ABSTRACT

Data for 1981-82 and 1982-83 are presented and analyzed to show trends in degree/certificate completions, student demographics, and miscellaneous student factors at Miami-Dade Community College (MDCC). A series of 30 tables covers: (1) completions of degrees and certificates by term by campus; (2) a comparison of unduplicated graduate headcount to total completions awarded; (3) completions by certification type by term of completion for each campus and the college as a whole; (4) college and campus data on completions by first year of enrollment at MDCC; (5) college and campus data showing completions by gender and by ethnic category for each certification type; (6) completions by age at graduation; and (7) means of hours earned and attempted, grade point averages and duration of enrollment. Analyses of the data indicate that there were 5,645 completions in 1982-83, representing a decline of 1,865 in the absolute numbers of completions from 1981-82. Associate in arts degrees represented 72.8% of the degrees awarded in 1982-83, and 77.0% of those awarded in 1981-82. Collegewide proportional data remained relatively stable for 1981-82 and 1982-83 in the areas of multiple degree completions, citizenship status, residency, completions by year of first enrollment, mean age, and mean hours earned to mean hours attempted. synonymously with degrees and certificates. When an exception occurs in definition, the differentiation will be noted. Completion trends are dealt with in Tables 1 through 7. Table, 1 shows completions by term by campus. There were 5,645 completions for 1982-83. Total completions for 1982-83 declined by an absolute number of 1,865 (24.8%) over the previous year (7,510). The 1981-82 graduation rate was abnormally high due, in large part, to the identification through AGIS of past-years-students qualifying for graduation awards. The greatest number of completions continue to occur in the Winter Term and, secondarily, in the Fall Term.

completions awarded. Here and here alone in Table 2 are the actual number of graduates shown. Graduate figures are unduplicated headcounts (5,317 in 1982-83) and completions represent some multiple degrees (5,645 in the same year). The difference (328) is equal to the number of awards beyond the number of persons who graduated. There was no change in percent of multiple completions college-wide in 1982-83. Medical Center showed 6% fewer multiple completions this year than lasty. Other campuses remained fairly constant in this regard.

Tables 3 through 7 show completions by certification type by the term in which the award was actually completed. . College-wide (Table 3), Associate in the fications exceeded all other award types combined for each term by large percentages. This trend has been in evidence continually in past years. A.A. degrees represent 72.8% of all awards issued in 1982-83. This compares to 77.0% in 1981-82. Proportionately, Associate in Science awards have increased to 20.9% compared to 17.1% last year. The other occupational award, Planned Certificates, also increased, albeit slightly. North, South, and New World Center (Tables 4, 5, 6) are mirror images of College-wide data with regard to large proportions of A.A. to A.S. and to the increases of A.S. awards Medical Center (Table 7) has historically and by nature been oriented toward A.S. awards. In 1982-83, A.S. certifications markedly increased over 1981-82 to 67.4% of that campus.

Demographic Trends

Tables 8 through 25 present demographic trends such as citizenship, residency, year of first enrollment, gender, ethnicity, and age at date of graduation.

The proportion of completions who were U. S. citizens decreased slightly from 65.5% in 1981-82 to 64.9% in 1982-83. This downward trend has been on-going at least since 1978. Immigrant aliens continue to increase proportionately across the past several years. This group includes 24% of the 1982-83 completions. Non-immigrant aliens (identified by student visas), show constancy across the comparison years. As a whole, citizenship status proportions have remained relatively constant in 1982-83.

Table 9 consists of completions by residency. Proportionately, by college-wide and campus percentages, all residency categories remain stable across years. The differences in absolute numbers reflect the abnormally high numbers of completions in 1981-82 assumed, as previously stated, to be due largely to AGIS identification of eligibility.

Table 10 presents data on year of first enrollment at Miami-Dade. It is interesting to note that 2 persons who first attended Miami-Dade Community College when the institution was conceived graduated in 1982-83, after twenty-three years of persistence. The modal number of years to graduate is three (31%). Approximately as many students required two as did four years to complete their education at M-DCG. Roughly 70% of the graduates in 1982-83 completed their requirements within four years.



Except for Medical Center, the other three campuses (Tables 11, 12, 13) are similar with regard to the mode as collegewide data. Seventy-four percent of South Campus graduates completed their studies within four years. Forty-three percent of M-DCC 1982-83 graduates were also from this campus. Medical Center displays a fairly even percentage of graduates across the modal years addressed. Its distribution is more rectangular in shape.

