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ABSTRACT

Data on the geographic distribution of 1986-87 high school graduates of New York State's public and private schools are presented in tabular form. The information includes: the college-going rate of high school graduates from 1973 through 1987; 15-year trends in the college-going rate within and outside New York State, tabulated by college type (two- or four-year) and high school type (public or private); the distribution of public high school graduates in postsecondary education, military service, or employment, by borough or county and by region; distribution of private high school graduates in postsecondary education, military service, or employment, by borough or county and by region; and distribution of all high school graduates in postsecondary education, military service, or employment, by borough or county and by region. 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## INTRODUCTION

The following tables present data concerning the distribution of 1986-87 high school graduates of New York State's public and nonpublic schools. The data were secured through the Education Department's Basic Educational Data System and reflect the status of graduates, as reported by school principals, in the fall of 1987.

Table 1 presents trends in the college-going rate of high school graduates from 1973 through 1987. Table 2 shows a 15-year trend of the college-going rate, within and outside New York State.

Tables 3, 4 and 5 show, respectively, the distribution of 1986-87 high school graduates of public schools, non-public schools and public/nonpublic schools combined. These tables are arranged by county within geographic region.
