**ABSTRACT**

From November 1986 through February 1987, the Community College of Rhode Island's (CCRI's) Job Placement Office conducted a survey of the college's 1986 graduates to gather information on the employment status and approximate salary range of graduates who joined the work force and a list of colleges currently attended full-time by graduates who were furthering their education. Questionnaire responses were obtained from 1,203 of the 1,418 graduates surveyed. Study findings included the following: (1) 53% of the graduates were employed full-time, 11% were employed full-time while pursuing education part-time, 10% were employed part-time, 2% were unavailable for work, 2% were unemployed, 12% were pursuing education full-time, and 10% were full-time students working part-time; (2) the programs with the largest number of graduates were business administration (N=365), associate degree nursing (N=211), liberal arts (N=183), and human services (N=100); (3) of 23 programs covered, the highest salaries were commanded by Instrumentation Technology graduates and the lowest by Dental Assistant graduates; and (4) a comparison of 1985 and 1986 statistics shows increases in the number of graduates employed part-time, of graduates employed part-time while attending school full-time, and of graduates working in "career" rather than "temporary" positions. REPORT ON JOB PLACEMENT  
AND EXTERNAL TRANSFER  
OF 1986 GRADUATES

The Report on Job Placement and External Transfer of 1986 Graduates covers two major areas: the employment status and approximate salary ranges of graduates who joined the work force and a list of colleges and universities currently attended full time by graduates who elected to continue their education.

This report helps to identify the goals and career directions of 1986 graduates of the College and provides important information that can be used in the recruitment and advising of students. It is hoped that it will be useful to both prospective and current students, to guidance counselors in the state and to businesses and industries that are potential employers of our graduates.

In order to obtain the information contained in this report, a survey was conducted by the Job Placement Office on a continuous basis from November, 1986 through February, 1987. First, a questionnaire was mailed to the graduates and the return was approximately 57%. As a follow-up, a telephone survey was conducted which produced a return of an additional 28%. A sample of the questionnaire used can be found on p.59.

The survey results show that 84% of the graduates are employed, 33% of the graduates are continuing their education and 2% of the graduates are unemployed. Some graduates are both employed and continuing their education. A further breakdown of these statistics can be found within the report.