Tables 15 through 19 present completions by gender and certificate type. Broadly, for college-wide data (Table 15), a 2:3 ratio of males to females is seen across years and across A.A. certifications. For the A.S. award, the ratio of males to females is roughly 1:2. Slightly more than half of the graduates on North Campus (Table 16) were female. Medical Center Campus data tends to be divergent from college-wide data. Eighty-eight percent of Medical Center graduates were females.

Tables 20 through 25 give completions by ethnic categories and certification types. Table 20 (college-wide) follows a pattern established over several previous years of decreasing white non-Hispanic completions (1,975 or 35%) and increasing Hispanic completions (2,722 or 48.6%). While the vast majority of all ethnic groups elected an A.A. degree, there has been a shift to the A.S. degree, most notably among black non-Hispanics (a ten percentage point increase). White non-Hispanic A.A. degrees decreased by 6%. higher percentage of Hispanics received A.A. awards than did either black non-Hispanics or white non-Hispanics.

Table 25 features completions by age at date of graduation.

Mean age, college-wide, is 25.25. These ages in campus comparisons are fairly constant over the past two years. The modal age, though 20, is not truly a discriminating mode for it encompasses only 20% of the graduates and is in close proximity to "secondary modes."

"Secondary modes" are found at ages 21, 23-25, and over 30. These percentages vary only one or two points from the age 20 mode. South Campus again has the youngest group of graduates (mean age = 23.80) and Medical Center has the oldest group of graduates (Mean age = 28.97). The mean age college-wide decreased in 1982-83, while that of Medical Center increased.

Miscellaneous Student Factor Trends

Miscellaneous student factors (Tables 26 through 30) entail four sets of means: hours earned; hours attempted; Grade Point Average; and non-CLEP academic terms. Hours earned include not only course semester hours completed successfully but credit by exam (Advanced Placement Program, College Level Examination Program, departmental exam, and germane credit). Hence, the hours earned exceed the hours attempted. Hours attempted constitute courses registered for, courses dropped, courses dropped as a result of college withdrawal, and courses completed unsuccessfully.

College-wide data across five years (Table 26) reveal that mean hours earned consistently exceed mean hours attempted.

Mean hours earned has been increasing steadily across time. For the past three years, mean GPA has been declining. For 1982-83, it was 2.90. The mean of academic terms required for non-CLEP graduates to complete their requirements has increased across five years from 10.20 to 11.26. This increase in time needed may be dependent on economic conditions or increased graduation requirements.

South Campus (Table 28) hours earned, when compared to hours attempted, mirror college-wide data. Medical Center Campus (Table 30) shows that mean hours earned far exceed mean hours attempted across the past five years. The large differential may be due to CLEP semester hours generated as well as credits given for previous field work associated with the training program (germane credits). The mean of semester credits hours earned for graduation is lowest on South Campus (69.61) and highest on Medical Center Campus (98.80). The 29:19 mean semester hour difference between

these two campuses may be attributed to two factors existing at Medical Center: 1) credits carried while awaiting admittance to a limited access program and 2) the higher credit hour requisites for both A.S. and P.C. awards on this campus. Awards for A.S. range from 62 through 92 credits. Seven of the eleven A.S. programs require upward of eighty credits.



Summary

There were 5,645 completions in 1982-83. This represents a decline in absolute numbers of 1,865 completions (24.8%) from 1981-82. The decrease appears to be due to the exceptionally high number of graduates in 1981-82 due to flagging by AGIS of graduation eligibility.

With a few exceptions, the college-wide proportional data for 1982-83 have been relatively stable across the two comparison years in the following categories:

- 1. Multiple completions
- 2. Citizenship status
- 3. Residency
- 4. Completions by year of first enrollment
- 5. Mean age
- 6. Mean hours earned to mean hours attempted

Associate in Arts degrees continue to be awarded most frequently (72.8%). The proportion of Associate in Science awards has increased for the 1982-83 year. For the most part, North Campus, South Campus, and New World Center Campus data follow college-vide patterns. Medical Center has its own unique configurations, which are: 1) 77% of its graduates receive occupational awards, 2) 85% of graduates are females, and 3) mean hours earned to graduate is 98.80 (as compared to 69.61 for South Campus).

The ratio of males to females for A.A. certification is 2.3 and 1:2 for A.S. certification. More than 25% of completions in 1982-83 were in occupational programs. Ethnic trends established over several years continue true to pattern with a decline in white non-Hispanics and an increase of Hispanics.

College-wide (for miscellaneous factors), mean hours earned continues to increase over a five-year span (to 75.38). Mean GPA has been declining for three years (to 2.90). The mean number of academic terms it takes students to graduate from M-DCC has been increasing (to 11.26).
