## ABSTRACT

This report provides information on the number and percentage of students retained in grade during the 1982-83 school term in the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD). Data were analyzed from reports filed by all principals and from the LAUSD Racial and Ethnic Survey, Fall 1982. Children's centers, adult schools, occupational centers, and development centers for the handicapped were not included. Results are reported by sex, grade, and ethnicity. The following major findings are reported: (1) the number of students retained in June 1983 (7,168 or 4.9 percent of all enrolled) decreased slightly from June 1982 (5.0 percent); (2) retention rates varied across administrative sectors; (3) more males (59 percent) than females (41 percent) were retained in grade; (4) for each ethnic group, except American Indians/Alaskan Natives, more males were retained than females; (5) retention rates for secondary students were higher than for elementary students; (6) more students were retained in grade 1 than in any other elementary grades; (7) more students were retained in grade 10 than in any other secondary grades; and (8) Black and Hispanic students were retained at proportionately higher rates than students in other ethnic groups. ## Abstract

This study reports the number and percentage of students retained in grade during the 1982-83 school term. The findings are grouped by sex, grade level, and ethnicity.

Data for this report were obtained from Principal's School Report, Form 3. Principals completed this form on October 11, 1983.

Enrollment data were recorded from the LAUSD Racial and Ethnic Survey, Fall 1982.

Major findings are:

- In June 1983, 27,168 (4.9%) LAUSD students were retained. This is a slight decrease from June 1982 (5.0%).
- Retention rates varied across administrative sectors.
- More males (59%) than females (41%) were retained in grade.
- For each ethnic group, except American Indian/Alaskan Native, males were retained more often than females.
- Retention rates for secondary students were higher than for elementary pupils.
- There were more pupils retained in grade 1 than in other elementary grades.
- For the secondary level, more students were retained in grade 10 than any other.
- Black and Hispanic students were retained at proportionately higher rates than students in other ethnic groups.

# Retention Patterns in the Los Angeles Unified School District, 1982-83

## Introduction

Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) policies state conditions under which a student may be retained in a grade. The LAUSD policies include standards of proficiency in basic skills and citizenship as a requirement for promotion from one grade level to the next.

District policy for elementary students includes standards of proficiency in basic skills commensurate with each grade level. These standards are used by the local school to determine whether pupils should be promoted.

District policy for junior high grades 7-9 requires 7th and 8th graders to maintain adequate competence in basic skills and meet district standards of passing prescribed courses. The 9th grade students must demonstrate proficiency in basic skills and pass 50 credits of prescribed courses.

Senior high students will be retained in 10th grade unless 50 credits of required courses are passed, and 11th graders will be retained until 100 credits are passed in approved courses. The 12th graders must pass required courses totaling a minimum of 150 credits and pass proficiencies in mathematics, reading, and writing. Students take districtwide standardized tests to measure basic skills proficiency.

LAUSD continues to modify its retention/promotion policies as state laws and course requirements change, but the inherent concern is promotion based on academic and educational growth.

This report presents the number and percentage of students retained in grade during the 1982-83 school term. The findings are grouped by sex, grade, and ethnicity. For comparison purposes, this report includes retention summary data from 1979-80 through 1982-83.

Data for this report were obtained from all schools except children's centers, adult schools, occupational centers, and development centers for the handicapped.

## Purpose

In studying student retention for 1982-83, the following questions were asked:

1. What number and percentage of enrolled students were retained in a grade?
2. Was the rate of retention uniform throughout the District?



3. Were there differences in retention with respect to sex?
4. Were elementary pupils retained more often than secondary students?
5. Were there differences in retention with respect to ethnicity?
6. Were there differences in retention at various grade levels?

### Procedure

Each principal completed the Principal's School Report, Form 3, on October 11, 1983 as part of the annual fall survey. Items 12 and 13 on the survey gathered information on students retained in grade the previous year.

12: "Enter the count of students, by grade, who were retained at the close of the 1982-83 school year."

13: "Enter the count of students, by sex and by ethnicity, who were retained at the close of the 1982-83 school year."

