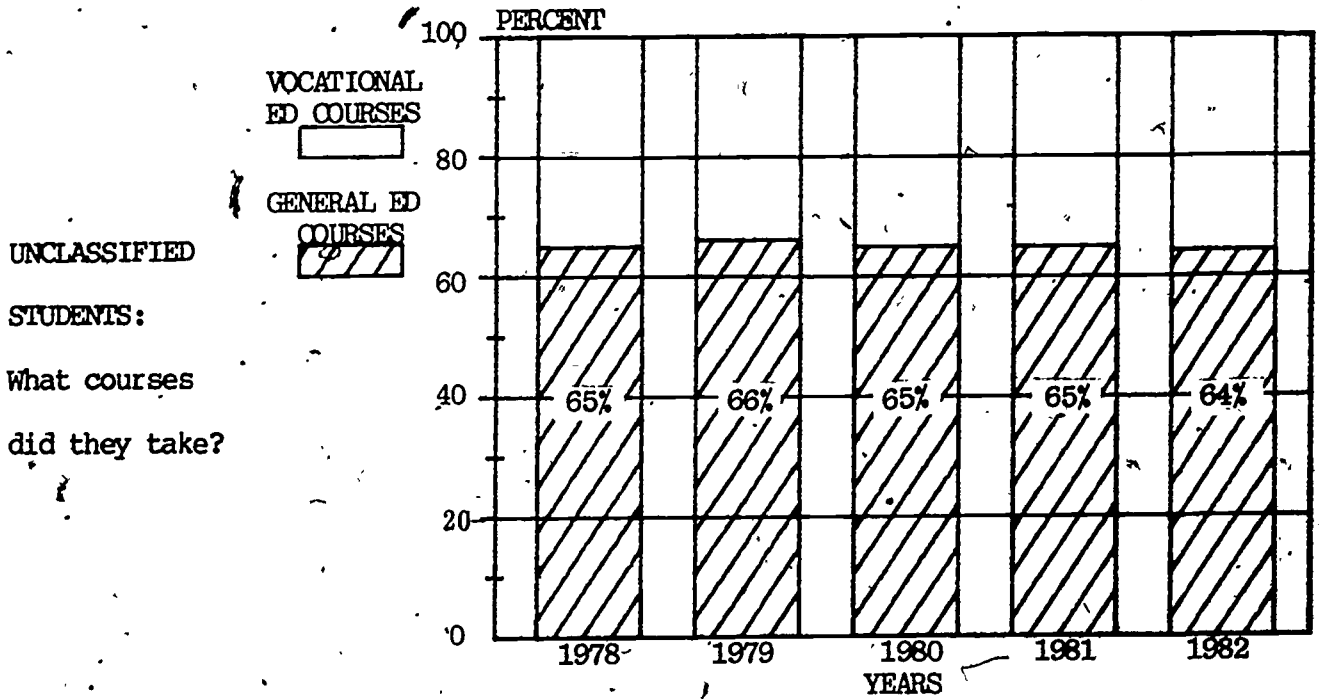

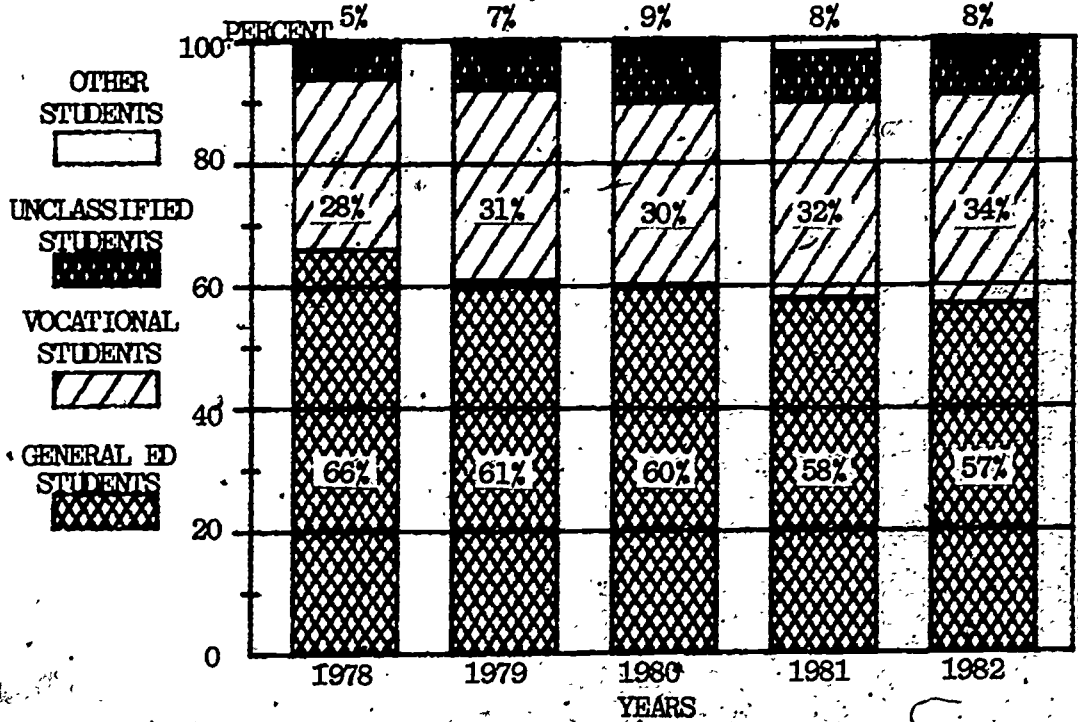

FALL 1978 TO FALL 1982

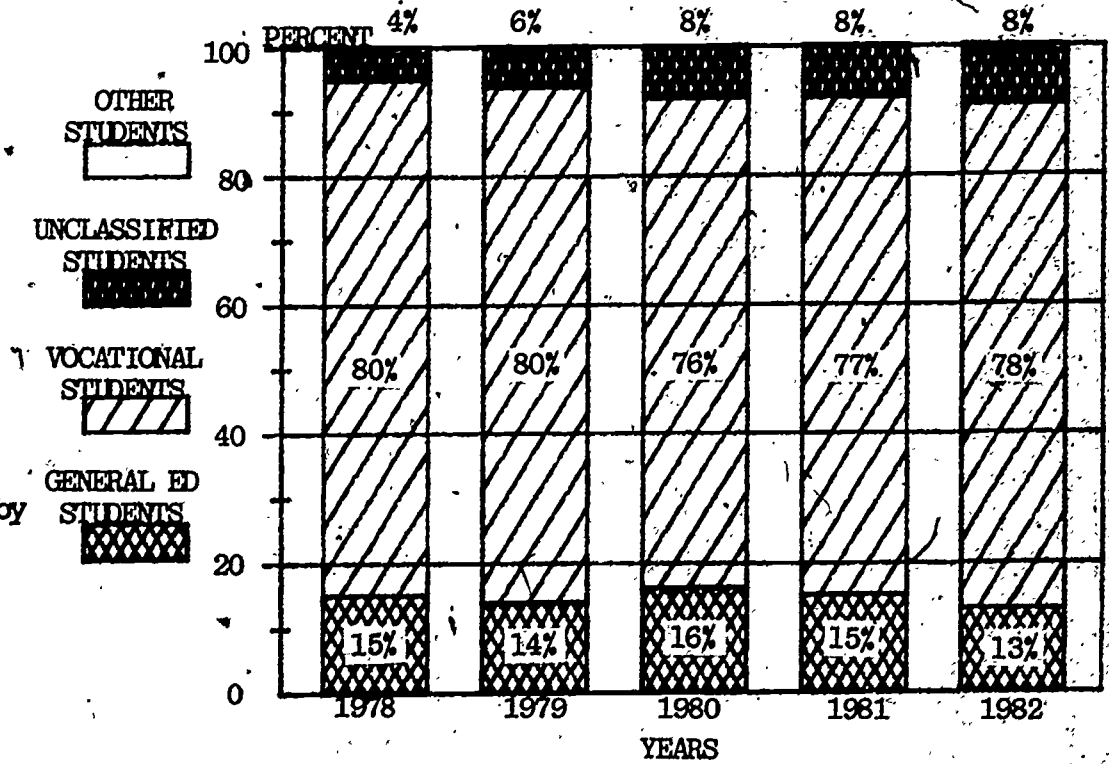

