ABSTRACT

Based on information contained in producers' catalogs and on responses to a survey conducted by the Reference Section of the Library of Congress National Library Service (NLS) for the Blind and Physically Handicapped, this publication lists reference materials produced in braille or in large type, and sound recordings of reference works available on cassette or disc. Subjects and types of publications covered include: business management; dictionaries and thesauri; encyclopedias; the grammar, style, and use of the English language; English-language literature; foreign language works; geography and maps; history; law and politics; mathematics; medicine; music and fine arts; personal and self-help; psychology and psychiatry; radio and television; religion and philosophy; pure and applied science; social sciences; and study guides to standard tests. For each entry, bibliographic information is given for the print edition, followed by pertinent information about the special format edition. It is noted that books for which "NLS" is listed as the source may be borrowed on free loan by qualified residents of the United States and American citizens living abroad. Also provided are a list of addresses of all the sources cited with information on general purchase, loan, or exchange arrangements used by these sources, and a title index to the reference works included.

INTRODUCTION

The definition of a "reference book" used in compiling this reference circular is "a book designed by its arrangement and treatment to be consulted for definite items of information rather than to be read consecutively."* The information contained in this circular is based on producers' catalogs and responses to a survey conducted for this purpose by the Reference Section. Titles whose current availability could not be confirmed are not included. In instances where more than one edition of a work exists in a special medium, only the most recent edition is listed. Titles thought to contain outdated information are excluded.

In Section I, reference books are grouped under broad subject categories and then by medium (braille, cassette, disc, large type). For each entry, bibliographic information is given for the print edition, followed by pertinent information about the special format edition. The number of volumes or cassettes and the number of pages in the special format edition are indicated, if this information was provided by the producer. All cassette books listed are available on 15/16 ips, 4-track, unless otherwise indicated.

Books for which "NLS" is listed as the source may be borrowed on free loan from a network of cooperating libraries for the blind and physically handicapped. This library service is available to residents of the United States and American citizens living abroad who are unable to read standard printed material because of visual or physical impairment. Full details about this program and addresses of cooperating libraries may be obtained by contacting the Reference Section, National Library Service for the Blind and Physically Handicapped, Library of Congress, Washington, D.C. 20542.

Complete addresses of all sources cited in this circular are shown in Section II. General purchase, loan, or exchange arrangements are also described in this section. If purchase, loan, or exchange arrangements are not indicated for a particular source, titles from that source are available only for purchase at the prices listed in Section I. Prices are subject to frequent change and should be verified with the source prior to ordering.

Reference books may be located by title in this circular by consulting the index in Section III.
