ABSTRACT

New York State college and university personnel data for 1985-1986 are presented for various types of institutions. Employment trend data are included by sector for 1983-1986. Data are provided on the number of full-time and part-time employees by position, and the number of men and women employed by position and by institutional classification. The following groupings are covered: total state, total public, State University of New York, City University of New York, independent, proprietary, two-year, and four-year and higher. Data are also provided for categories within the sectors (e.g., university colleges). The trend data, which are given by position and full-time and part-time status, are provided for the entire state and for public, independent, and proprietary institutions. The following positions are covered: executive, administrative, managerial; instructional faculty; other professional; and nonprofessional. Additional tables cover: tenure status and salary for teaching faculty on 9-month and 12-month contracts; and the number and percent distribution of instructional faculty by racial/ethnic origin and sector. DEFINITIONS

OCCUPATIONAL ACTIVITIES

- 1. EXECUTIVE, ADMINISTRATIVE, MANAGERIAL Includes persons who are assigned a primary responsibility for management of the institution, a department, or a subdivision. The assignment may require the performance of work directly related to management policies or general business operations of the institution and should require discretion, independent judgement and direction of the work of others.
- 2. INSTRUCTIONAL Includes persons with assignments customarily made for the purpose of instruction; excludes persons assigned a job associated with research projects.

Faculty: Generally associated with titles of professor, associate professor, assistant professor, instructor and lecturer.

<u>Teaching Assistants and Associates</u>: Includes persons who carry out instruction with guidance from others who exercise the primary responsibility. Typically, the position is staffed by people with student status.

3. PROFESSIONAL (research, business, health, etc., other than administrative or instructional) - Includes only persons whose positions typically require a bachelor's degree or its equivalent, persons with assignments of a professional nature associated with organized research projects and persons assigned to positions requiring knowledge of an advanced type in a field of science or learning, or original and creative work in an artistic field.

4. NONPROFESSIONAL

<u>Technical</u>: Includes persons with assignments requiring specialized know-ledge or skills which may be acquired through experience or degree or certificate programs below the bachelor's degree.

Office: Includes persons with assignments typically associated with clerical activity.

<u>Crafts and Trades:</u> Includes persons assigned to activities typically requiring knowledge or skill gained in recognized crafts or trades.

<u>Service</u>: Includes persons assigned to activities requiring a limited degree of previously acquired skills and knowledge.
