

ABSTRACT

Data on college attendance of ethnic and racial minorities at public and private institutions in New York State for 1984-1985 are presented. Enrollment data are presented for the state as a whole, public institutions, the State University of New York, the City University of New York, independent institutions, and proprietary institutions. The number and percent of full- and part-time undergraduates, graduate students, and first-professional students are reported by sex and racial/ethnic group. Six groups are represented: nonresident alien; Black, non-Hispanic; American Indian or Alaskan Native; Asian or Pacific Islander; Hispanic; and White, non-Hispanic. Undergraduate and graduate student enrollments by ethnic/racial group for the different types of institutions are also provided for the following subject areas: architecture and environmental design, biological sciences, business and management, engineering, mathematics, and physical sciences. First-professional enrollments in dentistry, law, medicine, and veterinary medicine are also reported. Trends in full- and part-time enrollments by level and racial/ethnic group are included for fall 1976 through fall 1984. (SW)




oullege and University Racial/Ethnic Distribution of Enroll-New York State Fall 1984

COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY RACIAL/ETHNIC DISTRIBUTION OF ENROLLMENT

NEW YORK STATE FALL 1984

The data summaries contained in this report were obtained from the 1984-85 HEDS/HEGIS Survey form ED2300-2.3, "Fall Enrollment and Compliance Report, Fall 1984." Enrollment figures in this report may vary slightly from official enrollment data published in "College and University Admissions and Enrollment, Fall 1984."

The data reported by some independent and proprietary institutions as "race unknown" are displayed separately, with racial distributions based only on the portion of data for which race was known. In contrast, all State University institutions, as well as most independent and proprietary institutions, distributed "unknowns" prior to submitting the data by prorating unknown data based on the known racial distribution.

Several estimating procedures were used in preparing data from The City University of New York for this publication, thus affecting both CUNY and Statewide summary tables. Racial/ethnic distributions for individual CUNY campuses were based on the CUNY Ethnic Census, a self-reporting questionnaire completed voluntarily by students. This survey produced estimated racial distributions by student level, within each institution, which were then extrapolated to the total student population. For purposes of this report, these racial estimates were applied uniformly to both full- and part-time students and across all subject areas for each campus. Institutional data were then summarized into CUNY totals and used in the preparation of the Statewide tables in this report.

DEFINITIONS

- NONRESIDENT ALIEN: A person who is not a citizen of the United States and who is in this country on a temporary basis and does not have the right to remain indefinitely.
- BLACK NON-HISPANIC: A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.
- AMERICAN INDIAN OR ALASKAN NATIVE: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America, and who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition.
- ASIAN OR PACIFIC ISLANDER: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, the Indian subcontinent, or the Pacific Islands. This area includes, for example, China, India, Japan, Korea, the Philippine Islands, and Samoa.
- HISPANIC: A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.
- WHITE NON-HISPANIC: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North Africa, or in the Middle East.
