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
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#### **ABSTRACT**

This guide contains an annotated bibliography of 107 resources for: (1) Basic 0-4: (2) Adult Basic Education; (3) English as a Second Language; (4) pre-General Educational Development Test; (5) General Educational Development Test; and (6) workplace programs published since 1986. It also contains a listing of job-specific workplace curriculum and exemplary special projects funded by the Pennsylvania Department of Education's Division of Adult Basic and Literacy Education (ABLE) programs between 1987 and 1989. Resources and projects were selected by a panel of six adult educators with outstanding records in curriculum/staff development and program management, who reviewed more than 300 resources supplied by publishers of ABLE materials. Resource listings are arranged alphabetically in each of the six categories. Each listing consists of title of resource, rollishers, author(s), audience, price, date of publication, class usage, reading level, subject, appropriateness for independent study and/or instructor use, subtopics, special features, components, computer requirements, review source, and a brief description of the resource. Special project listings consist of title, area, publication or completion date, issue, adult education number from Pennsylvania's clearinghouse AdvancE, projector director, organization name, address, and telephone number, audience, subarea, components, panel review, project cost, and a brief description of the project. Appendix A provides publishers' addresses. An inde  $\dot{}$ arranged alphabetically by publisher is included. (KC)

## The 1990 ABLE Curriculum Guide

The 1990 ABLE Curriculum Guide contains an annotated bibliography of Basic 0-4, ABE, ESL, Pre-GED, GED, and Workplace resources with 1986+ publication dates plus a listing of jobspecific workplace curriculum and exemplary special projects funded by the Pennsylvania Department of Education's Division of Adult Basic and Literacy Education [ABLE] Programs between 1987 and 1989.

The ABLE Panel, consisting of six adult educators with outstanding records in curriculum/staff development and program management, reviewed over 300 resources supplied to them by publishers of ABLE materials. Only the one hundred and seven resources deemed appropriate for ABLE learners and of superior content and format are included in the 1990 ABLE Curriculum Guide.

Thirty-five special projects featured in this guide were rated as exemplary by the FOCUS Panel of six adult literacy and basic education specialists and featured in FOCUS [1987-1990], a staff development bulletin funded by PDE's Division of ABLE. Out-of-state job-specific workplace curriculum projects were reviewed by the ABLE editor.

- 8. READING LEVEL For ESL books, reading levels are identified as E1-Beginner; E2-Intermediate, and E3-Advanced. Both ESL and 0-12 reading levels are those recommended by reviewers.
- 9. <u>SUBJECT</u> The major subject area, such as math, reading, lifeskills is identified.
- 10. SKLF-DIR. For the adult learner level indicated under Audience, the advisability of learners' using the resource independently is indicated by a YES.
- 11. <u>INSTRUCTOR-DIR.</u> For the adult learner level indicated under Audience, the advisability of tutor or teacher guidance is indicated by a YES.
- 12. <u>SUB-TOPICS</u> Specific areas of importance are identified. A workbook whose subject is <u>Reading</u>, might be further delineated under Sub-Topics as dealing with vocabulary development.
