ABSTRACT

Data on degrees conferred by public and private colleges in New York State for 1983-1984 are presented, with attention to the sex of recipients, level of degree, major subject area, and sector of the institutions. Information is reported on the following types of degrees: associate, bachelor's, first-professional, master's, and doctoral. Degree data are presented for each institution and for the following categories of institutions: total public, total public regents college degrees, total State University of New York (SUNY) and eight types of SUNY institutions, total City University of New York (CUNY) and five types of CUNY institutions, total independent and 10 types of independent institutions, total proprietary, total two-year, total four-year and higher, and total graduate only. The number of bachelor's and higher degrees conferred for each subject area is also specified by sector for 1983-1984 as well as for 1981-1982 to 1983-1984. In addition, trend data in degrees awarded by year since 1979 are provided.

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
