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**ABSTRACT**

Data on 1976-1984 college and university enrollment trends are presented, based on the Higher Education General Information Survey. Information is provided on higher education enrollments by control and level of institution, student sex, and full-time and part-time attendance status. Trends in enrollment are for the 50 states and the District of Columbia, along with data for undergraduate, graduate, unclassified, and first-professional students at public and private institutions. Total enrollment rose annually from 11 million in 1976 to 12.5 million in 1983, a total increase of 13%. Enrollment in 1984 was the lowest since fall 1980. The traditional college-going population age group began to decrease in 1982. About 96% of the increase in total enrollment from 1976 to 1984 occurred among women. The changes in enrollment occurred more among part-time students (20%) than among those attending full-time (6%). One factor in the increase of part-time enrollment was the increased enrollment of students 25 years old and older. Female part-time students increased 45% over the 8-year period. Public institutions accounted for 94% of total two-year college enrollments in 1984. (SW)

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## Trends in Fall Enrollment in Colleges and Universities, 1976 - 1984

### Introduction

Data in this report are derived from the 1976 through 1984 surveys of Fall Enrollment in Institutions of Higher Education<sup>1</sup> conducted by the U.S. Department of Education's Center for Education Statistics. These surveys were part of the annual Higher Education General Information Survey (HEGIS) conducted each year.

These data are summarized and presented in this report to show enrollment trends. All data in this report through 1982 were either published previously or derived from data files that were released previously. Enrollment data for 1983 and 1984 by level of institution (2-year vs. 4-year — which includes universities and other 4-year institutions) are new.

The selection of 1976 as the initial year of this report was made because the data by level of student (i.e., undergraduate, first-professional, graduate, and unclassified) were reported somewhat differently prior to that year.

The discussions that follow are in the order of the tables at the end of this report. These tables give detailed data as well as selected percentage changes for each year 1976 through 1984.

### Overall View

Total enrollment rose annually from 11 million in 1976 to 12.5 million in 1983, a total increase of 13 percent, and then dropped back to 12.2 million in 1984 (see table A). The 1984 enrollment was the lowest since fall 1980.

As shown in table A, the traditional college-going population age group began to decrease in 1982. While the percent of students 25 years of age and older has increased, more than half of all students (57 percent in 1983 as compared with 69 percent in 1976) were still in the 18-24 age range.<sup>2</sup>

### Enrollment Trends by Sex

About 96 percent of the increase in total enrollment from 1976 to 1984 occurred among women. This reversed the predominance of the sexes among college students during this period (see chart A). Whereas in the fall of 1976, women represented 47 percent of total enrollment, they represented 52 percent in 1984.

Most of the growth in enrollment among women (a 23 percent increase) occurred from 1976 to 1981. Since then, the enrollment of women has remained fairly steady. There was more fluctuation in male enrollment during the 1976-84 time period. As shown in chart A, male enrollment declined from 1976 to 1977 and fell to a low of 5.6 million in 1978. At that point, male enrollment began increasing to a high of 6 million in 1982 and has since declined to 5.9 million in 1984.

