ABSTRACT

This bibliography contains an extensive list of works of literature for the children of Micronesia. The bibliography is divided into the following categories: (1) "Micronesia" (including 41 citations); (2) "Primary: Picture Books" (378 citations); (3) "Primary" (83 citations); "Intermediate" (88 citations); (4) Middle/High (68 citations); "Informational Books" (217 citations); (5) "Poetry" (265 citations); (6) "Prose" (81 citations); and (7) "Multicultural." In the "Multicultural" section are 17 Asian/Pacific Islander, 19 Japanese, 10 Chinese, 9 Filipino, 17 Hawaiian, 9 African, 6 Hispanic, 12 Native American, 6 Black American, and 3 Jewish-American works. Citations are not annotated. Some citations represent early 20th century works, but most represent more contemporary works. The bibliography also includes sample literature sets for first and second grade and a list of children's book publishers. (SG)

And presto! A delicious, well-flavored book.**

This bibliography has many uses. It goes beyond the use of solely basal readers and allows the teacher to explore other sources for good literature. The books have been selected to reflect, for the most part, experiences which are real or familiar to the lives of our Micronesian children. One might say, it is a jungle book full of ideas.

The bibliography has been divided into nine sections: Micronesia, Primary, Intermediate, Middle/High, Informational Books, Prose & Poetry, Multicultural Literature, Literature Sets, and Publishers. The categories are not restrictive. This was done intentionally to show that books serve many purposes. For example, Picture Books can be used with upper levels when appropriate. A multicultural literature section includes books as far away as Africa and as close to us as Hawaii. The last section includes addresses of publishers which provides information you may need regarding titles, prices, and other purchasing concerns.

We hope that this bibliography will be of assistance as you select or order books. It takes time and enthusiasm to encourage the love of books among our children. As the 1989 Year of the Young Reader motto expresses:

**give us books,  
give us wings.**