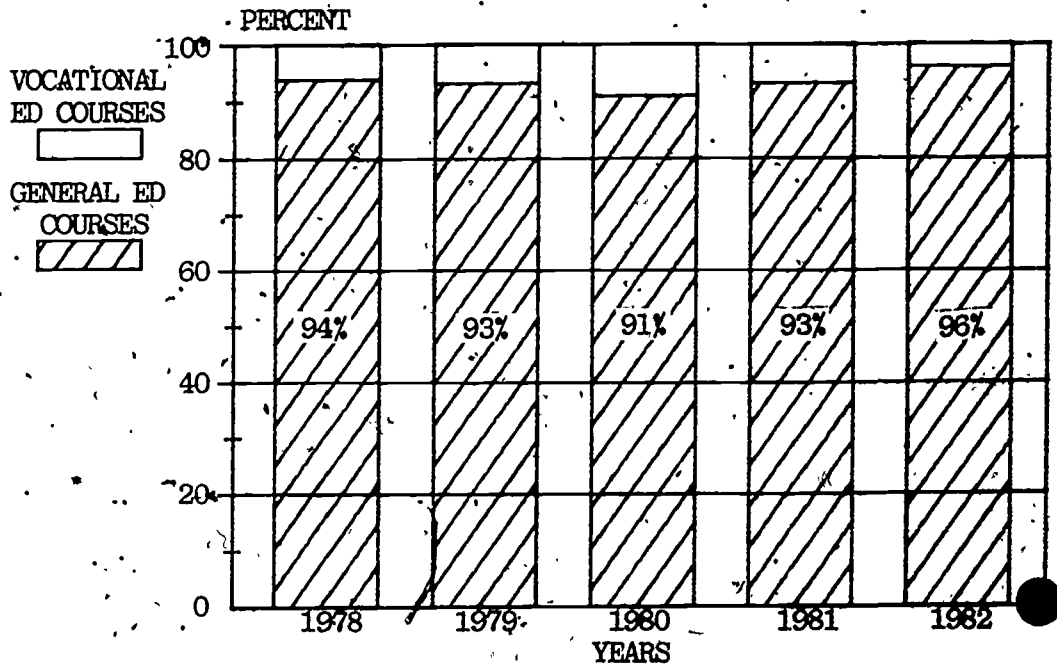

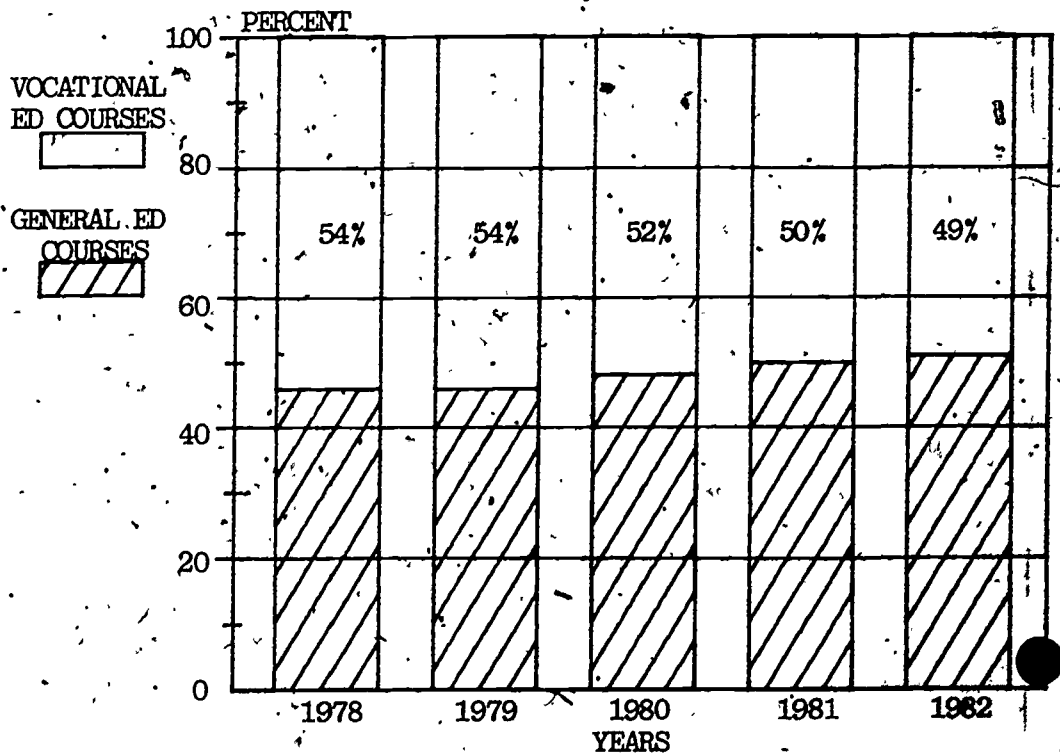

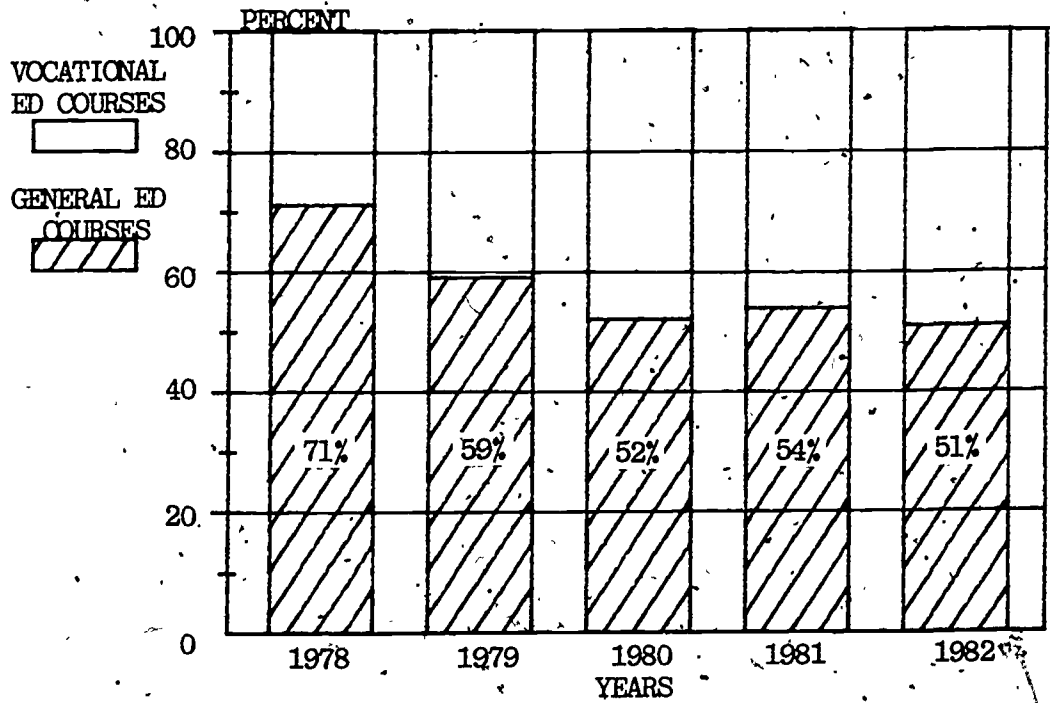
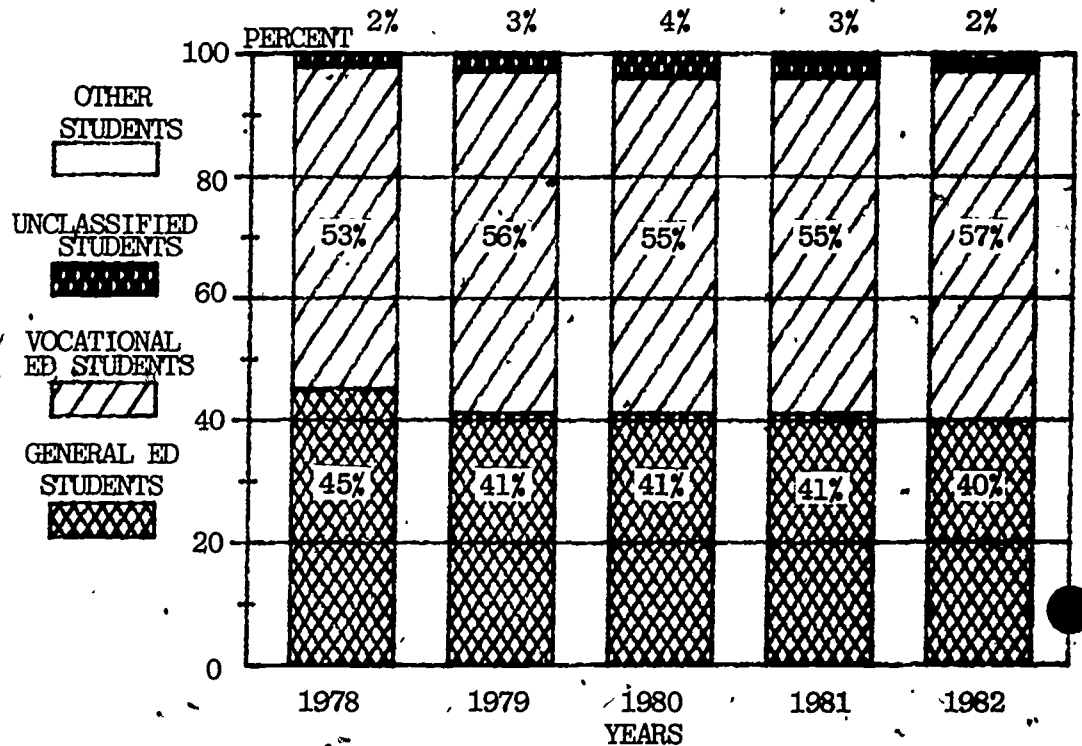