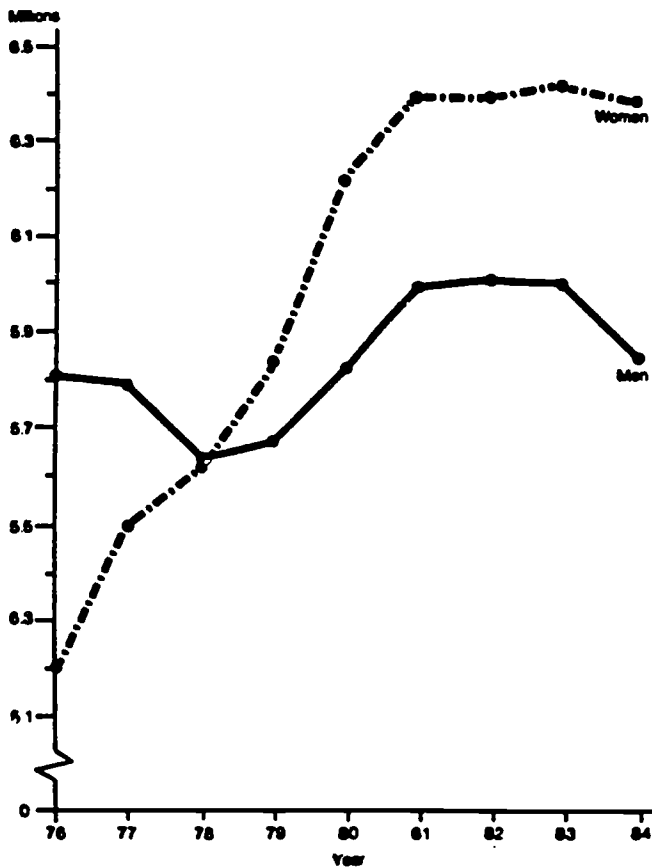
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**Chart A.—Trend in enrollment by sex 1976-84**



**Attendance Status**

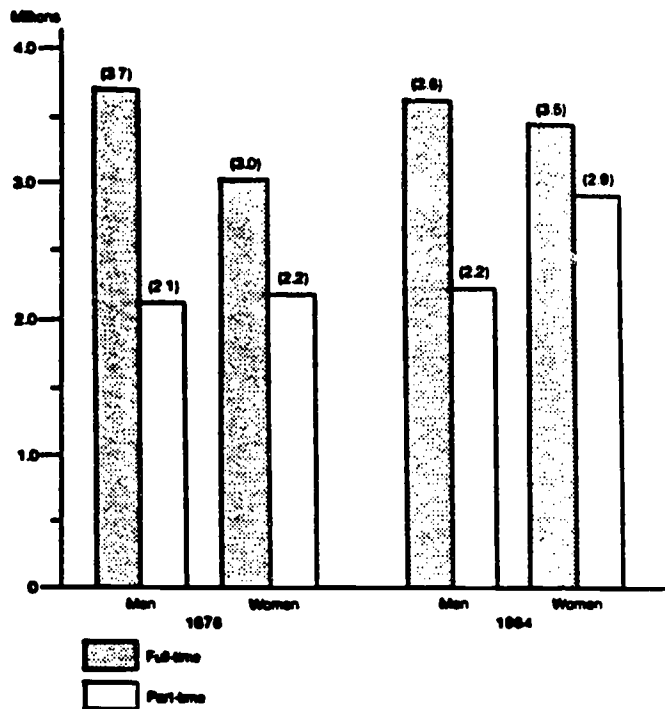
The changes in enrollment between 1976 and 1984 occurred more among part-time students (20 percent) than among those attending full time (6 percent) (see table 1 and chart B). This was especially so for female part-time students, whose enrollment increased by 34 percent over the period. Increases in the enrollment of women attending part time accounted for 60 percent of the total 1.2 million enrollment increase from 1976 to 1984.

One factor in the increase of part-time enrollment was the increased enrollment of students 25 years old and older during this period. The enrollment of these older students increased from 4 million in 1976 to 5.1 million in 1983. In 1983, an estimated 3.8 million, or 74 percent of these students were enrolled part time.<sup>4</sup>

Among both full-time and part-time students, women had larger changes in attendance status than men between 1976 and 1984. Male full-time students were still the largest group among the four attendance status-groups in 1984 despite an actual decrease since 1976 of 2 percent. Male part-time students, the smallest of the four enrollment groups in 1976, remained the smallest in 1984 with an increase of 5 percent. As already noted, female part-time students had the largest increase, 34 percent, whereas female full-time students increased by 15 percent (see chart B).

