ABSTRACT

Figures generated by the Common Core of Data survey indicate public school enrollment in the United States decreased by about 818,000 in fall 1981, a 2 percent decline from fall 1980 and part of a continuous decline since 1972. The five states reporting the largest decreases in enrollment (New York, California, Michigan, Illinois, and Ohio) accounted for approximately 45 percent of the total national decline. Nine states reported enrollment increases ranging from 0.6 percent (Idaho) to 5 percent (Alaska). A total of more than 40 million students were enrolled nationwide as of October 1, 1981, with over 27 million in prekindergarten to 8th grade and nearly 13 million in grades 9 to 12. The national decline was greater in secondary schools (3.3 percent) than in elementary schools (1.4 percent). Over half of this brief release is composed of tables, including student membership by level of instruction and by state or area for 1980 and 1981 and student membership by grade and by state or area in fall 1981. Public School Enrollment, United States, Fall 1981

Fall 1981 Enrollment Declines by 2 Percent

Public school enrollment decreased about 818,000 in fall 1981, representing a 2 percent decline since fall 1980. Forty-one States and the District of Columbia reported decreases in the number of pupils enrolled in fall 1981. The largest percent decreases in enrollment were reported by the District of Columbia (5.1 percent) and Connecticut (4.9 percent). Among the other 40 States, the percent decreases ranged from 0.3 percent in Colorado to 4.4 percent in Delaware (table 1).

For the 9 States reporting increases in enrollment for fall 1981, the percent increases ranged from 0.6 percent in Idaho and Louisiana to 5.0 percent in Alaska (table 1).

Overall, a little over 40 million students were enrolled in public elementary and secondary school systems throughout the United States in fall 1981.1/ More than 27 million were enrolled in grades prekindergarten through 8, and close to 13 million in grades 9-12 (table 1).

Five States Comprise Nearly 45 Percent of Enrollment Decline

Five States (New York, California, Michigan, Illinois, and Ohio) reported the largest decreases in number of students enrolled from fall 1980 to fall 1981. The total enrollment decline for these States represented approximately 45 percent of the total enrollment decline for the Nation.

1/ The public school enrollment data cited in this report for 1981 represent the total number of students enrolled as of October 1, 1981, and do not reflect cumulative changes occurring during the entire school year.

A Greater Enrollment Decline Shown at the 9-12 Grade Level

Student enrollment declined in both PK-8 and 9-12 grade levels from fall 1980 to fall 1981. However, the decline was greater at the 9-12 grade level both in terms of number and percent.

In all but five States reporting a decline in enrollment, the decreases occurred in both PK-8 and 9-12 grade levels. For 4 States (California, Colorado, Montana, and New Mexico), the decrease of students occurred in the 9-12th grade level only. In Massachusetts the decrease in student enrollment occurred in the PK-8th grade level only.

Enrollment Continues to Decline Since Fall 1972

Public school enrollment has continuously declined since fall 1972. Larger decreases in enrollment began in fall 1976 when the decline reached better than 470,000. The following table shows for the fall of each year, 1976 to 1981, the enrollment and percent decreases.

¹Georgia did not report enrollment data for fall 1978, and the data were estimated by NCES. Enrollment for Georgia usually represents about 2.6 percent of the national total.

Methodology

This report contains data on public school enrollment derived from the Common Core of Data (CCD) survey, part IV (Fall Report on Students), for school year 1981-82. This is the U.S. Department of Education's 28th annual survey to provide these data. The survey was conducted with the assistance of State education agencies in the 50 States, the District of Columbia and outlying areas under U.S. jurisdiction.

With the exception of Alabama, all States reported grade-by-grade enrollment. NCES estimated grade-by-grade enrollments for Alabama which reported four enrollment statistics: kindergarten, grades 1-6, 7-9, and 10-12 (and the totals). To estimate the grade-by-grade enrollment, NCES used a factor derived from Alabama's 1980 data by finding the percent each single grade was of the total enrollment in a grade span, i.e., 1-6, 7-9, or 10-12, and applying the factor to the 1981 data.

Enrollment data for prior years were reported in the Center's annual publication entitled "Statistics of Public Elementary and Secondary School Systems; Schools, Students and Staff," which has been discontinued. Beginning with the 1981-82 school year, the data will be published in several separate short releases of which this report on enrollment is the first.
