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ABSTRACT

In large type and in very simple language, this pamphlet informs parents about the provisions of Public Law 94-142. It states that children with handicaps can go to public school with other children, that the school must give the special help that children With handicaps need to learn in school, and that the special help is called special education. It provides a sample letter that parents can use in asking the school to assess the child for special education placement and a sample letter asking the school for a due process hearing. It shows an example of a form granting parental permission for psychological evaluation, an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) form, and a form indicating the parents' consent to have the child placed in a special education program. The pamphlet briefly outlines what is included in an IEP and describes the parents' role and rights during the placement process. (JDD)

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

Public Law 94-142 is a Law to help **all** children with handicaps in the United States.





Public Law 94-142 says:

- Children with handicaps can go to public school with other children.
- The school must give the special help that children with handicaps need to learn in school.
- This special help is called special education.





The law tells the school to help your child with special needs.

This special help is free.



Some children do not learn as fast as others.



They may not be able to read, or write or work with numbers as well as other children.



Some children may not get along with others.

Some children may act up in school.

They may get into trouble in school.



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No two children learn alike.


No two children have the same needs.





Some children need extra help to learn.

Some children who need special help to learn may be handicapped.



Public Law 94-142 (PL94-142) says:

- Children with handicaps can go to public school with other children.
- The school must give the special help that children with hundicaps need to learn in school.
- That special help is called special education.





PL 94-142 tells the school to find young children with handicaps who need special help.

Call the public school closest to you if you think your child will need special help to learn in school.



Ask the school to test your child.

Use a letter like the one below to ask the school to test your child.




You must sign a form before the school can test your child. The form will look something like the one below.

Request For Parental Permission For Psychological Evaluation And Record of Informal Conference With Principal

- You are to have been made aware of the need and reason to have your daughter/son evaluated in a conference with the principal.
- You have the right to review all data in your son/daughter's cumulative folder.
- 3. You have a right to know that the types of tests to be used may include individual intelligence, achievement, eye-hand coordination, interest, aptitude, personality, and any others that the psychologist may deem necessary to complete a thorough evaluation. If you desire, you will have an opportunity to meet with the psychologist prior to the referral and proposed evaluation.
- 4. You have a right not to consent to the evaluation, but when you are asked to consent to a psychological evaluation, it is only done after considerable deliberation by the staff for the benefit of your daughter/son.
- 5. It is to be understood that the information obtained, the conclusions reached, and the recommendations made by the school psychologist shall be explained to you, shall be confidential, and shall not be released to any person outside the school district without your written permission. No change will be made in your son's/daughter's education program without your written permission.



Dear Parent or Guardian:



If the tests show that your child needs help, the school will tell you.



If the tests do not show that your child needs special help, and you still think your child needs special help, you can ask for more tests.

You may use a letter like this to ask for other tests. Keep a copy of this letter.

If your child does need Special Education, a special plan called an

Individualized Education Plan,

will be written.

This is called an IEP.

Parents can help write the IEP.

The school must ask you to the IEP meeting.




Individualized Education Plan

You can tell the school what special help you think your child needs. An IEP will look something like this:

Your child may need specially trained people to work with him in school.



Your child may need to ride on a special bus to school and back to your house.



Your child may need special things to go to school.





The IEP should tell what help your child needs to learn in school and how the school will give this help.

All the special help in the IEP will be <u>free</u>.

The IEP will tell you the things your child should learn during the year.

If you want the IEP to say more, or if you would like changes in the IEP, tell the school.

Your child may be with other children who are not handicapped or in a special class only for children who have handicaps.





You must sign a form before the school can place your child in a special education program. This form will look something like the one below:

You must sign a form saying "YES" before the school can put your child in special education.





You may go to the school to see the special education class and watch your child work, or play.



If you still have strong feelings that your child's program is not helping, and you believe more should be done, you can ask for a hearing.



At a hearing, a person listens to your problems and to the school's and decides what is best for your child.

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You may use a letter like this to ask the school for a hearing.




Other parents can be very helpful to you.
