ABSTRACT

This enrollment summary provides collegewide and campus-specific student data for Miami-Dade Community College (MDCC) for fall 1989. The following variables are considered: credit/non-credit enrollment status, semester credits generated, credit load, ethnicity, gender, degree types, full-/part-time status, age, native language, citizenship status, and residency. Trends and enrollment patterns are highlighted in 2- and 5-year summaries. Among the college-wide trends noted in this profile are the following: (1) total student headcount increased by 19% over the past 5 years, reaching an all-time high of 49,145 students in fall 1989 and making MDCC the largest multi-campus two-year college in the country; (2) the largest enrollment category increase in fall 1989 was among students continuing from a previous semester; (3) increases were found among the numbers of students intending to receive an associate of arts degree, foreign nationals, women, and students over the age of 25; (4) the total non-credit student headcount for fall 1989 declined by 2% from fall 1988; (5) the median age for students was 24 years for part-time students, and 20 years for full-timers; (6) 57% of new freshman students were Hispanic; (7) 55% of all students were native English speakers; (3) 25% of all students were foreign nationals; (9) new freshmen took the most credits, averaging 10.5 credits in fall 1989; and (10) 85% of the new freshmen indicated an intent to transfer. Fall Student Profile 1989-90 Closing Fall Enrollment Analysis

Overview: Purpose and Method

The purpose of this report is to provide a profile of Miami-Dade Community College (M-DCC) students who enrolled in the Fall Term 1989. This report is generated annually in order to report enrollment category status for the Fall Term, as well as to track any changes in student composition. The 1989-90 Fall Student profile follows the same format as the report from last year. This format divides the report into college-wide and campus segments to facilitate examination of campus data and profiles.

Data elements used for this report are generated from a variety of sources, and in most cases the sources are cited as a footnote to each table. The basis for information regarding most of the items related to sindent demographics come from student self-report. Each time a student registers for classes at M-DCC, he or she is required to complete forms which ask for certain information, including gender, ethnic background, age, etc. The ethnic categories are those established by the federal government and are used by reporting agencies at both the state and federal level.

The following tables detail headcourt enrollment and semester credit counts. Trends and patterns are highlighted by either two or five year comparisons.



College-Wide Information

The College continues to set new growth records in terms of both credits and credit student headcount. More students enrolled for the Fall, 1989, Term at M-DCC than for any prior term. These students generated more credits than ever recorded for a Fall Term. The headcount now stands at 49,145, up 5.8% (or 2,713 students) since last year and 19% over the past five years. Credits are up 5.9% from last year and now stand at 437,979. This represents an increase of over 20% compared to five years ago.

With a Fall 1989 headcount of 49,145, Miami-Dade is the largest multi-campus college in the United States. The largest multi-college system is the Los Angeles Community College System with a Fall 1989 credit enrollment of 111,626; it is followed by Maricopa County Community College System with 89,369. The largest single-campus college is the City College of San Francisco with 29,691 Fall Term students. Further details can be found in the Community, Technical, and Junior College Times issue published April 24, 1990.

Who are these additional 2,713 students that Miami-Dade has gained in one year? A comparison of last year's credit headcount to this year's shows shifts in several areas. Most of the growth seems to be occurring in the continuing student enrollment category. More of both new and continuing students are declaring an intent to receive an A.A. degree. Fewer are U.S. citizens, and a disproportionate number are over the age of 25 and female.

By campus, South continues to generate most of the credits--44% of the total for Fall, 1989. Medical Center Campus generates the least with 5% of the total credits. Compared to last year, Wolfson Campus shows the most growth in credits with a 13.7% increase. Compared to five years ago, Wolfson also shows the strongest increase with 55.6%. North has grown the most slowly with a 0.6% increase from last year and 8.2% over the past five years.

The picture in the non-credit area is not as rosy. While semester credits are rising compared to last year. non-credit semester credit

equivalents have been falling. Compared to last year, credit equivalents are down 5% college-wide. Over five years, however, credit equivalents are up by 7.6%. Most of the one-year drop in non-credit semester credit equivalent occurred on Wolfson Campus, down almost 30% from one year ago. North also showed a credit equivalent decline of more than 10%. South and Medical Center showed modest gains.

The non-credit student headcount also declined by 434 students (or 2%) to 17,705. This drop is attributed entirely to Wolfson Campus where the headcount was less than half of what it was one year ago. All the other campuses showed modest increases. The Fall 1989 total student headcount at the College now stands at 66,850, up from last year. This increase is entirely due to increases in credit headcount, since non-credit headcount declined.

The make-up of the student body has changed little over five years. A majority of students are female (58%) and part-time (64%). More students (35%) fall in the 14-20 age range than in any other group. With a median age of 24, part-time students are older than full-time students who have a median age of 20. Overall, females are slightly older than males attending M-DCC.

Hispanics continue to comprise the largest ethnic group, now making up 55% of the headcount and 56% of the credits generated. The average credit load remains at 8 or 9 credits, with Black non-Hispanics taking the highest credit load and White non-Hispanics the lowest. Generally, White non-Hispanics and females are slightly more likely to be part-time students. A majority of new freshman (57%) are Hispanics in Fall 1989.

About half of M-DCC students continue to be native English speakers--55% of the total. On Wolfson, however, this trend reverses itself with 57% being native Spanish speakers and only 35% native speakers of English. The citizenship status of enrollees remains stable compared to one year ago. Most students (63%) are U.S. citizens. One in four, however, is an immigrant alien. A vast majority (88%) of students who enroll at M-DCC hail from Dade County.



