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**ABSTRACT**

Pennsylvania Governor Dick Thornburgh initiated an education reform package, "Turning the Tide: An Agenda for Excellence in Pennsylvania Public Schools" in October 1983. The statewide competency testing program which followed was "Testing for Essential Learning and Literacy Skills (TELLS)", and it tested reading and mathematics skills among students in grades 3, 5, and 8. State-funded remedial instruction was to be provided for students whose scores indicated a deficiency at their grade level. Tests were administered for the first time in October 1984 and were mandatory for the state's 501 school districts. (Participation was voluntary for nonpublic schools, and approximately one third of the nonpublic schools elected to participate.) This report summarizes the results of that administration. Aggregate data is given first for both public and nonpublic schools. District results follow in an alphabetical listing. Nonpublic school results are listed on the last page. The list presents, by district, the following figures for each of the six TELLs tests: (1) the number of regular students tested; (2) the number of regular students eligible for remedial instruction; and (3) the percentage of regular students eligible for instruction, computed by dividing the number eligible by the number tested in each case. 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## 1984-85 TESTING FOR ESSENTIAL LEARNING AND LITERACY SKILLS

In October 1983, in his education reform package, "Turning the Tide: An Agenda for Excellence in Pennsylvania Public Schools," Governor Dick Thornburgh called for a new statewide competency testing program. Known as Testing for Essential Learning and Literacy Skills (TELLS), the program tested reading and mathematics skills among students in grades 3, 5, and 8. At the same time, the Governor called for state-funded remedial instruction for all students whose scores on the TELLIS tests indicated a skills deficiency for their grade level.

The State Board of Education approved regulations creating the new testing program in June 1984, and the tests were given for the first time in October 1984.

This report summarizes the results of that testing program statewide and by school district.

Participation in the testing program was mandatory for the state's 501 school districts. Public school districts' results are listed alphabetically by intermediate unit in this publication.

Participation in the testing program was voluntary for the state's nonpublic schools. Approximately one third of the nonpublic schools elected to participate, and nonpublic school results, aggregated by intermediate unit, are listed on the last page of this booklet.

The primary objectives of the TELLIS program are to identify students who need extra help early in their school years and to provide additional state resources to support remedial instruction programs for students whose reading and mathematics skills are deficient. A separate booklet, "Estimated Distribution of TELLIS Remediation Funds Payable 1984-85," lists the additional state funds available to each school district for remedial instruction programs.

Persons analyzing these test results should note that valid comparisons of the quality of the educational programs in different districts cannot be made on the basis of these test results alone. Many factors contribute to student overall performance and the quality of the educational programs in a school district.

**1984-85 Testing for Essential Learning and Literacy Skills  
STATEWIDE PUBLIC SCHOOL AGGREGATE DATA**

In the fall of 1984, Pennsylvania's 501 public school districts administered the state's first TELLS competency tests in reading and mathematics to each of their third, fifth and eighth grade students. Approximately 360,000 public school students took the tests; 337,000 of them regular students.\*

This chart summarizes the number of regular students whose scores were below the eligibility score on each of the six tests given. PLEASE NOTE that within each grade, there is some overlap in the number of students in the reading and mathematics columns. Students who require remedial instruction in both reading and mathematics are counted under each subject. Therefore, it is not possible to add the reading and mathematics columns together to determine the number of individual students who are eligible for remediation in each grade.

**1984-85 Testing for Essential Learning and Literacy Skills  
STATEWIDE NONPUBLIC SCHOOL AGGREGATE DATA**

In the fall of 1984, approximately one-third of Pennsylvania's nonpublic schools elected to administer the TELLS tests to their third, fifth and eighth grade students. Approximately 69,000 nonpublic school students took the tests; 67,600 of them regular students.\*

This chart summarizes the number of regular students whose scores were below the eligibility score on each of the six tests given. PLEASE NOTE that within each grade, there is some overlap in the number of students in the reading and mathematics columns. Students who require remedial instruction in both reading and mathematics are counted under each subject. Therefore, it is not possible to add the reading and mathematics columns together to determine the number of individual students who are eligible for remediation in each grade.
