ABSTRACT

This bibliography includes both commercially published and locally produced textbooks and workbooks that are currently being used across the United States in foreign language programs for grades 1-6. The materials cited are used by 303 elementary schools that responded to a national survey of elementary school foreign language programs. The texts included in the list are used primarily in foreign language experience (FLEX) and foreign language in the elementary schools (FLES) programs. Materials for teaching Spanish, French, German, Latin, Russian, Chinese, Hebrew, and Ukrainian are included. The textbooks presented are divided by language, and the following information is presented for each textbook: title/author, publisher and publisher's address, and suggested grade level. (DJD)

The following is a list of commercially published and locally produced textbooks and workbooks that are currently being used across the country in foreign language programs in grades 1 - 6.

This information was gathered from a national survey of elementary school foreign language programs conducted by CLEAR from October 1986 - January 1987. Of the 1,454 randomly selected elementary schools that responded to the survey, 303 have foreign language programs. It is the texts used at these schools that are included in this list--the schools were asked to list the names and publishers of all commercially published textbooks and workbooks used. Information was also obtained from a survey conducted by the "Second/Foreign Language Acquisition by Children" Conference in Dallas, Texas, November 20, 1986.

Texts included here are used primarily in foreign language experience (FLEX) and foreign language in the elementary school (FLES) programs. (FLEX program goals include getting a general exposure to language and culture and learning basic words and phrases. FLES program goals include acquiring listening and speaking skills, gaining an understanding and appreciation for other cultures, and acquiring limited amounts of reading and writing skills.)

This list was compiled to help elementary school foreign language teachers become more aware of materials that are currently being used, since it is often difficult to obtain materials appropriate for young learners. Materials for teaching Spanish, French, German, Latin, Russian, Chinese, Hebrew, and Ukrainian are included. As can be seen from the texts included, teachers often "make do" with texts that were originally designed for older children. This list is not meant to be an exhaustive list of texts but rather an inventory of materials used in a sampling of FLES and FLEX programs. In the past year, many publishers have come out with new elementary materials that are not included here. It is recommended that those interested in more details about the texts listed should write directly to the publishers for additional information.