**Control of Institution**

More than three-fourths of all college and university students attended public institutions throughout the 1976-84 time period. However, private enrollment, which increased from 21 percent of total enrollment in 1976 to 23 percent in 1984, accounted for over one-third of the growth. One reason was the entrance into the private collegiate universe in 1980 of schools accredited by the National Association of Trade and Technical Schools (NATTS). As of fall 1984, there were 109 such private schools in the collegiate universe enrolling 76,000 students.<sup>5</sup>

Changes differed between public and private institutions in the 1976-84 time period. Public enrollment in fall 1984 was 9 percent larger than in 1976, while private enrollment was 18 percent larger at the same time (see table 1). Public institutions showed a slight setback in 1978, declined in 1983, and continued to decline in 1984, while private institutions continued to grow until 1983, showing no growth in 1984.

**Type of Institution**

Education enrollment changes in the 1976-84 time period differed significantly between 4-year and 2-year institutions. At 4-year institutions, the growth in enrollment in the 1976-84 time period was fairly gradual (see table 2). The overall growth was 8 percent. Among the various cate-

gories of enrollment, 4-year institutions mirrored the trends of total enrollments — namely:

- a) Private institutions grew at twice the rate of public institutions;
- b) Almost all growth was among female students; and
- c) Part-time enrollment increased faster than full-time enrollment.

At 2-year institutions enrollment grew by 23 percent between 1976 and 1982, when it reached a peak, and has dropped by 5 percent between 1982 and 1984. This peak occurred among men and women, among full-time and part-time students, and at the public institutions which accounted for 94 percent of total 2-year college enrollment in 1984 (see table 3). Enrollment in 2-year private institutions doubled between 1976 and 1984. However, this represents an increase of less than 140,000 students.

### Level of Student

Because undergraduates account for more than three-fourths of total enrollment throughout the 1976–84 time period, it is expected that trends described above for total enrollment apply to undergraduate enrollment. Namely, the increase in female undergraduate students attending college on a part-time basis, was the major factor in the total increase among undergraduate students (table 4). Female part-time students increased 45 percent over the 8-year period compared to 13 percent for total undergraduate enrollment.

Among first-professional male and female students,<sup>4</sup> different trends emerged in the 1976–84 time period. Males showed increases in enrollment each year between 1976 and 1980 and decreases each year between 1980 and 1984, to the point where the 1984 enrollment was the lowest of any year in the 1976–84 time period (table 5). Female students, on the other hand, showed steady and continuous increase in first-professional enrollment between 1976 and 1984 increasing by 72 percent.

Graduate enrollment showed the smallest increase among all types of students during the 1976–84 period — 3 percent (table 6). This increase, however, was not consistent when considering institutional control, sex, or attendance status of the students. Private institutions showed a 19 percent increase while public institutions had a 5 percent decline; female students showed an 11 percent increase while male students had a 4 percent decline; and full-time enrollment increased 8 percent, while part-time enrollment decreased by 1 percent.

Unclassified students (i.e., those that cannot be classified as undergraduate, first-professional, or graduate) remained the second largest of the four student levels throughout the 1976–84 period (table 7). These students are predominantly part-time students at public institutions.

### Survey Background

This publication contains selected results of the 1976–84 annual surveys, "Fall Enrollment in Institutions of Higher Education," conducted by the U.S. Department of Education, Center for Education Statistics, as part of the annual Higher Education General Information Survey (HEGIS). Each year, survey forms were sent to all institutions of higher education recognized by the Department of Education as accredited and listed in the "Education Directory, Colleges and Universities."

Table B shows the total number of institutions of higher education, the number of responding institutions and the number and percent that did not respond for 1976 through 1984. Data used in this report include imputations for nonresponding institutions in each year based on the previous year's response or on data from peer institutions. For more details on the individual year, see the Fall Enrollment in Colleges and Universities report for that year.

Data have been compiled annually as part of the HEGIS program since 1966, and the origins of the fall enrollment survey extend back to the early 1900's. The survey instrument has not changed appreciably since 1976, thus preserving the reporting consistency needed for statistical analyses.