Data generated from the two questions were analyzed by computer and Tables 1-12 were produced.

Enrollment data in this report were recorded from the LAUSD Racial and Ethnic Survey, Fall 1982.

### Results

In June 1983, LAUSD schools retained 27,168 (4.9%) students in grades K-12. The Senior High School Division reported the largest number of students retained (16,175, or 12.7% of enrollment). Administrative Region D reported the lowest number retained (958 or 1.8% of enrollment). The other seven administrative regions reported 2% to 3% of enrolled students as retained. Less than 1% of students attending schools for the handicapped were retained (Table 1).

The district's 1982-83 retention rates vary slightly from retention rates reported for 1981-82 (Table 2).

### Retention by Sex

In each administrative region more males were retained in grade than females. In Regions A, B, E, and H more than 60% of the total number retained were males. Across the district, the proportionate difference between male and female students retained was 18%: 59% males and 41% females (Table 1). For the past four school terms, however, average male students' retention rates exceeded females' by 15 to 18 percentage points (Table 2).

## Retention by Grade

In October 1982, elementary enrollment was higher than secondary; but, a greater number of secondary students were retained in grade. At the secondary level, the retention rates for the eight administrative regions, Special Education Division, and Senior High Schools Division ranged from 0.5% to 12.7%, with 7.2% as a district average. At the elementary level, the rates ranged from no retention in the Special Education Division to 4.1% in Region G. For the district, elementary pupils were retained at an average rate of 3.1% (Table 3).

The district's 1983 retention rate (4.9%) represents a slight decrease from the previous year (5.0%) (Table 4).

Retention rates by grade varied across administrative sectors. The highest rate (8.4%) was in grade 1, Region G, and the lowest rate (0.2%) was in grade 6, Region A. The highest rate of kindergarten pupils retained was in Region E (4.9%) and the lowest rate (2.4%) in Region D. There were no elementary pupils retained in the Special Education Division (Table 5).

For ease of comparing 1983 findings to previous years, Table 6 shows retention rates by grade for 4 years.

Junior high retention rates averaged less than 1% in Regions B, D, G and H. Region C, however, reported the highest retention rate (4.4%) for this level (Table 7).

In high schools, more 10th graders were retained than students in other grades. The rate for all high school grades was 12.7%. Of the 12 Special Education Division students retained, 11 were at the senior high level (Table 7).

Tables 6 and 8 report total retention by grade level for 1979-80 through 1982-83. Table 6 shows an increase in elementary retention rates for 1979-80 to 1981-82, then a slight decline in 1982-83.

Secondary rates increased in 1980-81 and tapered off at 7.2% for the following 2 years (Table 8).

## Retention by Ethnic Groups

In each administrative region, for each ethnic group except American Indian/Alaskan Native, more males than females were retained in grade (Table 9). Similar findings were reported for 1979-80 through 1982-83 (Tables 10 and 13).

Based on their ethnic group enrollment, the highest rate of retention (6.0%) was among black students and the lowest rate (2.0%) was among Asian students (Table 11).

Black students represented 21.4% of the district's enrollment in fall 1982 and white students 21.8%. Black students accounted for 25.9% of the total number retained, and white students 17.7%.

Hispanic students represented 48.9% of the district's enrollment and accounted for 53.2% of the students retained.

Asian students comprised 7.6% of the district's enrollment and accounted for 3.1% of the students retained.

American Indian/Alaskan Native students who proportionally represented the lowest ethnic enrollment also accounted for the smallest percentage retained (Tables 11 & 12).

### Findings

1. Retention rates for the district decreased slightly (5.0% to 4.9%) over the previous year.
2. Retention rates varied across administrative sectors.
3. More males than females were retained in each administrative sector.
4. For each ethnic group, more males were retained in grade.
5. More secondary students than elementary were retained in grade.
6. More pupils were retained in grade 1 than in other elementary grades.
7. More students were retained in grade 10 than other secondary grades.
8. Black and Hispanic students were retained at higher rates than their proportionate enrollment.
