**ABSTRACT**

This library guide lists some of the more useful sources of information about colleges and universities that are available in the Fogler Library at the University of Maine. The 99 items cited are listed in four categories: (1) colleges and universities, including general, graduate, and foreign programs; (2) preparation for admission exams; (3) transfer information; and (4) financial aid. Additional sources of information available through the library are also indicated, including a microfiche collection of information on U.S. and foreign colleges, a small hard copy collection of catalogs from northeast and eastern Canadian colleges, and a computer service providing details about career opportunities, two- and four-year colleges and graduate schools, and financial aid opportunities.