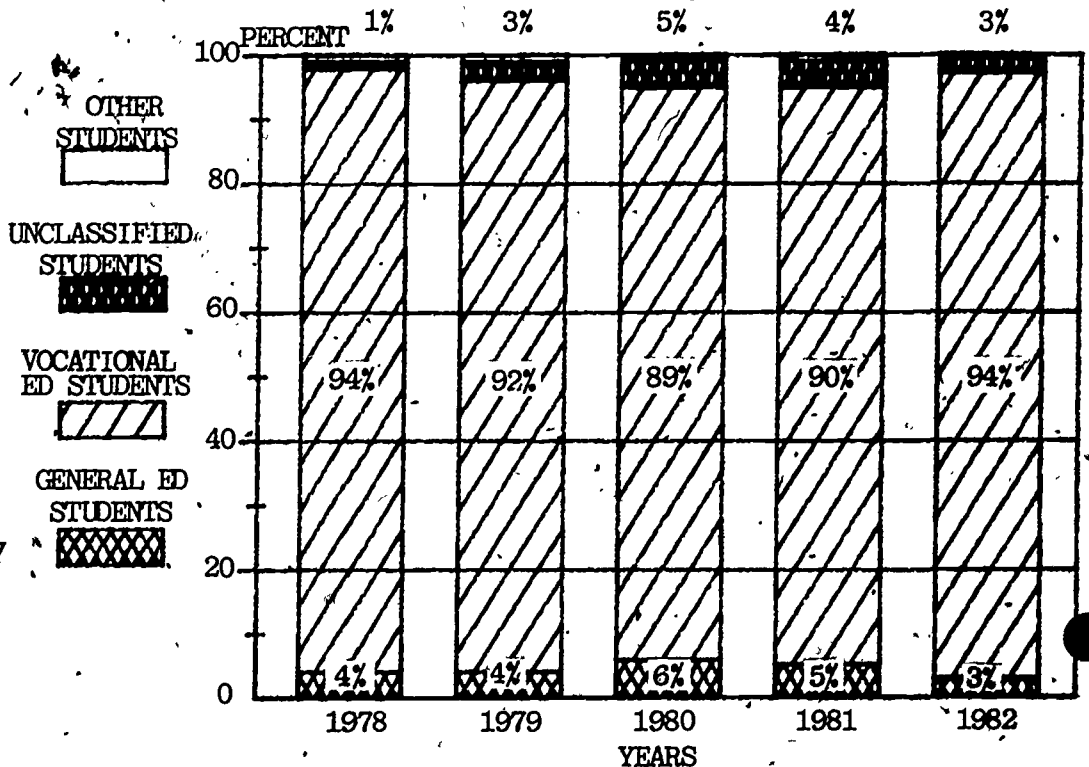

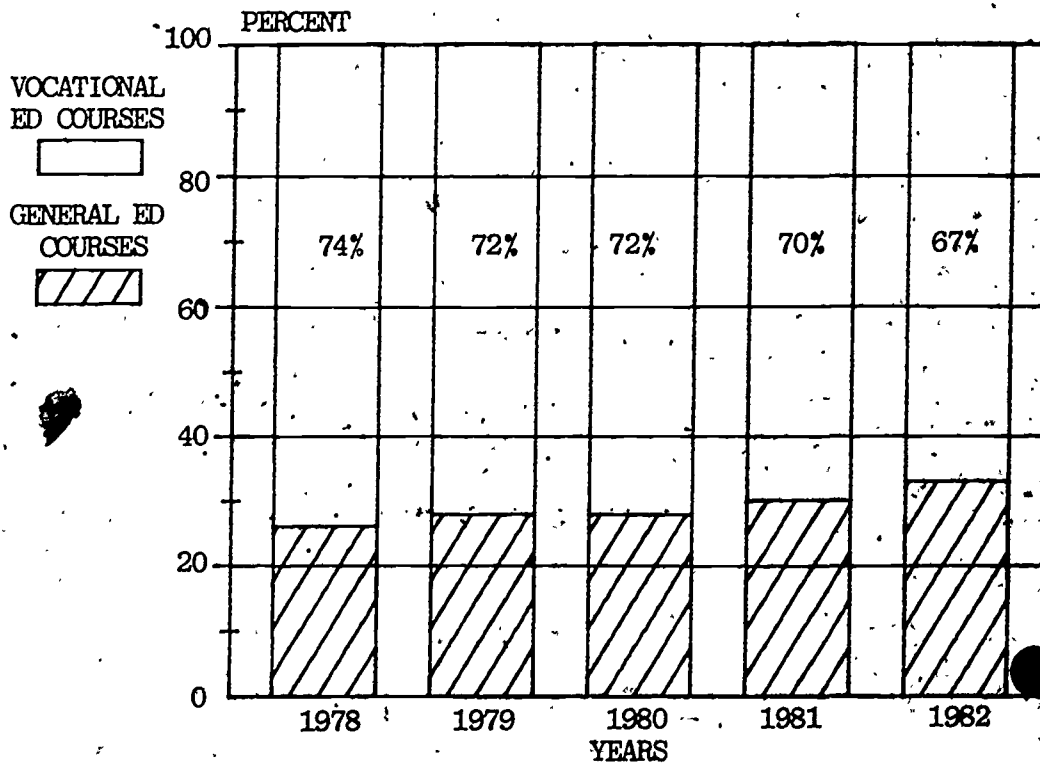

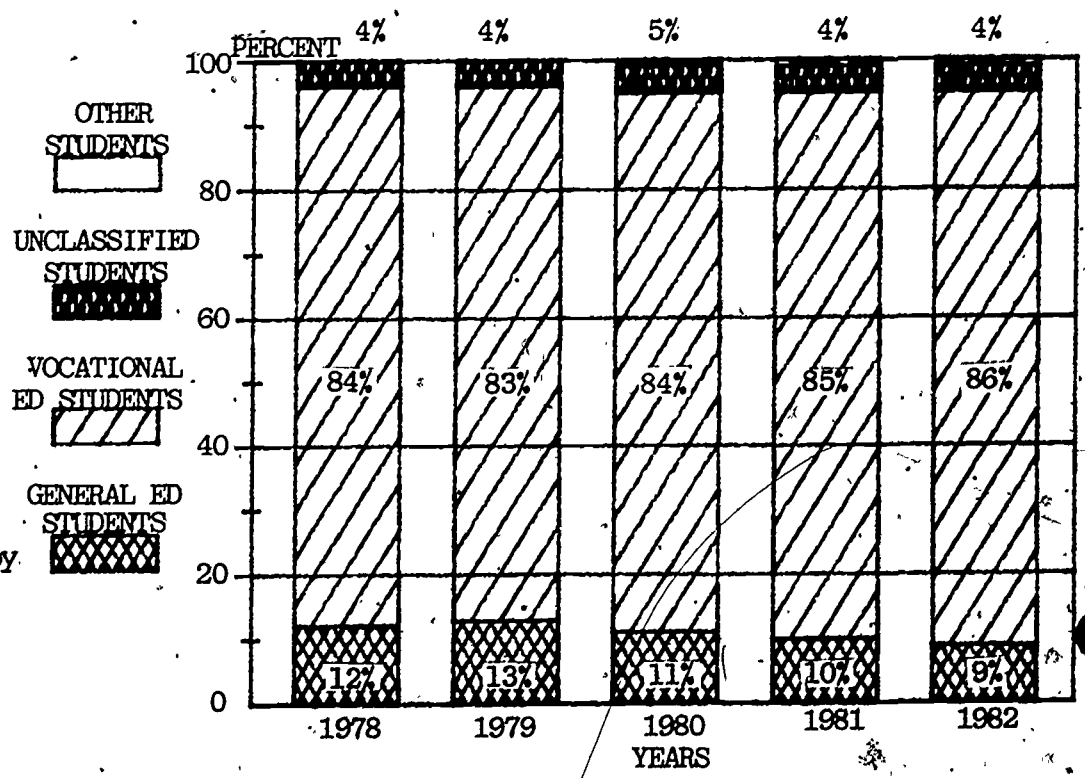

