ABSTRACT

This report provides a statistical summary for data included in the October 1987 Comprehensive Assessment Reports and of the results of the spring 1987 administration of the Pupil Evaluation Program (PEP) tests for New York State. The data for the 1986-87 school year in this report will enable school administrators to compare test results for their schools and/or school districts with those of various reference groups in New York State. For each test and reference group, the tabulated statistics provide a summary of the total number of non-handicapped students who took the test and the percentage of those students who achieved above the state reference point for the test. Students who score above the state reference point for a PEP test are making normal progress in developing the basic skills that are measured by that test. Skills assessed by the tests are associated with reading, mathematics, writing, social studies, business law, business mathematics, various foreign languages and scientific disciplines, and English. Minimum competency data are also summarized. Reference groups for which data are provided include total state reference groups, public schools by type of community or school district, public schools by county, and non-public school reference groups. Statistical data are provided in extensive tables for students in grades 3-10. (TJH)

THIS REPORT PROVIDES A SUMMARY OF THE RESULTS OF THE SPRING 1987 ADMINISTRATION OF THE GRADE 6 PROGRAM EVALUATION TEST IN SOCIAL STUDIES. THE DATA IN THIS REPORT ENABLE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS TO COMPARE THE TEST RESULTS FOR THEIR SCHOOLS AND/OR DISTRICTS WITH THOSE OF VARIOUS REFERENCE GROUPS IN NEW YORK STATE.

THE TABLES IN THIS REPORT PROVIDE SUMMARY DATA FOR THE NONHANDICAPPED PUPILS WHO TOOK THE OBJECTIVE TEST, THE WRITING SAMPLE, AND BOTH COMPONENTS (COMBINED TOTAL) OF THE GRADE 6 SOCIAL STUDIES TEST. FOR EACH REFERENCE GROUP, THE TABLES INCLUDE THE NUMBER TESTED, THE MEAN SCORE, AND THE PERCENTILE RANK OF THE MEAN SCORE FOR EACH COMPONENT OF THE TEST AND FOR THE COMBINED TOTAL. TABLE 1 ALSO PROVIDES THE STANDARD DEVIATION FOR EACH COMPONENT OF THE TEST AND FOR THE COMBINED TOTAL BASED ON THE SCORES OF ALL NONHANDICAPPED PUPILS TAKING THE TEST STATEWIDE (TOTAL STATE).

IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT MOST PUPILS WHO TAKE REGENTS COURSES OF STUDY DO NOT TAKE THE REGENTS COMPETENCY TESTS AND THAT THE SUMMARY RESULTS PROVIDED IN THIS REPORT DO NOT INCLUDE TEST RESULTS FOR THOSE PUPILS. SINCE APPROXIMATELY 55 PERCENT OF THE PUPILS IN NEW YORK STATE HIGH SCHOOLS DO NOT TAKE THE REGENTS COMPETENCY TESTS, THE SUMMARY RESULTS IN THIS REPORT ARE NOT A TRUE INDICATION OF THE SUCCESS OF ALL PUPILS IN MEETING THE COMPETENCY TESTING REQUIREMENTS FOR A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA. THE SUCCESS OF ALL PUPILS IN MEETING THE COMPETENCY TESTING REQUIREMENTS IS BETTER REFLECTED IN THE HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REFERENCE GROUP DATA.

FOR EACH TEST AND EXAMINATION PERIOD, THE TABLES IN THIS REPORT PROVIDE A SUMMARY OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF NONHANDICAPPED PUPILS WHO TOOK EACH TEST AND THE PERCENT OF THOSE PUPIL: WHO PASSED THE TEST. PUPILS ARE FIRST ALLOWED TO TAKE THE REGENTS COMPETENCY TEST IN MATHEMATICS IN GRADE 9 AND THE REGENTS COMPETENCY TESTS IN READING AND WRITING IN GRADE 11. PUPILS WHO DO NOT PASS THE TESTS MUST BE PROVIDED WITH REMEDIAL INSTRUCTION IN THE PROBLEM AREAS AND ARE ALLOWED TO RETAKE THE TESTS AS MANY TIMES AS IS NECESSARY TO PASS THE TESTS.

THE RESULTS FOR THE JANUARY REGENTS EXAMINATION PERIOD ARE PROVIDED IN TABLE 1. ONLY STATEWIDE RESULTS ARE PROVIDED BECAUSE OF THE SMALL NUMBER OF PUPILS TAKING REGENTS EXAMINATIONS IN JANUARY. FOR EACH EXAMINATION ADMINISTERED IN JANUARY, TABLE 1 PROVIDES THE NUMBER OF PUPILS TAKING THE EXAMINATION, THE PERCENT OF THE AVERAGE GRADE ENROLLMENT TAKING THE EXAMINATION, AND THE PERCENT OF THE PUPILS WHO PASSED THE EXAMINATION. THE RESULTS FOR THE JUNE REGENTS EXAMINATION PERIOD ARE PROVIDED IN TABLES 2 AND 3. STATEWIDE TEST RESULTS AND THE RESULTS FOR VARIOUS REFERENCE GROUPS ARE PROVIDED FOR EACH EXAMINATION ADMINISTERED IN JUNE. FOR EACH EXAMINATION AND REFERENCE GROUP, TABLES 2 AND 3 PROVIDE THE NUMBER OF PUPILS TAKING THE EXAMINATION, THE PERCENT OF THE PUPILS WHO PASSED THE EXAMINATION.

THE PERCENT OF THE AVERAGE GRADE ENROLLMENT TAKING EACH REGENTS EXAMINATION IS PROVIDED FOR EACH REFERENCE GROUP SO THAT VALID COMPARISONS MAY BE MADE BETWEEN LOCAL REGENTS EXAMINATION RESULTS AND THOSE FOR THE VARIOUS REFERENCE GROUPS. THE PERCENT OF THE AVERAGE GRADE ENROLLMENT TAKING EACH REGENTS EXAMINATION REFLECTS SCHOOL POLICIES FOR ADMITTING PUPILS TO REGENTS COURSES OF STUDY. - TOTAL STATE REFERENCE GROUPS: TEST RESULTS ARE PROVIDED FOR ALL PUPILS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS STATEWIDE, ALL PUPILS IN NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS STATEWIDE, AND ALL PUPILS IN PUBLIC AND NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS COMBINED STATEWIDE.