They generate almost two-thirds of the semester credits. New freshman take the most credits—10.5 on the average for Fall 1989. Continuing students average slightly more than 9 credits, while new transfers average 7.7 credits for the Fall 1989 semester.

A major mission of the College continues to be transfer. Fully 85% of new freshmen in 1989 plan to receive an Associate's degree (69% an A.A. and 16% an A.S.), up slightly from one year ago. For continuing students, 90% plan to earn an Associate's (68% an A.A. and 23% an A.S.). Conversely, about 60% of new transfers or former M-DCC students are pursuing an Associate's degree.

These patterns are true for the College as a whole. Further information can be found from studying Tables 1-16. The reader is reminded, nowever, that campus results can differ significantly from these overall trends. Readers interested in findings by campus are urged to read the following sections for each campus.



North Campus

North Campus currently generates 29% of the credits and 31% of the total headcount at the College. Compared to one year ago, the number of credits rose less than 1%, from 127,612 to 128,362. Closing Fall Credit Student headcount also changed very little from 13,559 to 13,996 for Fall 1989. See Table 17 for more information.

Tables 18 through 27 provide further details for the North Campus profile. Over the past five years, the percentage of females has increased to 55% and the percentage of full-time students has grown to 39%. The percentage of White non-Hispanics has fallen, while the percentage of Black non-Hispanics has grown. Young students in the 14-20 age range continue to comprise the largest age group at North Campus (34% of the total).

North Campus may see a decline in enrollment in the near future since the number of first-time-in-college (J) students declined from 20% to 18% of the headcount compared to one year ago. Though the student head-count increased slightly, the number of semester credits also dropped slightly. The average credit load declined to 9.17 from 9.33 one year ago.

More students are choosing to pursue the A.A. degree compared to ore year ago (up to 61.4% of the total from 58.4% one year ago). This increase is apparent for all enrollment codes. The number of A.S. degreescekers dropped slightly, especially for continuing students.

South Campus

South Campus currently generates 44% of both the credits and headcount at the College. The number of credits generated by South is up 6% compared to one year ago, and 18.5% over five years. Headcount rose 15% over the same five-year period. See Table 28 for further details.

Tables 29 through 38 provide more in-depth information on the Fall Protile for South Campus. Compared to one year ago, the percentage of White non-Hispanics dropped to 34% while the percentage of Hispanics rose to 57% of the total headcount. The average number of credits taken remains stable. The number of Black non-Hispanics enrolling full-time increased to 39.5% of the Black total compared to 37% one year ago.

While the distribution of headcount enrollment remains stable from last year, the percentage of first-time-in-college students (Js) who are White non-Hispanic dropped while the percentage who are Hispanic rose. The majority of students on South (44%) fall in the 14-20 age range. This group is also most likely to enroll full-time (68%). The average credit load for first-time-in-college (J) students dropped slightly from 10.72 credits last wear to 10.65 this year. The percentage of students pursuing an A.A. degree rose -0 76% in 1989 from 74% last year; both new and continuing students were more likely to select the A.A.

Wolfson Campus

Wolfson Campus generates 21% of the Fall semester credits (including Open College) and 21% of the "it student headcount. Compared to one year ago, the number of credits has increased 13.7% to 92,016. The Wolfson headcount rose to 10,273, a 7% increase over one year ago. See Table 39 for further details.

Tables 40 through 49 provide additional intormation on Wolfson's Fall 1989 profile. Please note that these tables exclude open college enrollment for students who list a home campus other than Wolfson. The tables show that more students enrolled as full-time students during Fall 1989 compared to Fall 1938, driving the number of semester credits upward and raising the average credit load to 8.91 from 8.6 last pear. The percentage of students who are Hispanic rose slightly to 71.6% of the headcount while the percent of White non-Hispanics declined slightly.

While the number of first-time-in-college students rose slightly, the major increase in headcount came from the continuing student category. This category increased by 812 students to 65.3% of the enrollment. Both A.A. and A.S. degree-seekers rose compared to one year ago, while the non-degree seekers declined.

The percentage of students who fell in the immigrant alien category declined this year, while the percentage with refugee or foreign/visa status rose. The largest category--U.S. citizen--remained stable at 47% of the campus total.

Medical Center Campus

Medical Center Campus currently generates 5.4% of the crecits and 6.9% of the total headcount at the College. Compared to one year ago, the number of credits rose 9% to 23,628. The Fall 1989 headcount rose by 357 students or 12% from Fall-to-Fall. See Table 50 for more in-depth information.

Tables 51 through 58 provide further details on the Fall Profile of Medical Center Campus. The campus remains predominantly female (73%) and part-time (75%). Compared to one year ago, the percentage of White non-Hispanics dropped while the percentage of Black non-Hispanic students increased. Though each of the three major ethnic groups has a sizeable presence c. Medical Center Campus, the largest percentage (37%) are Hispanic. With a median age of 29, students on Medical Center are older than on the other campuses.

Much of the growth in student headcount appears to be due to the number of first-time-in-college students on Medical Center Campus. Of the 312 add:tional students at Medical Center, 35% could be classified as "J"s, and this group rose to 12.4% of the headcount total.

The make-up of the group in terms of degree goals changed dramatically between 1988 and 1989. The percentage seeking an A.S. degree dropped from 85.7% to 70.7% of the students while the percentage seeking a non-degree upgrade rose from 4.9% to 17.8% in 1989. The percentage of students holding U.S. citizenship also dropped from 70% to 66% of the total.