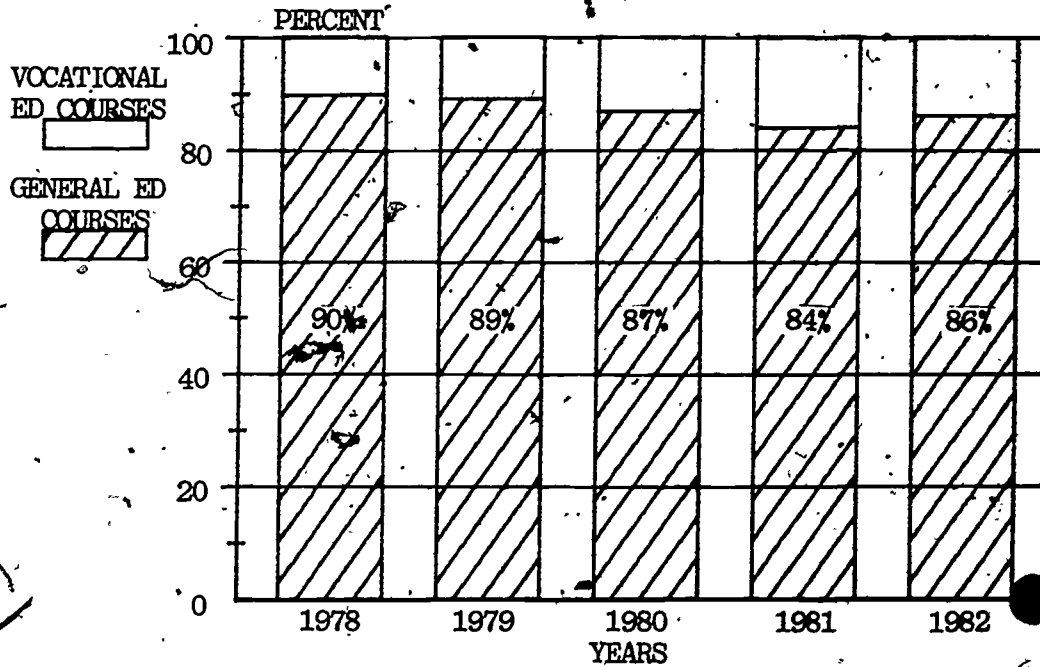

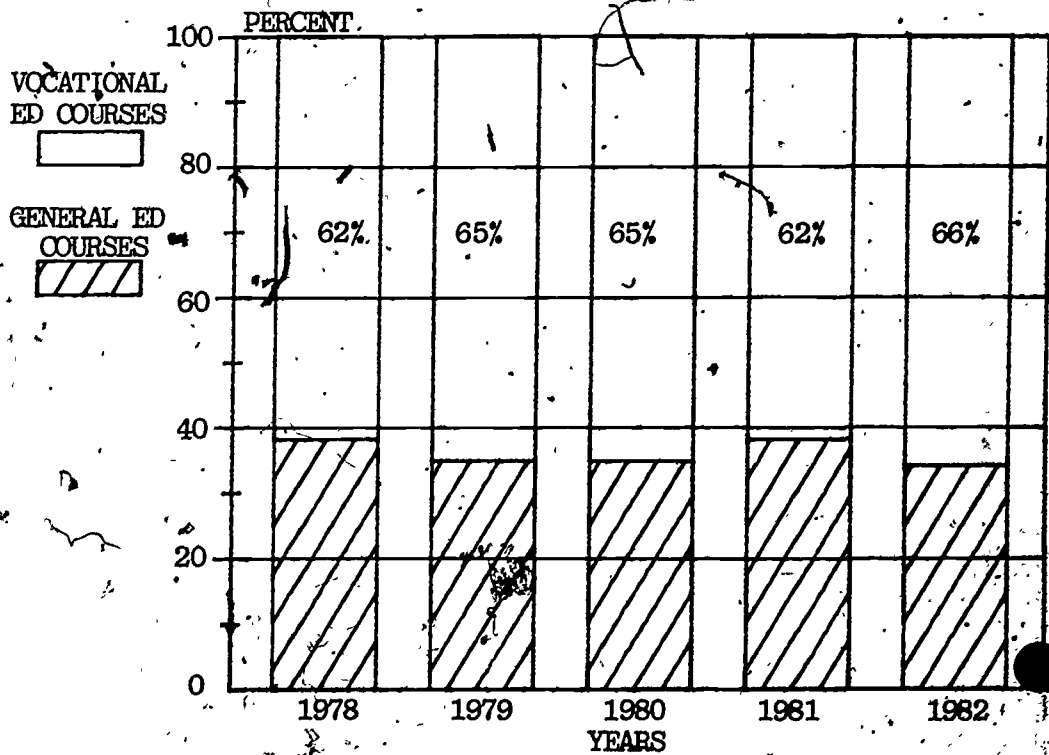
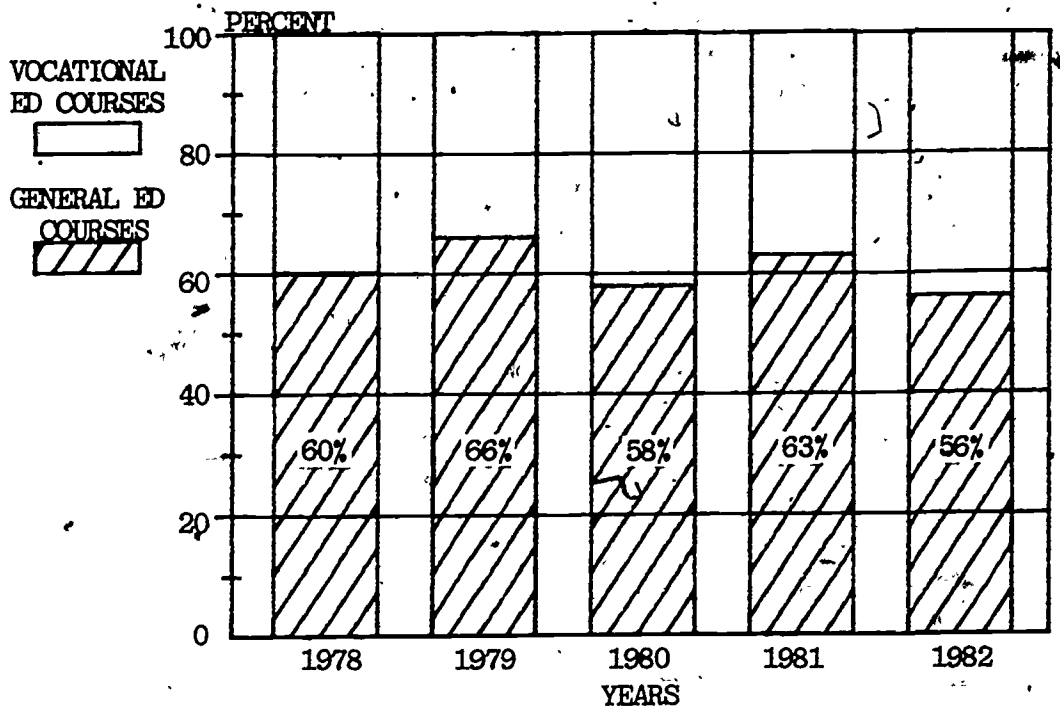


