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ABSTRACT

In 1990, surveys were sent to all 107 California community colleges to gather information on the status of job placement services for students attending the colleges. Survey results, based on a 60% response rate (n=64), included the following: (1) 62% of the colleges indicated that they had documented student job placements in some fashion, with 41% of these reporting between 500 and 999 job placements annually; (2) among the 25 schools reporting the average earnings of their placed students, 40% reported student wages of between \$5.00 and \$5.49 per hour; (3) the majority of job placement services were available less than 40 hours per week, though evening services seemed to be gaining in popularity, and several schools reported efforts to improve their service scheduling; (4) only 9 schools indicated that they required students to show proof of enrollment in a minimum number of units to qualify to use the job placement service; (5) 65% indicated that they limited the number of referrals allowed on a daily basis; (6) 48% reported having a policy of restricting referrals after receiving a complaint from a student or employer; and (7) 34% used the JOBTRAK computerized placement program, 31% used some other mass-market placement program, and 12% had plans to computerize in the future. Responses to open-ended questions on computerization; the survey instrument; and summaries providing available information on the contact person at each college, office hours, number of placements annually, minimum enrollment requirements, pre-screening, and status of computerization are included. Student Job Placement Services Survey

This survey was written, and results compiled by Lyn Hood, Coordinator - Career Planning and Placement, at Cabrillo College.

The purpose of this survey is to provide information as to the status of computerization of Job Placement services in the California Community Colleges. The survey does not attempt to be a definitive placement services survey, but rather was designed to be utilized with Joan Jacobson's 1989-90 California Community College Job Placement Survey (College of the Canyons).

This survey was mailed to all 107 California Community Colleges in July 1990. Sixty-four colleges returned their surveys, generating a 60% response rate. Of the responding colleges, seven schools indicated that they did not offer a placement service, four schools were just starting a placement service and six schools offered what they called a "job bank" service.

The results of this survey are accurate to the extent that where there was an ambiguous response, judgements were made as to a) not indicate a response, or b) use a "best fit" criteria. Suggestions for inclusion in future surveys would include the gathering of job descriptions, reporting lines, departmental budget, and type of area served (urban, rural, etc.).

I wish to express my thanks to all of you who so graciously responded to this survey. Through my follow-up phone calls, I feel that I have made several new friends and hope that we will be able to work together in the future. I hope that you find the enclosed material to be of assistance to you, and that you will feel free to contact me if you have any questions regarding the survey abstract.

Summary of Results

- Services are offered in a wide variety of modes, with no primary type of coordination or staffing pattern emerging.**
- Evening services seem to be gaining in popularity, and several schools indicated that they are reviewing their hours to better serve the needs of their student populations.**
- The majority of services are available less than forty hours a week.**
- Most schools are either partially or fully computerized, or are in the process of exploring the computer options available.**
- Most schools are pre-screening students and documenting the results of their referrals (or working toward documentation).**

Of the 55 schools responding to the documentation of student placements, 34 (62%) documented their placements in some fashion. Since not all of the reporting schools kept records of the type of placement made, only total numbers of placements made are reported here.

Three schools indicated they did offer services on weekends (one school specifying September through June only).

Question 9—Minimum Unit Requirement to use Service

Only 9 (18%) of 49 responding schools indicated that they required their students to show proof of enrollment in a minimum number of units to qualify to use the college placement service. This may in part be because a number of schools consider themselves to be a "job bank," or because they are open to the public as well as to students.

Question 12—Policy of Restricting Referrals

Almost half (48%) of the responding schools indicated that they had some type of policy or restricting referrals or counseling students/employers upon receipt of a complaint. Most of those who responded indicated that they handled the complaint on a case-by-case basis, and did not have a written policy. Copies of the policies are attached under Policy Statements, page 23. (Note: only three schools enclosed written policies.)

Comments on Computerization

JobTrak has been very helpful and definitely saves staff time.

The D.V.C. program has become indispensable, relatively easy to customize and relatively inexpensive, even with customization. We would not consider any program which requires employers to pay a fee.

We do not have a large placement service at this time. JobTrak is good for us as it comes to us in a user ready format, at very little cost to us.

