

ABSTRACT:

This annotated bibliography of supplementary materials for adult literacy students in Mississippi arranges the annotations in the following categories: automobiles; biography; communication skills; consumer information; coping skills; English as a second language; fiction; health, nutrition, and safety; history and government; insurance; job skills; money management; readers; religion; and tutor. Within each category the entries are arranged alphabetically by author's last name. Complete bibliographic information, prices, a brief description of the contents, and the reading level as furnished by the publisher are provided. The last page contains the names, addresses, and phone numbers of publishers and distributors. (CML)

As part of its adult literacy initiative, the Mississippi Library Commission is making the supplementary materials contained in this bibliography available to Mississippi adult literacy students and tutors through their local public libraries. From its contacts with librarians working with literacy programs and with educators involved in adult literacy efforts throughout the state, the Library Commission determined there is a need for books to supplement the textbooks literacy students and tutors are using and a need for materials of interest to new adult readers that would allow them to practice their developing reading skills.

Through a \$25,000 Library Services and Construction Act Title VI (Library Literacy Program) grant from the U.S. Department of Education, the Mississippi Library Commission has placed collections of recreational, coping skills, and tutor materials in 16 selected Mississippi public libraries that sponsor local adult literacy programs. If your local library does not have the title(s) you need, ask your librarian to request it from the Library Commission through interlibrary loan.

Also, through this same Title VI grant, the Mississippi Library Commission can provide an entire set of the books listed in this bibliography for use at literacy conferences or tutor training workshops, or as a start-up collection for public libraries initiating local adult literacy programs. Please use all of these materials often. We hope that by using them new readers can gain confidence and become more self-sufficient as they become better readers, and tutors will be better able to meet the needs of their adult students.