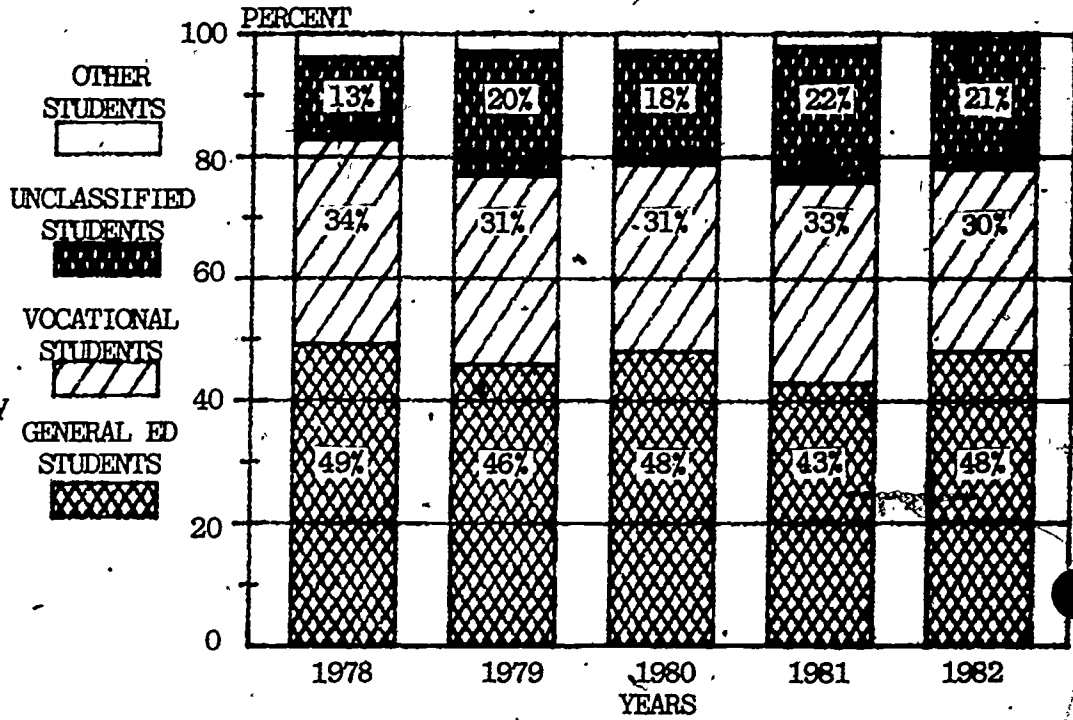

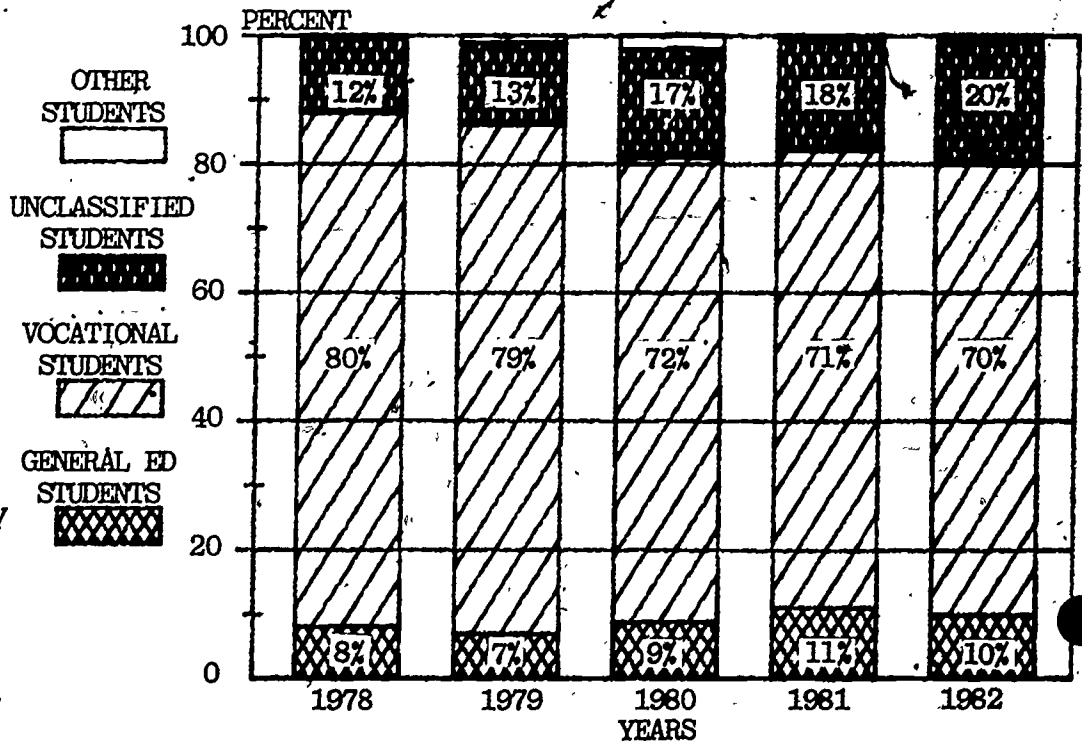

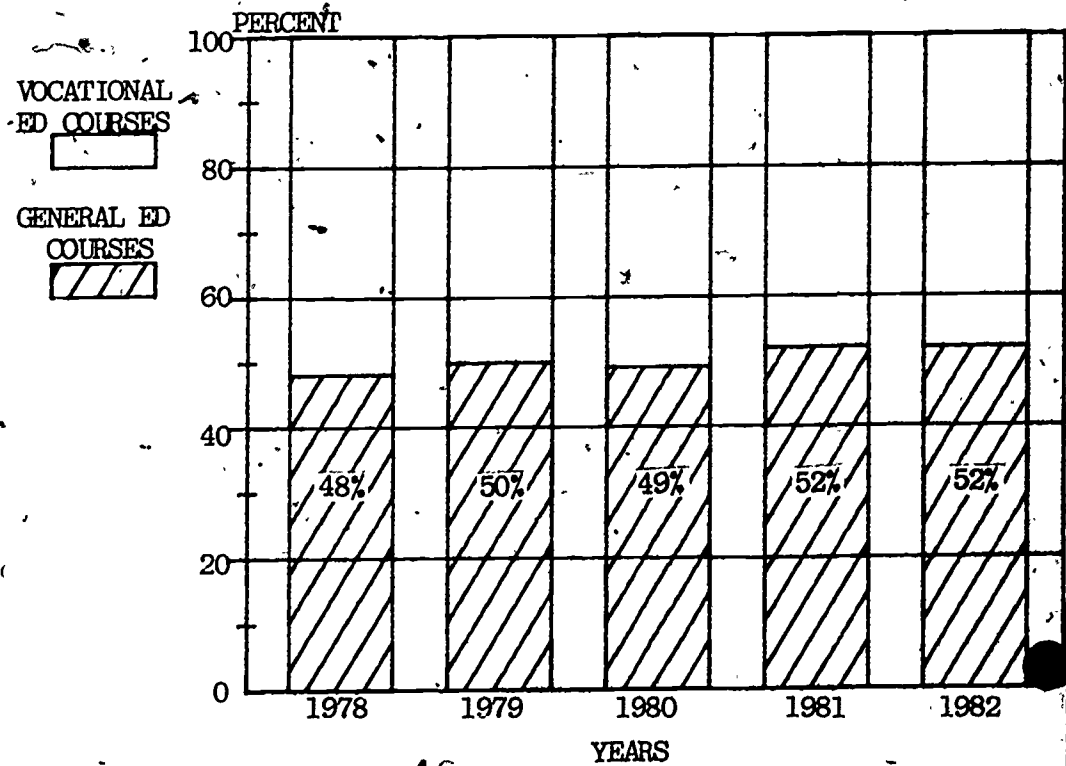

