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ABSTRACT

This advance report presents results of the current population survey (March 1984) on households, families, marital status, and living arrangements. Tables give information on (1) one-year changes in households and families, by type (1980-1984); (2) households by type (1970, 1980, 1984); (3) average population per household and family (1940-1984); (4) characteristics of unmarried-couple households (1970, 1980, 1984); (5) persons age 15 years and over and percent never married, by age and sex (1970, 1980, 1984); and (6) household and family units, by type (1940-1984).

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Population Characteristics

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(Advance Report)

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HOUSEHOLDS AND FAMILIES

According to results of the Current Population Survey, there were 85.4 million households in the United States as of March 1984, an increase of about 1.5 million over the total for 1983. The average net annual increase in the number of households over the period since 1980 has been 1.2 million. This compares with an average annual increase of 1.6 million households between 1970 and 1980.

Prior to the 1.5-million increase in the number of households in the 1983-84 period, there were reported increases of 1.6 million in 1980-81, 1.2 million in 1981-82,¹ and 391,000 in 1982-83 (table 1). The reported increase of 391,000 households in the 1982-83 period was not statistically significant and marked the first time since the early 1960's that there was not a statistically significant annual increase in the number of households.² The sizable increase in the number of households in the 1983-84 period provides support for the caution in the 1983 report against drawing conclusions about new trends on the basis of 1-year changes.

Approximately 62.0 million households in 1984 were maintained by family householders. Families accounted for 73 percent of all households in 1984, a proportion only slightly lower than their 74 percent share in 1980 (table 2). In 1970, by contrast, families represented 81 percent of all households. A family household, as defined by the Census Bureau, consists of two or more related persons, one of whom (i.e., the householder) owns or rents the living quarters. The three basic types of family households are married-couple households, of which there were 50.1 million in 1984; other families with female householder (no husband present), 9.9 million; and other families with male householder (no wife present), 2.0 million.

One of the trends characterizing the change in household composition, not only since 1980, but also during the 1970's,

has been the substantial increase in the number of families maintained by women with no husband present.³ There was no significant change in the number of these households during the 1982-83 period, but during the past year the number of families maintained by women alone once again increased markedly. About 25 percent of all households added since 1980 were families maintained by women, a higher proportion than the 18 percent of households added from 1970 to 1980.

About 23.4 million households, or 27 percent of all households in 1984 were maintained by nonfamily householders. Nonfamily households are made up of householders who either live alone or with others to whom they are not related. The dramatic increase in the number of nonfamily households was another of the major trends characterizing household change during the 1970's, that has reasserted itself during the past year. Roughly 47 percent of all households added since 1980 have been nonfamily households, down slightly from the 53 percent level recorded for the 1970-80 period.

Most nonfamily households are one-person households. There were about 20 million householders in 1984 who lived alone, 85 percent of all nonfamily householders. Persons living alone accounted for 36 percent of the increase in the number of households since 1980, compared with 43 percent of the increase between 1970 and 1980.

The average number of persons per household stood at a new low of 2.71 persons in 1984 (table 3). The decline in household size which began in the mid-1960's was interrupted in 1983 but has resumed during the past year. The disproportionate increase in one-person households (up 84 percent since 1970, compared with just 35 percent for households overall) has been a major factor in the decline in household size over the years.

Families, which by Census definition must include a minimum of at least two persons, declined from 3.58 persons per family in 1970 to 3.24 persons in 1984. Average family size, as recorded by the Current Population Survey,

has never been lower. Almost all of the decline in average family size is attributable to the drop in the average number of persons under 18 (0.99 persons in 1984, compared with 1.34 persons in 1970).

UNMARRIED COUPLES

The majority of nonfamily households that do not consist of persons living alone are unmarried-couple households. The Census Bureau defines these households as two unrelated adults of opposite sex who are sharing living quarters. There were about 2.0 million unmarried-couple households in 1984, compared with 1.6 million in 1980 (table 4). By contrast, only 523,000 such living arrangements were identified in 1970. Despite a tremendous increase over the years in their number, unmarried couples accounted for just 4 percent of the 52.9 million couples (married and unmarried) in the United States.

About 31 percent of the unmarried-couple households in 1984 included not only the two partners but also one or more children under 15 years old. This proportion has declined from 38 percent in 1970.

Unmarried-couple households today are likely to be maintained by younger persons than were similar households in 1970. About 70 percent of the persons maintaining such households in 1970 were 45 years of age or older. In 1984, by contrast, only 18 percent of unmarried couples had a householder age 45 or older.

Many unmarried-couple householders have never been married; about 48 percent in 1984. An additional 36 percent of these householders were divorced. Considerably smaller proportions were either widowed, or married but not living with their spouse.

PERSONS WHO HAVE NEVER MARRIED

The percentage of young adults in their twenties and early thirties that have never married was much higher in 1984 than in 1970. For example, among men 20 to 24 years old, the percentage that had not married increased from 55 percent in 1970, to 69 percent in 1980, to 75 percent in 1984. For women in the same age group the never-married percentage increased from 36 percent, to 50 percent, to 57 percent, respectively (table 5). The never-married percentage also increased significantly both for men and women age 25 to 29 years and for those 30 to 34 years old.

Many of these young adults may have postponed their entry into marriage in order to further their formal education, establish careers, or pursue other goals that might conflict with assuming family responsibilities. Most of today's young men and women are expected to marry eventually, but they are certainly delaying their entry into marriage when compared with their counterparts in 1970. The longer an event is delayed, the greater the likelihood that it may never occur. Consequently, the percentage of today's young adults that do not ever marry may turn out to be higher than the corresponding percentage for their predecessors.

RELIABILITY OF ESTIMATES

All of the statistics presented in this report are based on a sample survey. These estimates are subject to sampling variability and other sources of error. Additional data and more information on its limitations will appear in subsequent detailed reports.

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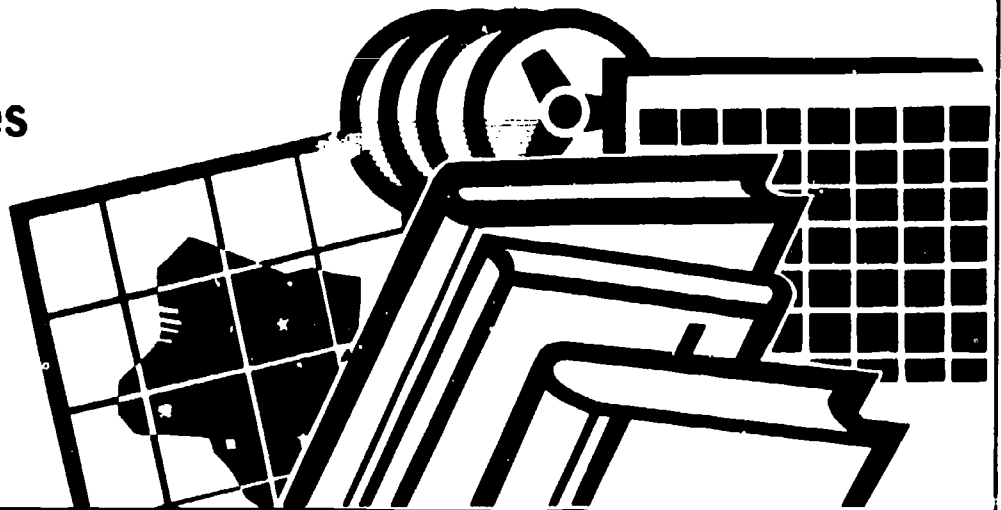
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
