ABSTRACT

1982-1983 summary data of basic student charges for more than 2,000 public and private four-year colleges and universities in the United States are presented. The national survey of U.S. colleges and universities obtained information on typical or modal tuition and fees charges required of full-time undergraduate and graduate students. In-state and out-of-state charges are given where they apply, as are charges for room and board. The data are presented alphabetically by state and by college within the state. (SW)

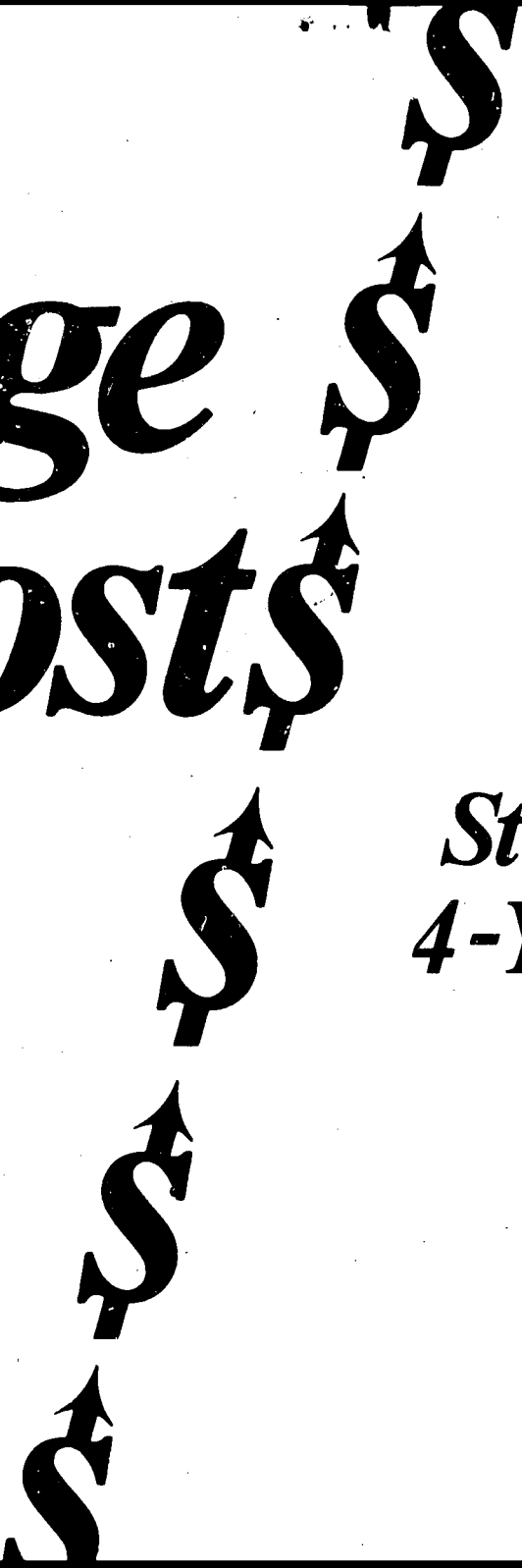

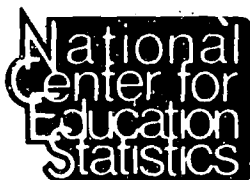

## Preface

This is the third annual booklet prepared by the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) to provide a summary of basic student charges for more than 2,000 public and private 4-year colleges and universities in the United States. These institutions comprise 60 percent of all institutions of higher education and approximately 7 of each 10 are privately controlled. Last fall, they enrolled approximately 7.7 million students. A survey of these students indicated that two-thirds of them were concerned about financing their college education.

The data presented in this booklet were obtained through a survey of all of our Nation's colleges and universities and represent the responses received by NCES before March 1983. Institutions were asked to provide typical or modal tuition and fees charges that were required of full-time students for the academic year 1982-83. In-State and out-of-State charges are given where they apply, as are charges for room and board.

This booklet is one of many helpful sources of information to be used when selecting a college. There are many other reference tools. A good starting point is your school or local public library. Consulting with a guidance or career counselor can also be of assistance in your selection as well as the advice of someone who has attended an institution in which you are interested.

Various sources can provide such basic data as addresses, telephone numbers, admission requirements, types of regular and special programs offered, calendar system, and size of student body, just to name a few. Once a selection has been narrowed somewhat, you should contact the college directly to obtain a copy of their current catalog and an application. You may also wish to visit the colleges or universities in which you have a serious interest. Much can be learned by visiting a campus that you cannot find out in any other way.