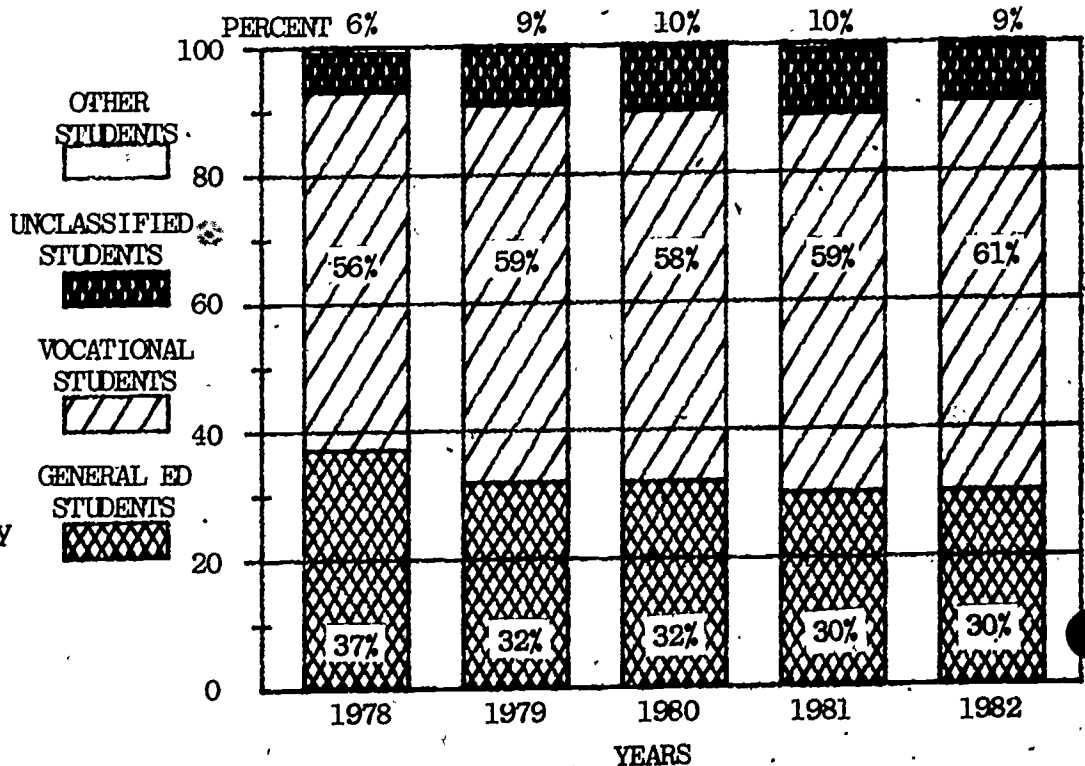

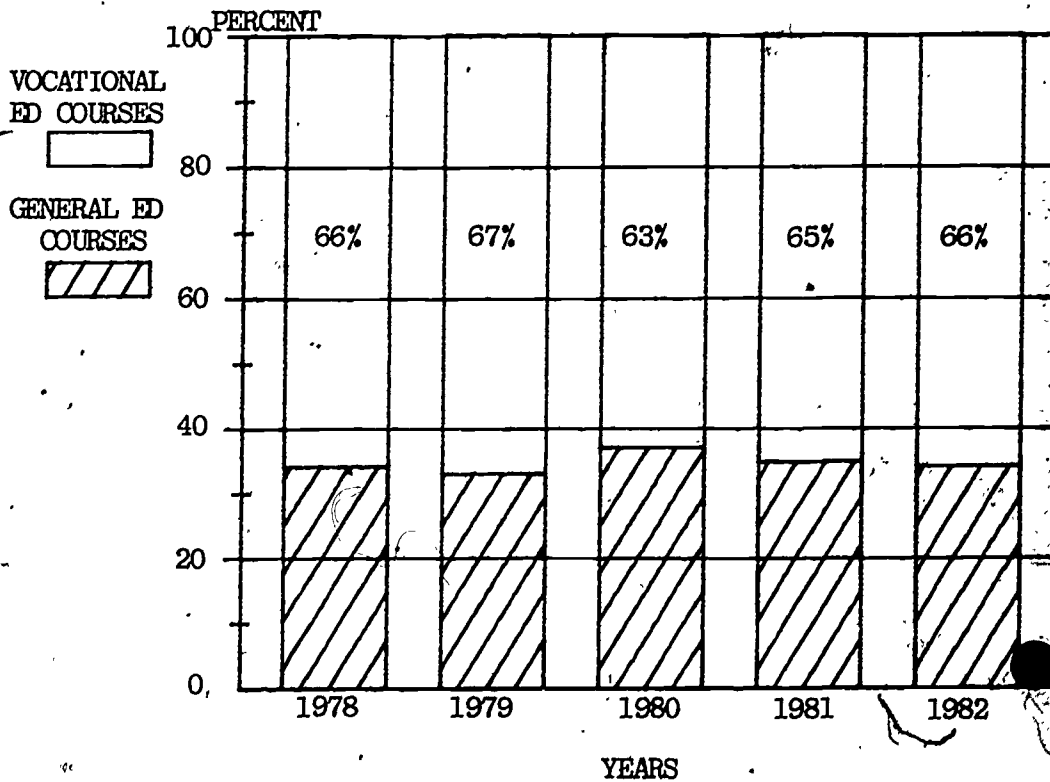