We receive a small check from JobTrak, but the real savings is from less staff time. I don't feel we have as good jobs as in the past, but we didn't have the staff for phone orders.

Our Pro-Search is excellent. We print out 350-400 jobs twice a week and could never do this manually. It is very neat, fast, and keeps our data correct. I don't know the effects of cost savings or time (lots).

At the time the Job Placement Service was computerized, using the DVC systems devised by a grant from the State in 1986, there were monies to staff the office. Also the Apple IIe computer was used with only a small memory capacity for our large operation. Therefore, the system proved ineffective for our operation. Since that time we now have an IBM PC with lots of memory; however, with our present budget constraints, we are unable to put our system back in operation.

We just got the system (Pro-Search)—too early to evaluate. I expect increased efficiency and staff time savings once we fully learn the system.

Pro-Search is excellent. We have a completely automated system. Students and all employers are in a computer data bank.

We combine JobTrak, who takes the j.o. from the employers, with Pro-Search. We are satisfied with both. JobTrak provides printed easy to read copies of j.o. that are then imputed into our Pro-Search. Pro-Search provides easy access to j.o. and the students info., as well as fast running reports.

JobTrak is very new to me, so I don't have enough information to base an opinion on at this time, but time saved on the phone is already a saving factor.

Pro-Search is a powerful tool in terms of conducting rapid searches, matching candidates to jobs and record keeping.

Newscorp is excellent—the computer is donated and sponsored by a local corp., and costs us nothing. It requires almost no time to use.

Much time is saved, some employers complain about JobTrak costs.

We are just installing Pro-Search. High amount of time and energy currently devoted.

Pro-Search—expensive but fast and very comprehensive. Will do more for student placement than DVC's system.

This program is fair (Brooks), we redesigned it to fit a two year college. It errors occasionally.

JobTrak very cost effective. Pro-Search in long-run cost effective.

I feel Pro-Search is fantastic, especially since JobTrak and Pro-Search can work together and down-load data directly into the computer. (As staff for data entry is a problem with any computer program.)

The computerized program (E.D.D.) is efficient and satisfactory.

...efficiency in getting information, but staff time savings? I am continually training new students to use the software (1st Place).

Policy Statements

Qualifications to Use the Job Board

You must meet one of the following requirements:

- **Current enrollment in a minimum of three (3) units**
- **Completion of twelve (12) units within the past three years if you are not currently enrolled (passing grades required) and plan to re-enroll next semester.**
- **Graduation from Cabrillo with an A.S., A.A., or Certificate of Proficiency**
- **Your placement card must be updated each semester.**

Suggestions on Use of the Job Board

Pre-screen yourself to be sure that you meet the requirements listed on the job card. Also be sure that you are willing to travel to the city where the job is located, and that you can work the hours and days listed. If there is flexibility in the hours, that will be noted on the card.

Do not remove the card from the board. If you know that a job has been filled, please notify the job placement staff.

You are limited to three referrals a day from the job board. Choose the jobs you wish to check on carefully. If available, you may use the phone in our interview office to contact employers listed with our service.

The wage noted on the card is not negotiable by the student unless it is so noted on the card. The staff works hard to obtain the best wages we can for our students. If, on contacting the employer, the duties of the job are substantially different than the student has been led to believe, please notify staff. (Also notify staff if there are other substantial differences than what is posted, or if the employer does not pay the wage listed on the job card.)

Disqualification from Board Use

You may be disqualified from using the job board if:

- **You repeatedly fail to attend scheduled interviews or not show up for work.**
- **You give job board information to others without the explicit permission of the placement staff.**
- **The staff receives complaints from employers concerning your work performance attitude, etc. (We will always listen to your side of the story, too.)**

Please notify staff if you have been hired or find out that a position is filled.

"No Show Policy"

Objective: The "No Show Policy" is a tool to assist our client's in developing a sense of responsibility for completing the referral process.

Procedure: Receipt of a "No Show" will result in the following:

1. First - A warning is placed in the client's record.
2. Second - Client is placed on probation with no referrals for two weeks.
3. Third - Client is suspended from any referrals for 30 working days.
4. Fourth - No referrals for three months or for the remainder of the academic semester, whichever is longer.