 FALL 1978 TO FALL 1982

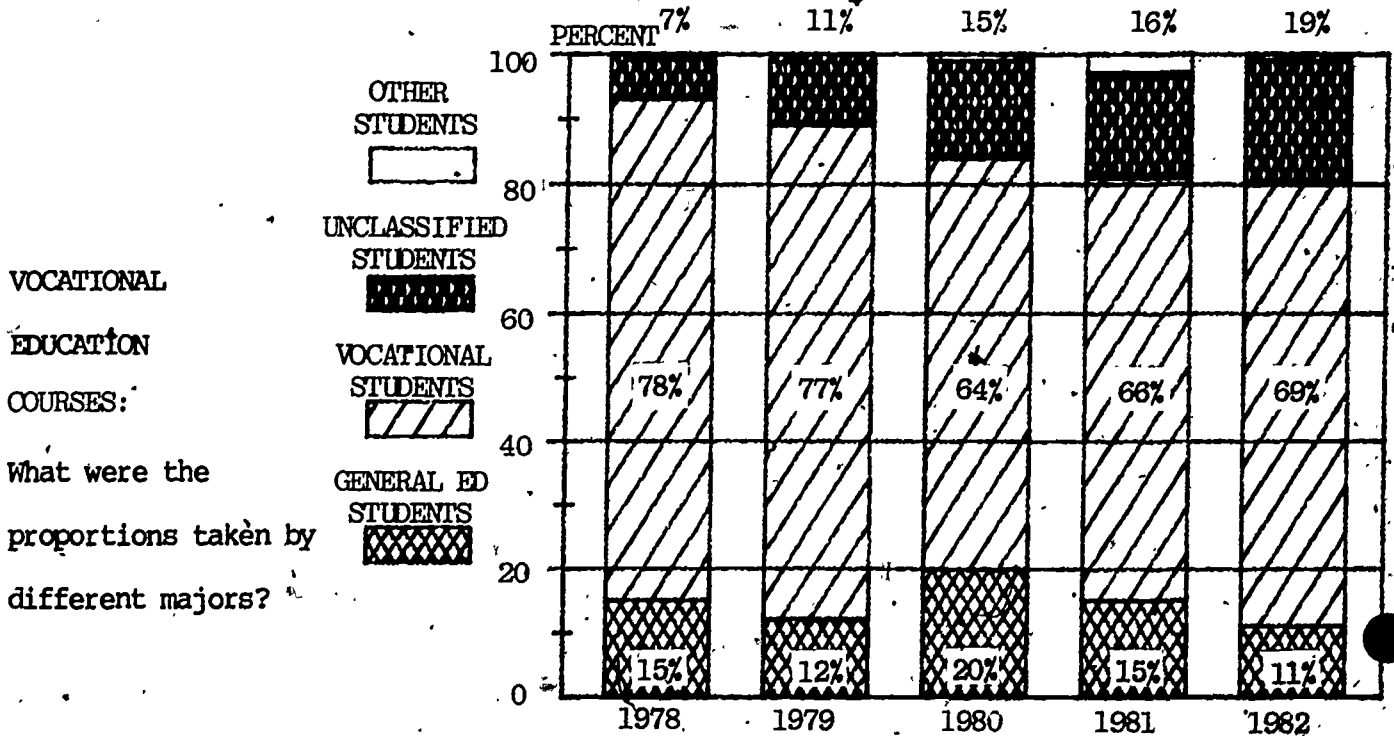
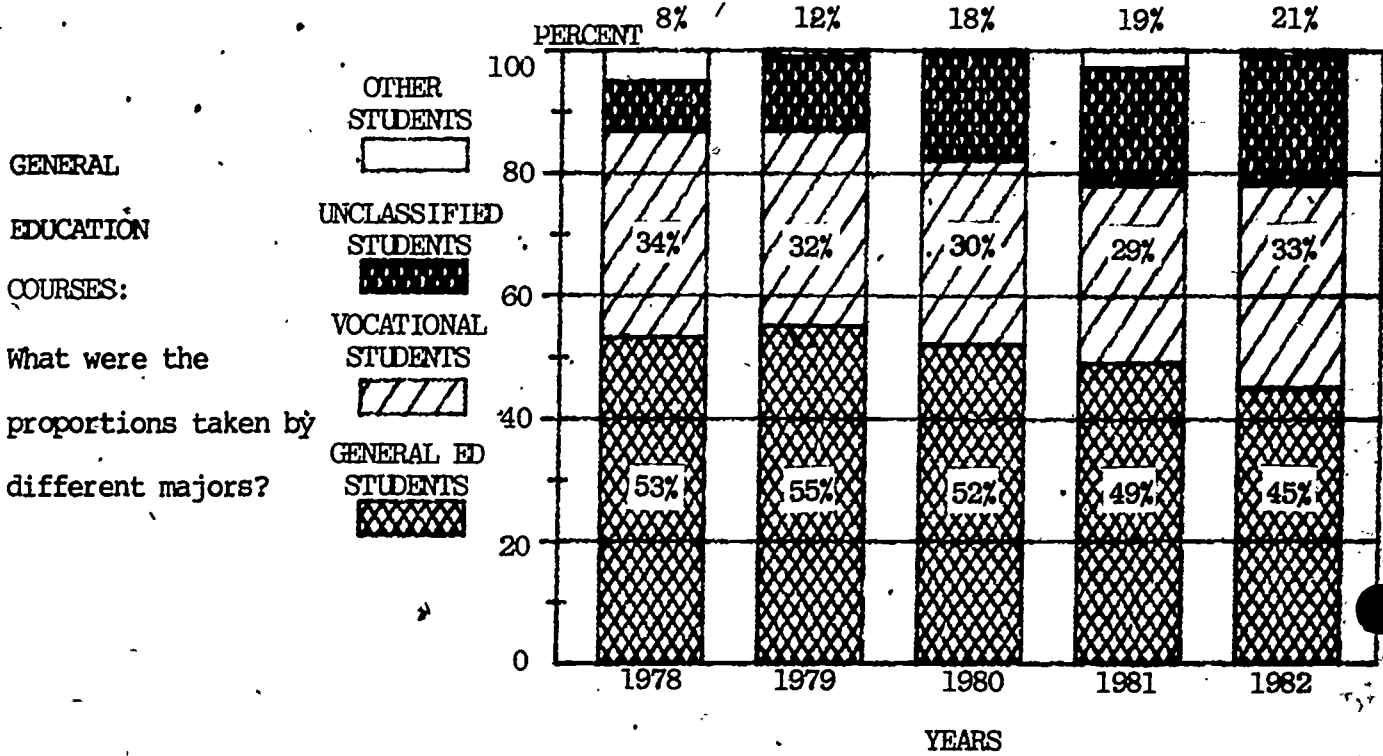

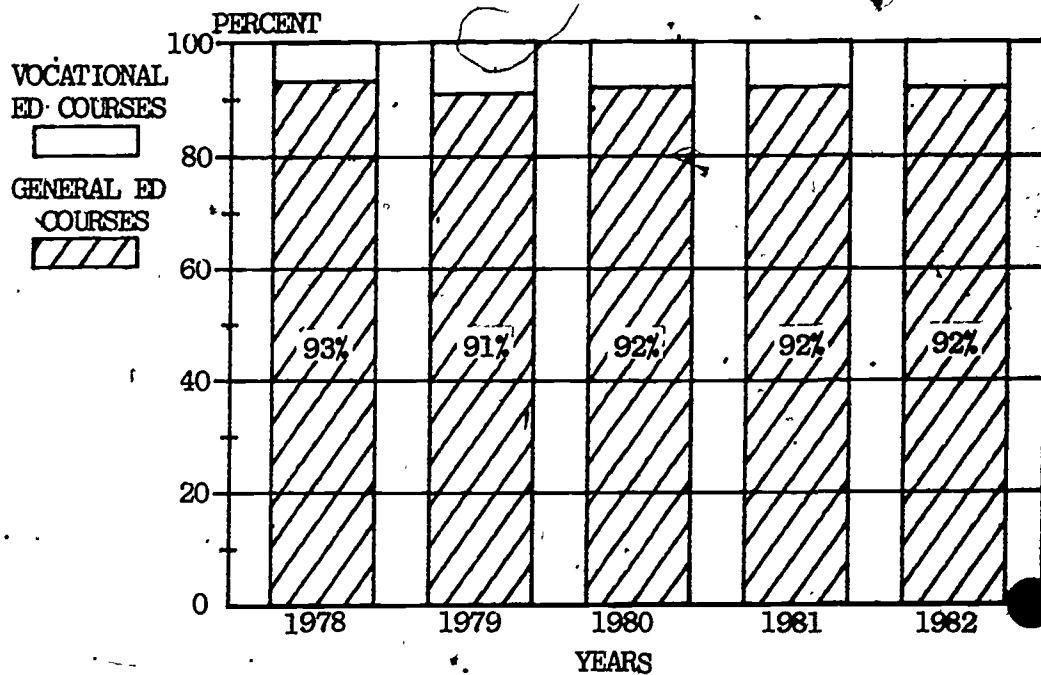

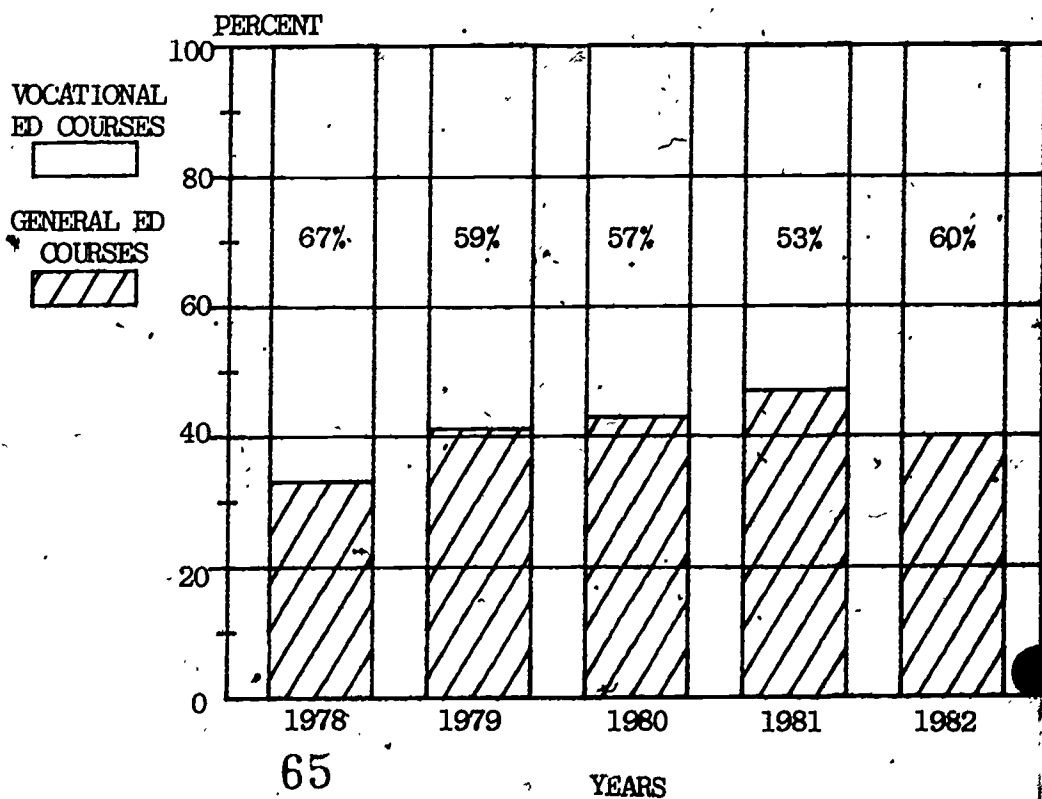

 FALL 1978 TO FALL 1982

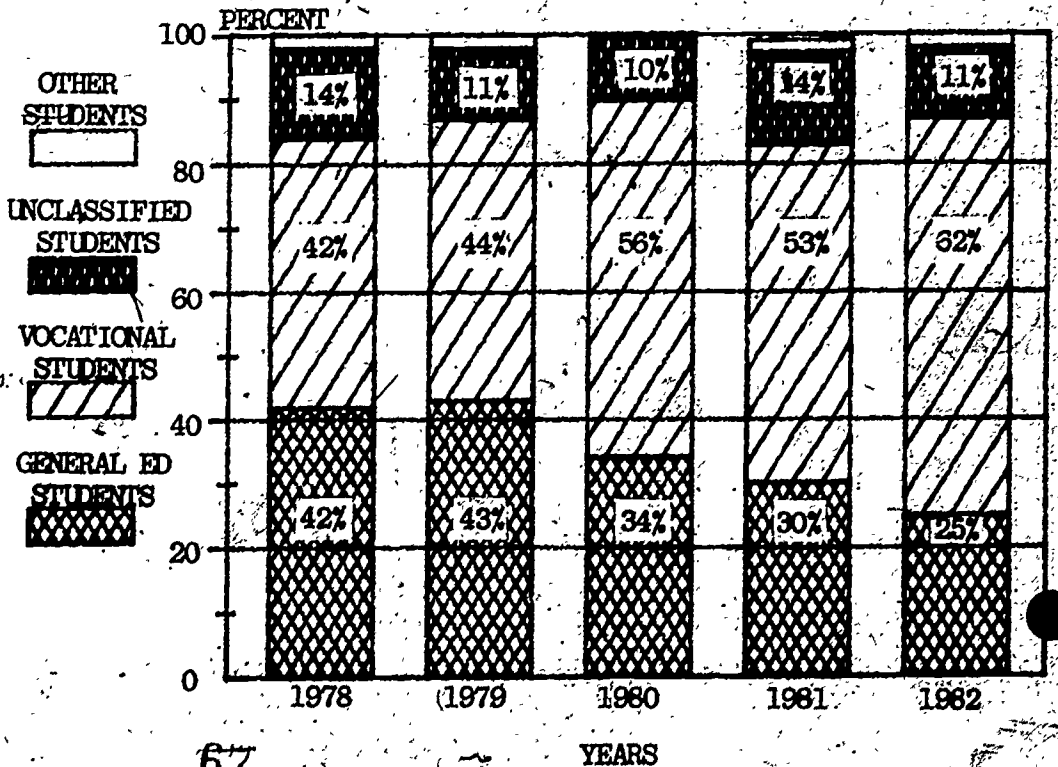
